- FOR STARTERS: The Rocket City Trash Pandas continue a six-game road series tonight against the Biloxi Shuckers, the Double-A affiliate of the Milwaukee Brewers. Rocket City is coming off a 2-1 home series win over Columbus (July 18-20). This marks the second and final meeting between the two clubs this season, with the Trash Pandas having taken four of six from the Shuckers at Toyota Field earlier this year (May 27-June 1). After the trip to the Mississippi Gulf Coast, Rocket City returns home to close out July with a six-game homestand against Birmingham, running July 29-August 3.
- SHUCKERS OUTLAST TRASH PANDAS IN WALK-FILLED SERIES OPENER, 5-2: In a 3-hour, 11-minute series opener, the Shuckers edged the Trash Pandas 5-2 on Tuesday night at Keesler Federal Park. Despite collecting nine hits, Rocket City left a season-high 14 runners on base and stranded the bases loaded three times. Biloxi capitalized on 11 walks issued by Trash Pandas pitchers and took an early lead, powered by strong outings from starter Alexander Cornielle and reliever Abdiel Mendoza. Rocket City showed late signs of life but couldn't overcome missed opportunities, dropping the opener of the six-game series
- DID YOU ORDER SOME HITS?: The Trash Pandas are 4-3 over their last seven games, highlighted by a fourgame win streak from July 12-20. During that stretch, they've posted a Double-A best .291 batting average and racked up 67 hits—an average of 9.6 per game, also the highest in Double-A.
- SPICY'S STREAK: JOSE QUIJADA FIRING UP ZEROES: Veteran reliever José "Spicy" Quijada has been lights-out since June 27, tossing 9.0 scoreless innings over his last nine appearances. During that stretch, he's gone 2-0 with 12 strikeouts, just three walks, and a stingy .194 opponent batting average.
- ROCKET CITY IS LIVING UP TO ITS NAME: Since July 3, the Trash Pandas have launched 16 home runs over 14 games, leading the Southern League and ranking third in all of Double-A baseball. That stretch includes a five-homer outburst on July 3 against Knoxville at Toyota Field, tying a franchise record. Prior to that, Rocket City had hit 53 home runs over 76 games—an average of just 0.7 per game. The recent surge has seen that average jump to 1.1 per game, fueled by Oscar Colas and Ben Gobbel, who have combined for nine of the 16 homers. Colás leads the league in that span with five, while Gobbel is right behind with four.
- "YOU CAN'T SCORE IF YOU DON'T GET ON BASE.": Three Trash Pandas enter Wednesday's game riding on-base streaks of at least nine games. Oscar Colás and Nelson Rada lead the way with 11-game streaks, while Sam Brown has reached in nine straight. Denzer Guzman has reached in 16 of his last 18 games, Travis Blankenhorn in 17 of 19, David Mershon in 13 of 14, and Joe Redfield in 13 of 15
- GUZ GONE WILD: DENZER'S BLAZING THROUGH JULY: The San Pedro de Macorís native leads the Southern League and is second in Double-A with a 1.144 OPS in July, and batting .339. He also tops the league—and is tied for first in Double-A—with eight doubles this month, and ranks fourth in RBIs with 14. On July 13 in Chattanooga, he recorded the second 5-hit game in Trash Pandas history, going 5-for-5 with three doubles a home run, and four RBIs.. He now ranks among league leaders in several offensive categories in 2025, including doubles (2nd, 22), extra-base hits (2nd, 34), RBIs (6th, 49), total bases (5th, 130), home runs (T-6th, 11), and slugging (8th, 423)
- SOUND THE BLANKENHORN: OF Travis Blankenhorn has reached base in 17 of his last 19 games, and 25 of 29 since returning from the Injured List on June 13. The veteran outfielder leads the Southern League and ranks fifth in Double-A with a .936 OPS, while batting .265 (27-for-102) with six doubles, eight home runs, 20 RBIs, and 16 walks over that span. During the June 24-29 series at Montgomery, Blankenhorn went 7-for-25 with a double, five home runs, nine RBIs, and a 1.360 OPS. He also became just the fifth Trash Panda to homer in three straight games, doing so from June 22-25.
- COLÁS CLEANING UP FOR PANDAS: Rocket City outfielder Oscar Colás leads Double-A with five home runs in his last 13 games since July 3, along with two doubles, 13 RBIs, eight runs scored, a .292 batting average (14-for-48), and a 1.016 OPS (second in the Southern League). On July 3 vs. Knoxville, Colás recorded his first career three-homer game, hitting solo home runs to lead off the third, fourth, and sixth innings This marked only the second three-homer game in franchise history, the first being Orlando Martinez's performance on May 7, 2021, at Chattanooga.
- RADA REPORT: CF Nelson Rada, the youngest player in the Southern League at just 19 years and 11 months, ranks second in the league and T-5th in all of Double-A with 31 stolen bases this season—19 of which came in a blistering month of May. His 31 steals already rank 3rd in Trash Pandas single-season history, trailing only his own mark of 35 from last year and Kyren Parris' franchise record of 44 set in 2023. Rada ranks among the league leaders in stolen bases (2nd, 31), OBP (6th, .383), batting average (T-8th, .278), and hits (T-7th, 82). Rada has recorded a team-best 26 multi-hit games, including four three-hit games
- GUZMAN AND BROWN GO BACK-TO-BACK FOR LEAGUE POW: INF Denzer Guzman was named Southern League Player of the Week for July 1-6 after leading the league with a 1.316 OPS and seven extra-base hits, along with six RBIs and six walks during a six-game series against Knoxville. One week later, INF Sam Brown earned the honor for July 8-13, posting a league-best .444 batting average (8-for-18) over five games in Rocket City's road series at Chattanooga. Brown added four extra-base hits, six RBIs, five walks, four runs scored, and a 1.398 OPS—also the highest in the league that week. Guzman and Brown became the 13th and 14th players in Trash Pandas history to win the award, and for the second consecutive season, Rocket City produced back-to-back weekly honorees, following **Tucker Flint** (Aug. 12–18) and **Christian Moore** (Aug. 5–11) in 2023.
- ROCKET CITY BRINGS THE ATTENDANCE BOOM: Despite the addition of two brand-new ballparks in Columbus and Knoxville, the Trash Pandas continue to lead the Southern League in attendance, averaging 4,434 fans per game, inlouding an average of 4,911 in July. Rocket City has topped the league in average attendance every season since 2021—a testament to the club's strong fan support and game-day experience.

