### NOTES AND NUGGETS

#### STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

After an 0-4 start to the season, the Storm Chasers have won 12 of their last 18 games.

- Last season, the Storm Chasers won just 6 of 27 series played ... Omaha has won consecutive series over Buffalo, Iowa and Indianapolis.
- Last week's series win was the Storm Chasers' 3rd straight ... Omaha never won back-to-back series last year ... the last time the Chasers won 3 series in a row was a stretch from April 23 to June 2, 2024 with 6 straight series wins.

#### CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Storm Chasers have the 4th-best fielding percentage in the International League at .983, committing just 13 errors in 22 game (1st: Rochester, .992) ... Omaha is tied 12th among the 120 full season Minor League teams.

- The clean play extends throughout the roster - of Omaha's 13 qualified fielders (min. 50.0 inn), 8 have a perfect 1.000 fielding percentage, led by **Kevin Newman** (144.0 innings) in the infield and **Kameron Misner** (160.1 innings) in the outfield.
- 26 double plays turned by the Storm Chasers are 2nd in the International League and 3rd in the Minors... 4 Storm Chasers infielders have participated in 10+ double plays, led by 15 from **Abraham Toro**.

#### DON'T GET CAUGHT

Stealing bases has been one of the strongest areas for the Storm Chasers this season, led by one of the International League's best baserunners.

- Omaha's 87.5% stolen base rate (28-for-32) leads the IL, is 2nd at the Triple-A level and ranks tied 12th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams.
- John Rave** leads Omaha and is 5th in the International League in steals (10) while **Gavin Cross** is 2nd on Omaha with 4 stolen bases ... Rave and Cross are 2 of 5 Storm Chasers who have stolen multiple bases without being caught.

#### CHALLENGING THE SYSTEM

The Omaha Storm Chasers have one of the better Triple-A teams at converting ABS challenges in their favor in 2026.

- Omaha's 63% win rate on challenges ranks 2nd at the Triple-A level ... both 67 total challenges and 42 successful challenges rank as the most in Triple-A.
- The Chasers' success is partially driven by how aggressive their catchers have been ... **Elias Diaz**, **Eli Marrero**, **Luke Maile** and **Luca Tresh** have challenged at a 3.5% rate, the highest in Triple-A, yet have won 27 of 42 defensive challenges (64%), with a level-leading 7 strikeout flips while ranking 2nd with 5 walk flips.
- At the plate, Omaha hitters have converted 15 of 25 challenges (60%) ranking tied 3rd in Triple-A in success rate... 8 strikeouts flips from the hitters are 1st in Triple-A.

#### MISNER ON A MISSION

Outfielder **Kameron Misner** has been the heart of Omaha's offense to open 2026.

- Misner has reached base safely in 18 of 20 games this season, with hits in 17 of 20 ... he has also driven in a run in 14 of 20 games, with 22 RBI this season ranking 3rd in the International League and tied 6th in the Minors.
- Early in the season, he produced a league-best 11-game hitting streak from March 28 to April 10, going 13-for-37 (.351) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 14 RBI.

#### WHAT A RELIEF

Omaha's bullpen has been one of the team's strengths this season, with a handful of arms standing out.

- Eric Cerantola** has been Omaha's most reliable relief arm to open the year, with 10.0 scoreless innings over 9 games and a Minor League-leading 5 saves ... 10.0 scoreless innings are tied for the 3rd-most scoreless innings in the International League ... factoring in last year, Cerantola last not allowed a run since August 21, 2025, a 22.1 inning scoreless stretch that spans his last 19 outings with Omaha.
- Chazz Martinez** has begun his year with 6.0 scoreless innings in 5 outings (since April 7), while **Jose Cuas** has worked 6.0 straight shutout frames (since April 4).

#### HOLY TOLEDO

Since the Chasers joined the International League in 2021, they have won 8 of 15 series with the Mud Hens, but won just 2 of 6 series played in Toledo.

- The Storm Chasers have won 4 of their last 6 series with Toledo across the last 2 years ... since 2024, Omaha is 22-16 (.579) against the Mud Hens.
- On the other side this week is former Storm Chasers outfielder **Tyler Gentry**, who signed a Minor League contract with the Tigers on April 11 ... Gentry's 364 games with Omaha between 2023 and 2025 rank 4th-most in the club's Storm Chasers era (since 2011) ... since 2011, he ranks 3rd for Omaha in walks (162), 5th in plate appearances (1393), 6th in doubles (69), 6th in homers (41), 7th in RBI (164).

