> YOUTH MOVEMENT: Among players in Minor League Baseball this season aged 19 years old or younger, no player has more home runs than Axiel laz, who hit his 12th home run of the season on Friday night. Plaz holds the third-highest SLG (.552) among players 20 years old or younger as well.

> ALUMNI UPDATE: On Friday, 2023 Bradenton Marauder RHP Paul Skenes was named the starting pitcher for the National League in the All-Star game taking place next week at Globe Life Field. Skenes become the 11th former Marauder to play in the All-Star team since the team's inception in 2010. Skenes joins Josh Bell, Gerrit Cole, Adam Fraizer, Tyler Glasnow, Clay Holmes, Brock Holt, Mitch Keller, Jeff Locke, Starling Marte, and Austin Meadows as other Marauders to make the All-Star game. Holmes (2015, 2018), Glasnow (2014) were also selected to play in the Midsummer Classic as well.

> $\textbf{RECORD SETTING DAY:} \ Bradenton\ racked\ up\ season-high\ 14\ runs\ in\ a\ six-run\ victory\ over\ the\ Jupiter\ Hammerheads\ on\ Wednesday\ morning.\ For\ the\ properties of\ the\$ second time this year, Esmerlyn Valdez hit a pair of home runs. He joins Axiel Plaz as the only Marauder this year to drive in five runs in a contest as well while also recording a season-high four runs scored. Bradenton also went 6-for-13 with runners in scoring position, it's the second-most hits with RISP this season. They held a season-high seven in 21 at-bats against St. Lucie on May 12 in 12-11 walk-off victory at LECOM Park.

Over his last seven games, Valdez is hitting .360/.467/.840 with three doubles, three home runs, 11 RBIs, four walks, and seven runs scored.

> WELCOME JUPITER: Bradenton and Jupiter met 12 times last season with each team hosting a series at their home ballparks with neither side winning either series. The Marauders won four out of six games against the Hammerheads at LECOM Park in 2022. Palm Beach is now the lone team in the Florida State League that Bradenton has yet to play
