#### INDY BITS

**ABOUT SUNDAY:** The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp relied on dominant pitching and a three-run fourth inning to defeat the Indianapolis Indians, 5-0, on Sunday afternoon in the series finale at 121 Financial Ballpark. Jacksonville capitalized on a pair of RBI singles in the fourth inning from Will Banfield and Tristan Gray. The Jumbo Shrimp added on two more runs in the contest, courtesy of a Gray solo home run in the sixth and an RBI single from Javier Sanoja in the eighth to cap their scoring. Jacksonville's pitching staff held the Indians in check throughout the contest, as starter Kyle Tyler fanned six across 7.0 innings. Right-hander Luarbert Arias finished the effort for the Jumbo Shrimp, as he limited Indy's offense while punching out three hitters to record the final six outs of the game.

**JP:** Joshua Palacios logged his third multi-hit contest in five games back from the injured list on Sunday at Jacksonville. He went 2-for-4 for half of the Indians four hits on the day. That performance was preceded by another two-hit game with his third overall home run of the season and his first with Indianapolis after he hit two in four games of his rehab assignment with High-A Greensboro. In 21 total games this season between Single-A Bradenton, Greensboro and Indy, Palacios owns a .263 batting average (20-for-76) with eight runs, five doubles, three home runs and nine RBI. He launched eight home runs in 20 games alone with Indianapolis last season to go along with his .410 batting average (32-for-78).

**GILBERTO CONTINUES TO BE HOT:** Gilberto Celestino continued his hot streak as of late last night, hitting a single for one of four Indians hits. He has hit safely in seven of 10 games during the month of June with a .294 batting average (10-for-34), five runs, four extra-base hits, six RBI and as many walks (6) as strikeouts (6). His month included a solo home run to get the Indians on the board in their first victory over Jacksonville on Thursday. He paired homers with Grant Koch for second back-to-back home runs by Indians batters this season. He hasn't gone hitless in back-to-back games since May 16 (1)-17, and in 18 games since May 19 he is hitting .303 (20-for-66) with nine runs, three doubles, three home runs, nine RBI, nine walks and a .872 OPS.

**LEANING ON PITCHING:** The Indians 2.29 ERA (13er/51.0ip) over their six games at Jacksonville leads all 30 International League teams over the last week. The Indians bullpen helped lead the best pitching staff in the IL for the week, logging a 1.21 ERA (3er/22.1ip) in six games. None of Chris Gau (3.0ip), Geronimo Franzua (2.2ip), Brent Honeywell (3.0ip) or Isaac Mattson (4.0ip) allowed a single run during the series.

**BULLPEN STRETCHES:** The Indians bullpen has boasted a number of effective individual stretches beyond last week's success at Jacksonville. Those individual stretches by Indians relievers are listed below:

**ANOTHER ONE FOR ALVAREZ:** Andrés Alvarez led the Indians offense last week, going 6-for-20 in five games. On Saturday, he matched his career-high with four hits last night, going 4-for-4 and reaching base safely in all five of his plate appearances with a walk. Alvarez's first four-hit game of the season came on June 5 vs. Columbus, when he went 4-for-5 with three runs scored and a triple-turned-little league home run.

**A STREAK:** The Indians won three consecutive games at Jacksonville with a 4-1 victory on Thursday, 3-2 win on Friday, and 6-2 win on Saturday night. It was the first time they have won three straight games since April 30-May 2 vs. Buffalo. Their longest winning streak of the season came in four games from April 4-6 (2) vs. Memphis. The last time the Indians won three consecutive games in a single road series was Sept. 13-15, 2023, at Omaha.

**TONIGHT:** The Indians kick off their lone homestand vs. the Iowa Cubs, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago Cubs, tonight at 7:05 PM ET at Victory Field. The Indians and I-Cubs faced off at Principal Park in Des Moines, Iowa from May 21-26, splitting the series 3-3. In that series, the Indians launched 14 home runs. Beginning the series for Indianapolis today is RHP Domingo Germán (0-4, 6.93) made his second start of the season with Indianapolis at Iowa and surrendered five runs (four earned) with five strikeouts in a season-high 5.1 innings on May 25, taking a no-decision. Countering for Iowa today will be LHP Thomas Pannone (4-5, 4.04), who went 0-2 with 10 earned runs in 7.0 innings with six strikeouts in two starts against Indy earlier this season.

**ROAD SERIES:** With a three-game winning streak at Jacksonville, the Indians split their second consecutive road series after not winning more than one game in their first four road trips. The Indians first series with more than one win came when they went 3-3 at Iowa from May 21-26, a series which was bookended by Indians wins and 14 home runs.

**THIS DATE IN 1963:** On Father's Day in Denver, the Indians split a doubleheader, winning Game 1 by an 11-3 score before losing the nightcap, 22-5. Joe Gaines led the offense with three hits in the opener, which included an eight-run eighth for Indy. Gaines' hot hitting continued in Game 2 with a four-hit performance despite the lopsided outcome.

## TONIGHT'S PITCHER

**Domingo Germán:** Right-hander Domingo Germán is set to make his sixth start of the year for Indianapolis against the Iowa Cubs, tonight at 7:05 PM at Victory Field.

**Last Outing:** Germán toed the rubber for his second start on the road with the Indians on 6/12 as he punched out four batters across 4.1 innings and took the loss.

**Against the I-Cubs:** Germán made his only career start against Iowa on May 25, taking the no-decision with a 6.97 ERA (4er/5.1ip) and five strikeouts.

**Historic Germán:** Domingo Germán spent the 2023 season with the New York Yankees. He made 20 total appearances (19 starts) while tossing the 24th perfect game in major league history on 6/28 at Oakland which was the fourth in Yankees history. He was placed on the restricted list on 8/2 and missed the remainder of the season.

**Miscellaneous:** Germán was signed by the Florida Marlins as an international free agent on May 27, 2010. On Dec. 19, 2014, he was traded to New York (AL) with RHP Nathan Eovaldi and RF Garrett Jones in exchange for RHP David Phelps and 3B Martin Prado. He had his contract first selected by the Yankees on November 4, 2016 and he made his MLB debut on June 11, 2017 vs. Baltimore. He was signed by Pittsburgh as a minor league free agent on March 16, 2024.