ADDITIONAL NOTES (CONT)

BACK FROM THE FUTURES GAME: RHP George Klassen made a brief but electric appearance for the American League squad at the Futures Game on July 19, throwing 11 pitches in the bottom of the third inning. He fired two 99 mph heaters—striking out Chicago's Owen Caissie. The No. 3 prospect for the Angels was the only representative for the Angels and became the sixth Rocket City player to earn a Futures Game selection, joining RHP Caden Dana ("24), DF Kyren Paris ("23), C Edgar Quero ("23), RHP Ky Bush ("22), and LHP Reid Detmers ("21).

FARRIS WHEELIN' AND DEALIN STRIKEOUTS: LHP **Mitch Farris** is 3rd in the Southern League in strikeouts with 97 over his first 17 outings in 2025.

BEN JAMMIN': INF **Ben Gobbel** has belted four home runs in his last 13 games, including his second career multi-homer performance on July 8 at Chattanooga—the first also came against the Lookouts on June 6, 2024, at Toyota Field. Since rejoining the Trash Pandas on June 17, the Georgia native is batting .267, a notable improvement from his .228 average over 68 games with Rocket City last season.

KEEPIN' IT QUALITY: Starter Joel Hurtado, has not made a start since June 20, but still ranks 3rd in the Southern League with seven quality starts, and ranks 6th in the Southern League with a 3.10 ERA.

ANOTHER ONE LAUNCHED TO THE LEAGUE: On July 3, INF Chad Stevens made his MLB debut for the Angels, becoming the seventh this season, and 43rd all-time Trash Panda to make their MLB debut. In 17 games for Rocket City in 2024, he hit .316 with two homers, 10 RBIs, and two stolen bases over 17 games. He joins former Pandas, Robinson Piña (debuted on June 20), Christian Moore (debuted on June 13), Alan Rangel (June 6), José Fermin (April 26), Edgar Quero (April 16), and Michael Darrell-Hicks (April 11), who all debuted this year.

NEW HALF, NEW TRASH PANDAS: In June, the Trash Pandas had 25 roster moves impact the roster, with 10 moves coming on June 17. Only 17 of the current 28-man roster were active on May 19. Newcomers joining the club in June include OF Oscar Colás (6/3), 1B Evan Edwards (6/3), INF David Mershon (6/17), INF Ben Gobbel (6/17), LHP A.J. Block (6/17), RHP Sam Ryan (6/17), while OFTravis Blankenhorn (IL, 6/7), C Jaxx Groshans (Dev. List, 6/24) and RHP George Klassen (IL, 6/1) have been reinstated from the IL, or Dev. List.

