CARDINALS MAKE HISTORY, SWEEP DOUBLEHEADER: The Cardinals snapped an 8-game losing streak with a historic performance en route to a doubleheader sweep on Thursday evening at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi. In game one, **Cooper Hjerpe** and **Andrew Marrero** combined to throw the first no-hitter in Springfield Cardinals history in a 5-0 victory. **Hjerpe** threw 5.0 innings and **Marrero** the final 2.0. The Cards managed to score 5 runs without a hit with a runner in scoring position. In game two the Cardinals defeated the Hooks 4-2. **Jacob Buchberger** had two hits for Springfield and **Matt Svanson** picked up his league-leading 10th save of the season.



OPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander **Miguel Ullola** makes his 12th start (14th appearance) of the season for the Hooks...Last start came on Friday, June 14 at San Antonio and surrendered 2 ER on just 1 H over 3.2 IP while walking 3 and striking out 9...Over 3 starts in June is 1-0 with a 2.70 ERA with 18 K in just 13.1 IP...For the season has struck out 84 while walking 39 in 61.2 IP...Opponents are batting just .156 against him...Spent all of last season with High-A Asheville going 3-9 with a 5.86 ERA in 25 appearances (13 starts)...Made 7 appearances with the Mesa Solar Sox of the Arizona Fall League after the season going 1-0 with a 14.04 ERA, walking 11 and striking out 6 in 8.1 IP...First full season came in 2022 with Low-A Fayetteville and Ullola put together a 2-2 record with a 3.25 ERA in 22 appearances (11 starts)... Best Fastball in the Astros system according to *Baseball America*...Signed by the Astros in 2021 out of the Dominican Republic...22 years old

CARDINALS VISIT CORPUS CHRISTI TO CONCLUDE FIRST HALF: The Cardinals make their only trip to the Gulf of Texas this season for their first of two matchups with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). The Cards have not visited Corpus Christi since 2022 when they lost 4 of 6. In the only series between the two clubs in 2024, the Cardinals went 4-2 at Hammons Field from August 22-27.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

FIRST HALF PENNANT RACE: With just 3 games to play, the Cardinals are in desperation mode in the race for the North Division 1st half title. Springfield is in 2nd place in the North Division, 1.5 games back of the Arkansas Travelers, who have a magic number of just 3 to clinch a postseason berth. The Cards' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers.

CARDS MAKE FRANCHISE HISTORY: In game one of their double-header on Thursday night at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi, the **Cooper Hjerpe** and **Andrew Marrero** combined to throw the first no-hitter in Springfield Cardinals history in a 5-0 (7 innings) win over the Hooks. The Cardinals carried a no-hitter through 7 innings in the season opener on April 5 against Arkansas in a 6-1 win. Cardinals history dates back to 2005 when the franchise moved to Springfield from El Paso.

HOME vs ROAD: For a majority of the 2024 season, the Cardinals have had much more success on the road than at Hammons Field. After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have dropped 18 of their last 23 games at Hammons Field, a stretch that includes a franchise record-tying 8-game home skid. Overall the Cardinals are 13-18 with a team ERA of 6.05 at home.

Road games, however, have been a much different story. The Cardinals are 22-13, the 2nd-best road record in the league, with a 3.75 ERA which is tied for 2nd best and tops in the North Division.

GRINDIN': Simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 461 whiffs in 66 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (444 K in 64 games). The Cards are averaging just 6.98 K's per game.

CARDS ON WRONG SIDES OF POWER: While the Cardinals are at or near the top of the Texas League in several important categories, such as batting average (1st) and hits (1st), Springfield is on the wrong side of HR on both sides of the ball. The Cards have the lethal combination of allowing the 2nd-most home runs (71) while hitting the fewest (33) in the Texas League this season.

The Cardinals are on pace to give up 148 HR this season. Springfield, however, is on pace to hit just 69 homers, which would be the fewest in the Texas League since the 2015 Arkansas Travelers who also hit 60. The Cardinals have run especially cold over the last month with just 8 HR since May 18 (a league-low in that time period followed by Corpus Christi's 17), and have allowed 27, 2nd-most in the Texas League during that time. Over their first 36 games leading up to May 18 Springfield had hit 25 homers, good for 7th in the circuit. The Cards have hit just 3 HR over their last 21 games. The last time Springfield hit more than 1 HR in a game was May 21 in a 7-6 win against Tulsa at Hammons Field (Nathan Church & Matt Lloyd)

BIG INNINGS COSTLY: Big innings have proven to be an issue for the Cardinals' pitching staff this season. The Cards have surrendered 47 innings of 3+ runs, including 6 in their past 3 games and at least one such inning in each of their last 7 games. All together, "big innings" have accounted for 186 of the 346 runs Springfield has allowed this season (53.7%). The Cardinals are 26-6 in games while they don't allow a "big inning", and 9-25 when their opponent scores 3+ runs in an inning.

REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 215.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 34 straight games without a home run.
