### JACKSONVILLE RALLY FALLS SHORT TO MEMPHIS

The Jacksonville Jumbo Shrimp scored three in the ninth Wednesday to take the lead, but **Errol Robinson's** two-run double won it 6-5 for the Memphis Redbirds in the bottom of the ninth at AutoZone Park. Trailing 4-2 in the top of the ninth, Jacksonville plated three runs to take a 5-4 lead. However, the Redbirds rallied to win their second straight in the series.

### STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM

Jacksonville starting pitchers have ceded three runs or fewer in 15 of their last 19 games. During that span, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have yielded 40 runs, 33 earned, on 84 hits (8.2 H/9) in 92.0 innings for a 3.22 ERA. This stretch has not seen Jacksonville starters strike out many opponents, with the club's rotation registering just 68 punchouts (6.7 K/9). However, they have only issued 29 walks during this run, a rate of 2.8 per nine innings.

### WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Over the season's first eight games, Jacksonville mustered only 25 walks, the second-fewest such total in the International League. However, the Jumbo Shrimp have shown a significant amount of patience of late; Jacksonville has registered 107 free passes over the last 19 games since April 11, a figure that ranks first in the International League. During this stretch, the club has walked in 14.4 percent of their plate appearances. The MLB average is roughly 8.6 percent. The Shrimp walked in just 7.6 percent of plate appearances in their first eight games. Jacksonville's 11 walks on Sunday, were their most in a game since tallying 12 against Birmingham on 6/15/19. The last time the club tallied 11 walks at home was 8/6/15 vs. Pensacola.

### JERARASSIC PARK

**Jerar Encarnacion** has been on a tear since Jacksonville's two-week homestand (4/18-4/30). In that span, Encarnacion leads the Jumbo Shrimp in batting average (.364), hits (12), total bases (20), extra-base hits (6), OBP (.523), SLG (.606) and OPS (1.129). This hot streak has seen Encarnacion raise his batting average 100 points from .264 to start the season. He debuted with the Marlins on June 19, 2022 at Citi Field against the New York Mets, smacking a grand slam and adding an outfield assist and steal.

### FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A whopping 13 of Jacksonville's 27 contests have been decided by two runs or fewer, a rate of 48.1 percent. The Jumbo Shrimp have excelled in one-run contests, going 6-3 (.667), tied for the second-most such victories in the International League. Jacksonville is just 1-3 (.250) in games determined by two runs. In 2022, the Jumbo Shrimp were .500 in both one- (19-19) and two-run (12-12) games. Sixty-four of the club's 149 affairs were determined by no more than two runs, a rate of 41.6 percent.

### 'PEN PALS

The Jacksonville bullpen struggled mightily during a seven-game stretch from April 14-26. Over that timeframe, Jumbo Shrimp relievers collectively surrendered 27 runs, 26 earned, on 38 hits (11.7 H/9) in 29.1 innings for a 7.98 ERA. That stretch saw the club's bullpen fan 35 batters (10.7 K/9) but walk 23 hitters (7.1 BB/9). However, in the six games since then, Jacksonville relievers have combined to cede 12 runs, eight earned, on 27 hits (9.5 K/9) in 25.2 innings for a 2.81 ERA. The Jumbo Shrimp bullpen has combined for 30 strikeouts (10.5 K/9) against 20 walks (7.0 BB/9).

### BIRD HUNTING SEASON

Since 2021, Jacksonville's first year back in Triple-A, they are 21-8 against the Memphis Redbirds. In 2022, the club matched up 18 times with the Redbirds, winning 14 of those contests (.778). The Jumbo Shrimp tallied 42 wins on the road with nine of those wins coming at AutoZone Park. Jacksonville pitchers had a 3.08 ERA, third-best among 2022 opponents. On the offensive side, Jacksonville owned Memphis pitching, slashing .266/.338/.451/.789 with 28 home runs, 91 RBIs and 11 stolen bases.

### SHRIMP BITES

**Jeff Lindgren**, who starts on Thursday for Jacksonville, has not allowed an earned run in two of his three Triple-A outings thus far in 2023... **Jake Mangum** ranks ninth in the IL in batting average (.353). **Jerar Encarnacion** also places amongst the league leaders in several categories. The Bayaguana, Dominican Republic native is tied for eighth in doubles (8), tied for 11th in walks (19), 14th in RBIs (22) and 22nd in on-base percentage (.412). **Brian Miller** is tied for 10th in the circuit in steals (10).

### ABOUT JEFF

-A graduate of Illinois State University, Lindgren was mainly a reliever in college, starting in just 17 of his 83 appearances. He went 8-14 with a 6.02 ERA over his four seasons. However, entering 2022, he has already totaled 19 minor league starts in 36 career games, collecting an 8-10 record and 3.28 ERA.

-Jeff comes from an athletic family; His father, John, played football at Henderson State University in Arkadelphia, Arkansas.

-An alumnus of Illinois State University, Jeff followed in his sister Allyson's footsteps in attending school in Bloomington-Normal, Illinois. Allyson is a fellow graduate of Illinois State.

### 2022 SEASON

-Lindgren played for the Pensacola Blue Wahoos between stint with Jacksonville. In 2022 combine, Lindgren posted a 7-4 record with 116 strikeouts in 136.2 IP.

### 2021 SEASON

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .234 (59-for-252) with a .740 OPS. However, with runners in scoring position, Lindgren buckled down for a .211 (16-for-76) opponents' average and .598 OPS.

-Lindgren got off to slower starts in 2021; in the first and second innings, opponents batted .290 (43-for-148). However, in the third and fourth innings, often his second time through the order, Lindgren held opposing hitters to a .183 (25-for-136).

-When Lindgren got hitters in a 1-2 hole, they were just 7-for-71 (.099) against him with 33 strikeouts.

Interestingly, when Lindgren was pitching from behind on the scoreboard, he performed better, holding opponents to a .176 (24-for-136) average. When his team led, opposing hitters collected a .241 (27-for-112) average.

### 2019 SEASON

-With High-A Jupiter, lefties hit .297 with a .680 OPS against Lindgren. However, he held right-handed hitters to a .176 average with a .432 OPS.

-With the bases empty, opponents hit .275 (11-for-40) against Lindgren with a .626 OPS. With runners in scoring position, Lindgren limited opposing batters to .194 (6-for-31) with a .508 OPS. Total, with runners on, Lindgren posted a .188 (9-for-48) batting average against with an OPS of .471.

### ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-At Centennial High School (Champaign, Ill.), Lindgren competed in both baseball and basketball. He served as the baseball team captain, helped win two regional championships and one sectional championship.

### VS. THE REDBIRDS
