CARDS SET FRANCHISE MARK WITH 2-1 WIN OVER MISSIONS: Benito Garcia matched a career high with 8 strikeouts over 4.2 innings of relief and Nathan Church went 3-for-4 as the Cardinals held on to defeat the San Antonio Missions 2-1 on Wednesday night at Nelson Wolff Stadium. With the win the Cardinals set a new franchise record with their 78th win of the 2024 season, eclipsing the previous record held by the 2012 & 2017 clubs. Matt Svanson stranded the tying run at 3rd and the winning run at 2nd to end the ballgame for his Texas League-leading 26th save of the season.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander Henry Baez make his 9th start with the Missions this season...Got the win in his last start last Friday, September 6 at Tulsa when he allowed just 1 ER on 4 H over 6.0 IP with 2 K...Had surrendered 8 ER on 10 H over 9.1 IP over his previous 2 starts combined...Promoted to San Antonio on July 23 and went 3-0 with a 2.22 ERA over his first 5 Double-A starts...Picked up the win against the Cardinals on August 8 at Hammons Field allowing just 1 R on 4 H with 4 K over 6.0 IP...Began the season at High-A Fort Wayne and went 2-3 with a 2.95 ERA in 17 starts, allowing just 56 H with 78 K over 76.1 IP...Midwest League opponents batted just .201 against him...Earned Midwest League Pitcher of the Week on July 14, a week before being promoted...Began the 2023 season at Low-A Lake Elsinore where he went 7-3 with a 3.24 ERA in 17 appearances (14 appearances)...Earned a promotion to Fort Wayne for his final 4 starts of the season and pitched to a 7.20 ERA and did not factor in a decision... Signed by San Diego as an International Free Agent in July 2019 out of the Dominican Republic for \$125,000...21 years old

CARDS CLOSE OUT 2024 REGULAR SEASON IN THE ALAMO CITY: Springfield hits the road for the final series of the regular season before beginning the postseason next week. The Cards meet the San Antonio Missions (Double-A, San Diego Padres) for a six-game series at Nelson Wolff Stadium. The Cardinals and Missions split a six-game series at Hammons Field from August 6-11.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.



For the second straight season all 138 Cardinals games can be found across the FM airwaves of Southwest Missouri all season long on Classic Rock 106.7, the radio home of the Springfield Cardinals!

HISTORIC CARDS MAKE HISTORY AGAIN: With their 2-1 win over the Missions on Wednesday, the Springfield Cardinals collected their 78th victory set a new franchise record for wins in a season. The 2024 club surpassed the 2012 & 2017 teams who each won 77 games. The wins record caps a season that has seen the Cards notch several franchise firsts.

- Springfield has won 40 road games this season to set a new franchise record, eclipsing the 38 road wins in 2008.
- The Cards began the season with a franchise record 9-game winning
- Cooper Hjerpe and Andrew Marrero combined to throw the first no-hitter in franchise history in a 5-0 win in game one of a doubleheader on June 20 at Corpus Christi.
- Chandler Redmond set the new franchise record with his 60th home run in a Springfield uniform.

ON PACE...: With just 5 games remaining in the 2024 regular season, the Cardinals are on pace for several team and individual franchise records:

- Springfield's pitching staff is currently 21 strikeouts from the franchise record for K's in a season fo 1,263 set in 2019. The strikeout pace for the Cardinals pitching staff is 1,279.
- With an average of .333, Bryan Torres is on pace to break the record for highest batting average held by Tyler Minges who hit .324 in 2005.
- With 26 saves, Matt Svanson is one save shy of the franchise record of 27 (Mark Worrell, 2006 & Chris Perez, 2007).

CARDIAC CARDS: Over their last 26 games, the Cardinals have saved their best work for late in games. Springfield is 18-8 during that time, and have outscored its opponents 45-17 in the 8th inning or later.

HOLDING 'EM DOWN: While the 2024 campaign has been a roller coaster ride of sorts for the Cardinal pitching staff, the Birds' arms have been at their best since the beginning of August, compiling a 3.33 ERA over their last 36 games, a mark that is 3rd-best in the Texas League. Through the end of July the Cardinals sported a 4.64 ERA, 9th in the circuit.

RUN PRODUCER: Through 6 games in the month of September, Cardinals 1B/ OF Matt Lloyd is batting .333 (11-for-33) with 2 HR and is 2nd in the Texas League with 11 RBIs. For the season, the Canadian product has been one of the top run producers in the Texas League. His 77 RBIs ranks 2nd in the circuit behind only AJ Vukovich of Amarillo who has 80.

5-HIT TORRES: With a 5-for-5 performance on Friday night, **Bryan Torres** became the first player in Springfield Cardinals history to have 5 hits in two separate games in the same season. The reigning Texas League and Cardinals Minor League Player of the Month also went 5-for-5 on August 14 at Frisco. Torres leads the Texas League in batting average (.333), hits (146), and OBP (.418).

CARDS WELCOME BIG BAT BACK INTO FOLD: Cardinals C Jimmy Crooks was activated from the IL on Tuesday, putting perhaps Springfield's most productive hitter back into the middle of the lineup. At the time he was placed on the IL August 27, Crooks was leading all qualified hitters the Texas League with a .359 average, 10 HR and 39 RBIs since June 23. Crooks is 3-for-6 with a double in the first two games of the series.

MAKING A SPLASH: In his first game at Double-A on Saturday, 2023 1stround pick Chase Davis announced his presence with his very first swing. The 21st overall pick homered on the first swing he took in a Springfield uniform, a solo shot to give the Cards a 1-0 lead in the 2nd inning. In his first 4 games with Springfield, Davis is 5-for-14 with 2 2B, a home run and two stolen bases.

SLAM THE DOOR: Cardinals closer Matt Svanson has been lights out so far in the 2024 campaign in save situations. Svanson is a perfect 26-for-26 and his 51 appearances lead all of Double-A while his 24 saves is 2nd in MiLB. So far in the 2nd half, the Birds closer is 16-for-16 in save opportunities. Svanson had a run of 19 apperances without allowing an earned run snapped on Sunday afternoon in Wichita when he allowed 2 ER on 4 H in the 8th inning of Springfield's 5-2 win. The Cardinals are 58-1 when leading after 8 innings this season.
