NASTY NESTOR: LHP Nestor Cortes will make his third rehab start (second with Nashville) on Friday night to open the series against Indianapolis. After working three scoreless with Nashville on July 2 against Memphis, Cortes worked four scoreless last Thursday night for High-A Wisconsin. Including his last start with the Brewers, Cortes has worked 13.0 straight scoreless innings with 12 strikeouts and two walks on five hits. That follows a MLB career-high eight earned, five walks, and five home runs allowed in his Brewers debut against the Yankees.

OUR FRIEND, CRAIG: Brewers' no. 19-rated prospect Craig Yoho worked his eighth consecutive appearance without allowing an earned run as he pitched a scoreless bottom of the seventh inning for Nashville in the series finale against Durham last Sunday. Yoho lowered his Triple-A ERA to 0.90 in 27 appearances with Nashville after the outing. In 27 games with the Sounds, Yoho has allowed 18 hits in 30.0 IP with 36 strikeouts and 12 walks. His eight straight games without an earned run is tied for the 10th longest active streak in the IL. He's also tied for the seventh-longest overall streak in the IL this year with his 12-game stretch without an earned run allowed from March 29 - May 21.

AIN'T HE GRAND: Daz Cameron hit his second grand slam of the season in the top of the third inning last Saturday night against Durham. His first came on April 19 on the road in Charlotte. Cameron is now responsible for two of the three grand slams hit by Nashville this season along with Andrew Vaughn who hit the only other on June 17 vs. Iowa - his first hit as a member of the Brewers organization. After going three straight seasons from 2019-2022 without having a player hit multiple grand slams in a season, Nashville has now had a player hit multiple slams in three straight seasons. Wes Clarke had two for Nashville in 2024 and Patrick Dorrian had two during the 2023 season. **Saturday night was the sixth career grand slam for Cameron.** Cameron ended the series having played in four games and went 7-for-15 with two home runs, two doubles, seven RBI, and four runs scored.

MASHVILLE: Drew Avans and Jefferson Quero each launched their second home runs of the season - and series - last Saturday night against the Bulls. Quero made it back-to-back games with a home run, the 11th instance of a Nashville player doing so this year and the third time of the series, joining Tyler Black and Daz Cameron. After going 60-games between home runs earlier this year, Avans he now has two in his last five games played. The Sounds improved to 21-5 on the season when hitting 2+ HR in a game and 9-0 when hitting 3+. Entering the series against Durgam, Nashville went homerless in 13-of-15 games with five total home runs during the 5-game span between June 18 - July 4. **Nashville hit at least one home run in seven straight games after Saturday night and hit 13 home runs total in the six games played against Durham.**

STAYING AT THE QUALITY INN: Logan Henderson's quality start last Saturday night against Durham was his third in 13 starts with the Sounds and gave Nashville their third-straight quality start, and fourth of the series against the Bulls. With the win, **Henderson improved to 9-3 on the season and is in a three-way tie for the most wins in Triple-A** along with Durham's Ian Seymour and Scranton/Wilkes-Barre's Allan Winans. The trio are among 10 minor leaguers with nine wins on the season. **In three career appearances against Durham, Henderson improved to 3-0 with three quality starts and has allowed two earned runs over 18.0 IP (1.00 ERA) with 20 strikeouts and a walk.** It's just the second time this season that the Sounds have gotten three straight quality starts. They also did it on May 2-4 on the road in Gwinnett when Henderson, Jacob Misiorowski, and Carlos Rodriguez were on the mound. The 5-inning rain shortened game on Wednesday was the only game of the series that Nashville has not gotten a quality start.

IN THE MARGINS: The 12-run margin of victory against the Bulls on July 12th was the largest of the season for Nashville, topping the 11-runs they beat Memphis by in game one of a doubleheader with a 11-0 shutout win on May 14th.

COUNTDOWN TO 65: Nashville got to 50 wins on the season with the win over Memphis in their series finale on Sunday, July 6 to take the series. It's the earliest that Nashville has gotten to 50 wins since the 2022 season when they picked up their 50th win on July 7 and were 50-30 on the year. The team got to 50 wins in 2009 on July 11th (89 G), July 14th in 2006 (92 G), and on July 8, 2025 (89 G). **Rick Sweet is 12 wins away from passing Buddy Bailey for the third-most wins by a Minor League manager in history.**
