YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were shut out by the Baysox, 9-0. Frederick Bencosme hit a two-run double and TT Bowns added an RBI single in the first inning to open a 3-0 lead. John Rhodes singled in a run in the third and Silas Ardoin worked a bases-loaded walk in the fourth to extend the lead to 5-0. Bowie added four runs in the ninth. **Evan Gates** threw 2.2 innings without allowing a run and struck out four. **Jose Cruz** pitched two scoreless innings, working around two walks. Richmond did not have a hit after the second inning.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS have split the last two series, including a six-game series to open their home schedule against Akron from April 9-14 and a six-game road series in Harrisburg from April 16-21. They dropped two-of-three at Somerset to open the season from April 5-7. Last year, the Flying Squirrels reached the postseason for the second consecutive season and the fourth time in franchise history, winning the Southwest Division Second-Half title. They were eliminated by the Erie SeaWolves in the Southwest Division Series. The team went 74-64 overall, the second-best record in the Southwest Division. In the first half, the Flying Squirrels jumped out of the gate in first place for most of the first month of the season, but slid down the stretch and finished 33-36, fourth in the Southwest. In the second half, the Flying Squirrels surged to a 41-28 record, finishing three games ahead of Erie in first place. The Flying Squirrels spent 57 percent (79 games) of the season in first place in the division. Richmond's 74 wins this year were the third-most in franchise history and their .536 winning percentage was the second-best, trailing only 2014 (79-63, .556). After starting this year 1-4, the Flying Squirrels are 7-5 in their last 11 games.

THE BAYSOX won five-of-six in last week's series at Prince George's Stadium against the Altoona Curve, including a walk-off single on Friday in the 10th inning by John Rhodes and a walk-off grand slam by Jud Fabian in the ninth on Saturday. The Baysox opened the year taking two-of-three against the Reading Fightin Phils at home before dropping four-of-six in Hartford from April 9-14. Last year, the Baysox went 67-70, fourth in the Southwest Division. They finished last in the first-half Southwest Division standings, going 31-38, before going 36-32 in the second half, third-best in the division. The Bowie roster includes nine of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C/1B Samuel Basallo (No. 2), OF Dylan Beavers (No. 7), RHP Seth Johnson (No. 10), OF Jud Fabian (No. 12), RHP Trace Bright (No. 16), OF John Rhodes (No. 23), RHP Alex Pham (No. 24), SS Frederick Bencosme (No. 27) and OF/2B Billy Cook (No. 30). Baseball America's top-30 Orioles prospects list includes nine Bowie players, including Basallo (No. 2), Johnson (No. 10), Beavers (No. 11), Fabian (No. 13), Bright (No. 21), Rhodes (No. 26), Pham (No. 27), Bencosme (No. 28) and RHP Keagan Gillies (No. 30).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander **Hayden Birdsong** makes his fourth start of the season. He last pitched on Saturday and threw 3.1 scoreless innings against the Senators in Harrisburg with four walks and five strikeouts. Birdsong leads the Eastern League (min. 10 IP) in K/9 (15.09) and ranked fourth in strikeout percentage (38.0%). Last year, he climbed three levels in the Giants' system en route to being named a 2023 MiLB.com Organization All-Star in his first full professional season. For the season, he posted the second-highest K/9 (13.32) and strikeout percentage (34.9) in the minors (min. 100 IP). He began the season with Low-A San Jose and posted a 2.16 ERA in 12 outings (10 starts). He was leading the California League in strikeouts (70) when he got promoted to High-A Eugene in June. After going 2-2 with a 3.25 ERA in eight games (seven starts) for the Emeralds, he was promoted to Double-A Richmond on August 5 for the remainder of the season. Birdsong was selected by the Giants out of Eastern Illinois University in the sixth round of the 2022 MLB Draft. He is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com entering the 2024 season. **For more on Birdsong, see page two.**

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Trace Bright makes his fourth start of the season and the first of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He last pitched on Saturday against the Curve and allowed one run on nine hits over five innings. Last year, he spent most of the season with High-A Aberdeen and went 2-6 with a 4.35 ERA in 22 outings (18 starts). He was promoted to Double-A Bowie in August and went 0-1 with a 2.63 ERA in his three Eastern League starts. Bright was a weekend starter at Auburn in 2022 and helped lead them to the College World Series. He was drafted by the Orioles that year in the fifth round. Bright is ranked as the No. 21 Orioles prospect by Baseball America and No. 16 by MLB.com.

SUGASTEY SURGING: **Adrián Sugastey** has hit safely in his last seven games, the longest streak by a Flying Squirrels player this year. During the streak, Sugastey is batting .360 (9-for-25) with eight singles, a double, four RBIs and three runs scored. This year, Sugastey is the youngest catcher in the Eastern League. With his debut earlier this month, Sugastey became the second-youngest catcher in team history behind Tommy Joseph (2012) and the 13th-youngest player in franchise history.

WILL POWER: **Will Wilson** saw his six-game hit streak end on Thursday night but worked a walk. The streak was the second-longest by a Flying Squirrels hitter so far this season. Wilson is batting .333 (9-for-27) with a double, three RBIs, three runs scored and five walks in his last seven games. Dating back to 2021, Wilson has played 153 games for the Flying Squirrels over parts of four seasons.

BACH TO FORM: In his last six games dating back to the start of last week's series against the Senators, **Brett Auerbach** is batting .278 (5-for-18) with a triple, a double, an RBI, two walks and three runs scored. He has picked up five hits over his last four games, including a double and a triple on Saturday night.

HOWELL HEATING UP: Dating back to Friday, **Carter Howell** is batting .409 (9-for-22) with a triple, four doubles, three walks and six runs scored, raising his batting average from .115 to .250. His five-game hit streak was snapped on Thursday night. Last year in his first full professional season, Howell led the Giants system in hits (144) and triples (8) and was second in the organization in batting average (.294) and runs scored (94) between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene.

PAY YOUR DUES: In his 10 games for the Flying Squirrels this year, **Damon Dues** is batting .316 (6-for-19) with nine walks and a .536 on-base percentage, which is first in the Eastern League (min. 25 PA). Last Thursday, Dues reached base four times, going 3-for-4 with a walk. He added two more walks on Saturday night. Dues signed with the Giants as a non-drafted free agent in 2021 out of Wright State University.

STRONG ARMS: The Richmond pitching staff has combined for 174 strikeouts this season, third-most in the Eastern League, and also ranked fourth with a 3.39 ERA. Flying Squirrels starters have combined for a 3.79 ERA this year, which is third-best in the league behind Akron (1.97) and Erie (2.00). The Richmond bullpen has the fifth-lowest ERA (3.07) in the league.

PROSPECT WATCH: Eight of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the roster, including **Hayden Birdsong** (No. 6), **Reggie Crawford** (No. 9), **Grant McCray** (No. 10), **Vaun Brown** (No. 11), **Eric Silva** (No. 22), **Adrián Sugastey** (No. 25), **Ryan Murphy** (No. 28) and **José Cruz** (No. 30). In Baseball America's Best Tool in the Giants Organization list, **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control, Sugastey is rated as the best defensive catcher and McCray is rated as the best defensive outfielder and best outfield arm. Crawford is rated as having the best fastball and best slider. Six players landed on MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Birdsong (No. 6), Crawford (No. 8), McCray (No. 13), Brown (No. 15), **Victor Bericoto** (No. 20) and Sugastey (No. 24).
