FROM THE CROWS NEST

LAST TIME OUT: The Bradenton Marauders fell 10-3 in the series opener on Tuesday night against the Lakeland Flying Tigers. Bradenton led a 3-2 lead going into the bottom of the second inning before the Flying Tigers plated the final eight runs. The final 19 Bradenton batters were retired in order. **Andrew Patrick** doubled in a pair of runs in the second inning.

SEARCHING FOR A WIN: The Marauders have lost their last seven games on the road in Lakeland with their last win coming on June 25, 2023. Last season, the Marauders went 8-3, winning both road series' in Lakeland.

TIGERTOWN BOUND: The Bradenton Marauders make their second and final visit of the season to Joker Marchant Stadium this week. Bradenton's first road trip of the season was in Lakeland back in April, where the Marauders dropped all six games. The Marauders have yet to win a series against the Lakeland Flying Tigers having lost two and split another in three series meetings in 2024.

LOST AT SEA: The Marauders won five out of six games in their last road series in Port St. Lucie but still went 6-6 in their two week road affair at the start of August. The .291 win percentage on the road is the worst in Minor League Baseball this season, only just ahead of the Chattanooga Lookouts (Double-A, CIN) who sit at .316. Bradenton dropped their first nine road games to the start the year as well which included losing all six in Lakeland in April.

TONIGHT'S STARTER: RHP **Khristian Curtis** makes his third start since coming off the injured list a few weeks ago. Curtis was a 12th round selection last year by the Pittsburgh Pirates last year and is currently ranked as the Pirates' No. 27 prospect according to MLB Pipeline.

ON A ROLL: Since coming off the injured list on August 2, LHP **Michael Kennedy** has been superb in his three starts. The southpaw sports a 1.38 ERA after only allowing two earned runs on five hits while striking out 14 and only walking two in 13.0 innings. Opponents are hitting just .116 off him in August.

THOU SHALT NOT PASS: RHP **Danny Carrion** recorded the last out on Saturday night to run his scoreless innings streak up to 9.1 innings. Over his last six plus outings, Carrion has allowed just two hits while striking out eight. The 2023 9th round pick has lowered his season ERA from 5.40 to 3.20.

GRAND SALAMI: C **Derek Berg's** first professional home run came on an inside-the-park grand slam last Thursday night in Port St. Lucie. For the Marauders, it's their second inside-the-park grand slam this year, with the other coming from **Esmerlyn Valdez** against the Mets at LECOM Park on May 10. **A week later, Will Taylor's first professional hit was a grand slam against Dunedin at LECOM Park.** Bradenton has six grand slams this year, which is the second-most in Single-A and tied for the eighth-most in all of Minor League Baseball. Last year, Bradenton hit four with Deivis Nadal hitting one on same day last year (Aug. 15) as Taylor's.

AMONG LEAGUE LEADERS: The Marauders hold four of the top nine home run leaders in the Florida State League, with **Esmerlyn Valdez** leading the way in second with 17 longballs. **Axiel Plaz** is currently in third with 15, **Javier Rivas** is in eighth with 11 and **Shalin Polanco** is tied for ninth with 10. Valdez is two just HR shy of tying league leader in Ariel Almonte (Daytona). The 17 HR hit by a Valdez are the second-most by a Marauder since the Florida State League was moved from High-A to Low-A. Rodolfo Nolasco hit 20 bombs last year for Bradenton to lead the way.

CLOSE QUARTERS: Sunday's win against the Blue Jays marked the Marauders' 39th one-run contest of the season. The Marauders own an 19-20 record in those games. It snapped a five-game losing skid in game's decided by one run.