THE STREAK IS OVER!!!: The Trash Pandas dropped a Southern League record 16 straight games from June 14 to July 2. The streak was the longest in Minor League Baseball this season. The streak surpassed the previous Southern League mark set by the Columbus (GA) Astros in 1971, dropping 15-straight games from May 17-June 1, 1971. That season, the Southern League and Texas League played an interlocking schedule and referred to the agreement as the "Dixie Association".

PROSPECTS WITH A HALO: The Trash Pandas roster features four of the Angels' top 10 prospects and nine of the top 25; included in the top 10 are RHP George Klassen (3), LHP Sam Aldegheri (5), OF Nelson Rada (6), and INF Denzer Guzman (9). The other members of the roster included in the Top-30 include LHP Samy Natera Jr. (16), RHP Walbert Ureña (17), RHP Joel Hurtado (19), and RHP Camden Minacci (21).

THE YOUNG GUNS: The Trash Pandas have three of the nine youngest players in the Southern League. For the second-straight year, OF **Nelson Rada** is the youngest player in the Southern League at 19.9 years old (8/24/05), the only player in the league born in 2005. INF **Denzer Guzman** is the eighth-youngest at 21 years old (2/8/04), and RHP **Walbert Urena** is the ninth-youngest, just 14 days older than Guzman, born on 1/25/04, 21 years old (1/25/04).

DELAYING THE LAUNCH: From June 12-29, the Trash Pandas endured 9 hours and 20 minutes of weather delays, and during the last homestand, June 10-25, they faced delays that totaled 6 hours and 20 minutes. This season, Rocket City has had 14 home games impacted by rain delays or post-ponements, adding up to 9 hours and 2 minutes of total delay time. According to wunderground. com, rain has been recorded on 22 out of 37 home game days.

MAY WAS A GOOD MONTH FOR BROWN AND RADA: Over 26 games in May, Sam Brown finished 4th in the league in batting at .301 (28-for-93), with eight extra-base hits, and 14 RBIs, and Nelson Rada finished 2nd in batting at .325 (27-for-83), and 2nd in OBP (.467). Rada led all of Double-A and was 3rd in MiLB with 19 stolen bases.

ANOTHER WALK-OFF AT TOYOTA FIELD: The June 11th walk-off single in the 10th inning by Cole Fontenelle was the second of the season for the Trash Pandas. This was the first walk-off since Denzer Guzman hit a walk-off homer in the ninth inning on April 5 against Chattanooga. Overall, it marked the 24th walk-off victory for the Trash Pandas at Toyota Field.

MLB EXPERIENCE: The Tash Pandas boast seven players on the roster with Major League experience after the recent additions. Sam Aldegheri made his MLB debut on August 30, 2024, for the Angels, vs. Seattle, and made three starts for the Angels over the remainder of the season. Kelvin Cáceres made his debut for the Angels on September 27, 2023, vs. Texas, and appeared in two total games that season. Jesus Cruz made his MLB debut for on August 18, 2020 for the Cardinals, and has appeared in eight games between the Cardinals ('20) and Braves ('22). Jordan Holloway made his MLB debut on July 26, 2020, for the Martins, and appeared in 15 games (4 starts) for Miami from 2020-2023, posting a 3.29 ERA. Sean Poppen made his MLB debut on June 19, 2019, for the Twins and has appeared in 63 games for the Twins (10), Pirates (3), Rays (1), and Diamondbacks (49) since 2019, posting a 5.08 career ERA. José Quijada made his MLB debut for the Marlins on April 24, 2019, against Cleveland, and has appeared in 140 games for the Marlins (34) and Angels (106) since 2019, logging a 4.64 ERA and eight saves. The only position player with MLB experience is Travis Blankenhorn, who made his MLB debut on September 15, 2020, for the Twins against the White Sox. Overall, he's played in 49 career games for the Twins (2), Mets (24), and Nationals (23) since 2020.

FONTENELLE'S CYCLE: Not only was Cole Fontenelle's cycle on April 8 vs. Knoxville the first in Trash Pandas history, but it was the first in the Southern League since former Smokies star Moises Ballesteros did it on June 15, 2024, at Biloxi. Fontenelle led off each at-bat, which has only been done once in MLB history, by Todd Helton in 1999 against the Florida Marlins. The last LA Angels minor league player to hit for the cycle was José Rojas, who hit for the cycle on May 11, 2018, while playing for the Double-A Mobile BayBears. Rojas completed his cycle with a grand slam in the eighth inning, leading the BayBears to a 14-3 win over the Mississippi Braves at Trustmark Park.
