TODAY'S GAME: The Memphis Redbirds begin a six-game homestand against the Indianapolis Indians (Triple-A, Pittsburgh Pirates) on Tuesday night at AutoZone Park. Left-handed pitcher Bruce Zimmermann is slated to make his sixth start of the season in game one for Memphis opposite Joe La Sorsa for Indianapolis in a bullpen game for the Indians.

SUNDAY'S RECAP: The Memphis Redbirds wrapped up a six-game road trip at the Norfolk Tides (Triple-A, Baltimore Orioles) with a 14-4 victory on Sunday afternoon at Harbor Park. Memphis took a firm grasp on the win with a nine-run top of the third inning. In total, all 10 Redbirds to take a plate appearance in the game reached base safely. Left fielder Joshua Báez led the way with a 3-for-6 day and added an RBI triple. Third baseman Blaze Jordan and shortstop Cesar Prieto each smacked a home run. Memphis converted at a 5-for-15 rate with runners in scoring position. Starting pitcher Quinn Mathews allowed one run on three hits, walked one and struck out five in 4.0 innings pitched. Matt Pushard (1-0) earned the win with a perfect relief appearance. Luis Gastelum continued the great start to his Triple-A career with a perfect inning and lowered his ERA to 2.51 in 2026. With the win, Memphis took a one-game lead in the International League over the Gwinnett Stripers. The Redbirds have yet to spend a day outside of at least a tie for first place this season.

NOT A DAY OUTTA FIRST: Thanks to a franchise-best 7-0 start to the 2026 season and steady play since, the Memphis Redbirds have yet to spend a day of the season outside of at least a share of first place in the International League. Memphis enters Tuesday with a one-game lead in the International League standings over the Gwinnett Stripers. Memphis has not won any International League (or Triple-A East) title since leaving the Pacific Coast League ahead of the 2021 season. The last Redbirds league title came in 2018.

MANAGER BEN JOHNSON

Ben Johnson enters his eighth season as manager of the Memphis Redbirds and his eighth year in the Cardinals organization.

COACHING CAREER

- Became the all-time winningest manager in franchise history on May 21, 2025 (368 wins)
- 428 - 435 managerial record entering 2025 season, including postseason.
- Oversaw a franchise record 15-game winning streak in 2021 (7/9-7/25); tied for longest in MiLB that season
- Oversaw a franchise record 200 home runs in 2019; team won 29 of final 40 games and were in contention for division until 2nd to last day of the season
- Spent 2018 as third base coach for the Durham Bulls (Rays' Triple-A)
- Spent 2014-2017 as a scout in the Arizona Diamondbacks organization
- Coached at Millenium HS in Goodyear, AZ from 2011-2013
- Previously managed Arizona Centennials in the Independent League in 2012

PLAYING CAREER

- Drafted by the Cardinals in the 4th Rd. of 1999 Draft; traded to Padres in 2000
- Made MLB debut on June 26, 2005 with the Padres; played 98 games over next three seasons with the Padres and Mets
- Named Padres Minor League Player of the Year in 2005 when he hit a career-high .312 with 25 home runs and 83 RBIs as a member of the Portland Beavers
- Played 901 MiLB games over 10 seasons with Cardinals, Padres, Mets and Tigers; hit .262 with 115 career home runs and 473 RBIs

PERSONAL

- Born in Memphis and played baseball at Germantown HS; named Memphis-area HS Player of the Year in 1999; lives with his dad during the season
- He and his wife, Elizabeth, have two children, Ethan and Ruby; reside in Phoenix, AZ

PITCHING COACH DARWIN MARRERO

- Marrero is beginning his 14th season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis.

COACHING CAREER

- Joined the Memphis Redbirds coaching staff following five seasons (2018-22) with Double-A Springfield Marrero's career with St. Louis began as pitching coach for the Gulf Coast League Cardinals (Rookie) from 2013-14, followed by the same role with the State College Spikes (Class-A) from 2015-17.

PLAYING CAREER

- Marrero's playing career spanned seven seasons from 1998-2004 with the Montreal Expos organization, attaining his highest level at Double-A with the Harrisburg Senators in 2002 and 2004.

HITTING COACH HOWIE CLARK

- Clark is beginning his fourth season in the Cardinals organization and fourth with Memphis

COACHING CAREER

- In 2015, Clark was named the hitting coach of the Delmarva Shorebirds, the Class-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. In February 2017, Clark was named the assistant hitting coach for the Orioles. He was named hitting coach of the Charlotte Knights, Triple-A affiliate of the Chicago White Sox, for the 2020 season. [9] On December 1, 2020, Clark was named assistant hitting coach for the Chicago White Sox.

PLAYING CAREER

- Clark played parts of six seasons in MLB with the Baltimore Orioles, Minnesota Twins and Toronto Blue Jays from 2002 to 2008.
- Clark batted .262 with three home runs and 26 RBI in his career

- Originally drafted by the Atlanta Braves in 2017. Made his Major League debut with the Orioles in 2020. Involved in a six-player trade between the Braves and Orioles in 2018 sending RHP Kevin Gausman and RHP Darren O'Day to Atlanta.
- Played parts of five Major League seasons making 27 starts and 38 appearances with the Orioles and one start for the Brewers in 2025.
- Started the Orioles home opener in 2022 vs. Milwaukee (4/11).
- Posted Major League career-highs with innings pitched (73.2) in 2022; strikeouts (56) and wins (4) in 2021 all with the Orioles.
- Made his Major League debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader vs. Tampa Bay in 2020 at Oriole Park at Camden Yards.
- Led the Eastern League with two shutouts in 2019. 2018 South Atlantic League Midseason All-Star.
- Graduated from Loyola Blakefield High School in Towson, Md. Was a two-sport athlete also playing offensive guard and linebacker in football.
