#### A Trip to the Capital

Reading continues a six-game series at Harrisburg with game three tonight. The teams each have four wins in the season series.

#### Looking Back

A career-high seven innings from Mick Abel lifted Reading past Harrisburg 6-1 last night. Offensively, Oliver Dunn had two hits and Jhailyn Ortiz had two doubles, along with four RBI. It marked the second 4+ RBI game of the season for Ortiz. For Harrisburg, James Wood was 2-4, but the rest of the Senators lineup combined to go 0-22. Tristan Garnett and Keylan Killgore each tossed scoreless frames out of the bullpen.

#### The Month of Dunn

Oliver Dunn added two more hits, a double, RBI and run scored last night to continue his torrid August. Dunn also eclipsed the 100-hit mark last night, which makrs a career-high in hits for Dunn. 2023 has been a career-year for Dunn, as he has careet bests in hits, runs, doubles, homers, RBI and stolen bases. His 21 home runs rank tied for third in the Eastern League and his 76 RBI make him the active leader in the leaue.

#### Abel's Sharp

Phillies No. 2 Prosepct Mick Abel turned in an excellent start last night. He tossed seven innins, which is a new career high. It's the second time a Reading starter went seven innings this season, with the other Griff McGarry on July 21 at Altoona. Abel allowed just one run, two hits and had three strikeouts. He pitched to contact a lot more, tossing eight ground balls to just five fly balls. After last night, Abel now qualifies for the Eastern League lead in batting average against at .201. He also now ranks seventh in WHIP in 1.32. Abel is at 106 strikeouts this season and his previous high was 130, which came between High-A Jersey Shore and Reading last season.

#### Playoffs?

Reading remains in the playoff hunt, just 2.5 games back of a spot with 22 games to play. Since Somerset won the first half title, if the Patriots remain in first place, then the second place team in the Northeast Division will earn the final playoff spot. Two teams ahead of Reading are still on the schedule. Portland comes to Reading from Sept. 5-10 and Reading ends the season in Binghamtom from Sept. 12-17.

### Around the Organization

The Phillies fell to the Giants 8-6 yesterday in ten innings. Bryce Harper hit a game-tying three-run homer in the ninth and Johan Rojas made an excellent diving catch and double play. Lehigh Valley split a doubleheader with the Railriders as Simon Muzziotti and Weston Wilson each had two hits in the second game. Jersey Shore beat Wilmington 10-9 as Justin Crawford had two hits, including a double. Finally, Clearwater beat Lakeland 5-2 as Jonathan Petit tossed six-shutout innings and Jordan Viars tripled.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

### **Hey Harrisburg**

Harrisburg enters tonight with a 23-24 record in the second half and 54-61 record overall. Last week, the Senators took just one-of-five from Richmond, while dropping the last-four games. Next week, Harrisburg will begin a 12-game road trip at Binghamton, then Altoona. Currently, 10 of Washington's top-30 prospects are on Harrisburg's roster: Dylan Crews (1), James Wood (2), Brady House (3), Robert Hassell (8), Trey Lipscomb (14), DJ Herz (16), Cole Henry (19), Israel Pineda (22), Mitchell Parker (26) and Jacob Young (30).

#### Senators Pitcher

Lefty Andrew Alvarez will get the start tonight for Harrisburg. It'll be just his second start for Harrisburg as he made his Double-A debut last Friday at Richmond. He suffered the loss, but was solid, tossing five inning and allowing two runs on three hits with two strikeouts. Alvarez was called up to Harrisburg on Aug. 17 from High-A Wilmington, where he went 7-4, with a 2.61 ERA over 21 games/18 starts (103.1 IP, 88 H, 32 BB, 96 SO). Alvarez spent 2022 between Single-A Fredericksburg and Wilmington, combining to go 4-7 with a 5.00 ERA. He made his pro debut in 2021 after being drafted by the Nationals in the 12th round in 2021 out of Cal Poly. Alvarez was at Cal Poly from 2018-21 and appeared in 65 games, while making just 24 starts. Even though he's a lefty pitcher, he does half things lefy-handed and half right-handed.