- ✓ Ryan Ramsey is making his **5th appearance** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **4th start** of the season with Omaha.
- ✓ Playing his **5th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- ✓ This is Ramsey's 1st career start against Toledo ... it is just the 2nd time he has faced a Tigers affiliate, having worked 2.0 scoreless innings against High-A West Michigan in April 2024.

- ✓ **STARTER'S ORDERS:** Ramsey made just two spot starts last year for Omaha, but cracked the Storm Chasers' Opening Day roster ... when he opened last year in Double-A, his first appearance came as a "piggyback" pitcher behind starter Hunter Owen ... in 2024, his first 4 outings of last year came in relief, while 2 of his first 3 appearances this year have been starts.
- ✓ **Y2K ROTATION:** Ramsey is one of five players on the Chasers' active roster, and one of two starting pitchers that were born in 2001, however he is the oldest of the five ... he's approximately 7 months older than fellow starter Luinder Avila (born 8/21/2001), who is scheduled to start Sunday for Omaha.

LAST OUTING: FRIDAY, APRIL 17 VS. INDIANAPOLIS

- ✓ In his 3rd start of the season, opened the afternoon with a scoreless 1st, working around a walk ... allowed runs in the 2nd and 3rd innings, on an RBI single and RBI groundout ... worked a scoreless 4th, with a double play erasing a 1-out walk ... came back out for the 5th, allowed a leadoff walk and got a pair of outs before being removed from the game ... came 1 out shy of earning a win.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- ✓ Appeared in 1 Cactus League game with the Royals while up from Minor League camp, working 1.0 scoreless inning ... opened the 2026 season on the Storm Chasers' roster.
- ✓ Worked 5.0 innings of 1-run relief on April 5 vs. Buffalo (TOR), 1 out shy of tying his longest career relief appearance.

- ✓ Began the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and spent most of the year in Double-A, also making a pair of spot starts for Omaha ... posted a 5.54 ERA (65 ER in 105.2 IP) in 25 appearances (18 starts) at Double-A ... his 114 total strikeouts ranked tied with Shane Panzini for the Royals organization lead.
  - ✓ Pitched to a 3.73 ERA (17 ER in 41.0 IP) over his first 9 appearances (7 starts) from April 9 to May 31 which included a 5.2-inning, 5 strikeout, scoreless performance May 18 @ Tulsa (LAD).
  - ✓ Made his first Double-A start on April 15 @ San Antonio (SD), throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit ball to start what became the fourth no-hitter in Nationals history ... relievers Chazz Martinez, Ryan Brady & Brandon Johnson finished it off ... was NWA's third combined no-no, the club's first no-hitter since 2013.
  - ✓ Was transferred to Omaha on April 30 and made his Triple-A debut on May 1 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) ... returned to the Nationals on May 2 and returned to Omaha for a start on September 19 @ Columbus (CLE).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- ✓ Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+), splitting time between the bullpen and as a starter ... appeared in 22 games (11 starts) with a 2.43 ERA (24 ER in 89.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts to 30 walks (3.23 K/BB) at High-A ... had a career-high 25.2-inning scoreless streak from July 25 to August 27, the River Bandits' longest scoreless streak in their Royals-affiliate era (since 2021).
- ✓ Largely split 2023 between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), but also made 2 rehab appearances (1 start) with the ACL Royals (R) ... pitched to a 0.54 ERA (2 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts across 7 starts with Columbia before earning a promotion to Quad Cities ... made 5 appearances (2 starts) at High-A with 22 strikeouts in 14.1 innings (13.8 K/9) ... set a Fireflies record with a 24.0-inning scoreless streak from April 21 to July 29, spanning 5 outings and stints on the Development List and Injured List.
- ✓ Made his professional debut in 2022 with the ACL Royals (Rk) after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the 2022 MLB Draft ... pitched in 1 game in the ACL that season.

MISCELLANEOUS

- ✓ Pitched 3 seasons (2020-22) for the University of Maryland (Big Ten), working a career 17-2 record with a 3.13 ERA (47 ER in 135.0 IP) and 140 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.41 K/BB) for the Terrapins ... named 2022 First Team All-Big Ten and 2021 Second Team All-Big Ten ... in 2022, went 11-1 with a 3.22 ERA (33 ER in 92.1 IP) and 90 strikeouts to 41 walks (2.20 K/BB) across 16 appearances (15 starts).
- ✓ Threw a 9.0-inning perfect game for the University of Maryland on April 29, 2022 against Northwestern.
- ✓ Was drafted by Cleveland in the 36th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Pascack Hills High School but elected not to sign and instead attend the University of Maryland.
