TODAY'S GAME: Welcome to LoanMart Field! The Quakes continue this series with game two of a six-game home stand tonight against the San Jose Giants (SFG). Tonight is Raising Canes Bark in the Ballpark, as fans can bring their four-legged friends with the purchase of a \$3 Pet Pass, with proceeds to benefit the Rancho Cucamonga Animal Shelter. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE GIANTS: Today's game is the eighth of 18 games against the Giants and the eighth of 12 here at home. Last night's loss drops the Quakes to 4-3 against the Giants in 2025, after winning four of six in a mid-April series here at home. Rancho was 7-5 against the Giants in 2024, 4-2 here at LoanMart Field.

LAST GAME: The Rancho offense was stymied for much of Tuesday night, as the Quakes dropped a 5-2 decision to the San Jose Giants at LoanMart Field. Giants' starter Hunter Dryden (3-0) was dominant, as he allowed one run on four hits over five innings, striking out a career-best eight. Rancho starter Aidan Foeller (2-2) got touched for a pair of early homers, but settled in to give the Quakes five innings of work. Rancho got three hits from both Elijah Hainline and Gio Cueto, with Hainline blasting his second homer of the year and scoring both runs. The Quakes have now dropped two straight overall, while the Giants have won seven of their last eight.

RECAPING THE ROAD TRIP: The recent 12-game road trip was not only their longest of the year, but also the worst, as the Quakes went 2-4 in Stockton and 3-3 in Modesto for a 5-7 trip overall. Their series record overall is now 6-2-1, with both series losses coming in Stockton.

HOW TO WRAP IT UP: After last night's loss, there are only 14 left to play in the first half, with the Quakes having an eight-game lead over Lake Elsinore and nine over Visalia. In theory, the Quakes could clinch as soon as Saturday night, but that would require four straight losses for Lake Elsinore, three losses in four games for Visalia and four straight Rancho wins over San Jose. After this series, the Quakes will head to last-place Inland Empire for six, before finishing the half at home with three against second-place Lake Elsinore. This week, the Storm are in Modesto, while the Rawhide are home against Inland Empire. Next week, the Visalia Rawhide travel to Lake Elsinore for six. Meanwhile, there's real drama up north, as San Jose and Modesto are tied with 14 to play.

QUINTERO FOR THE SECOND TIME: For the second time this year, Eduardo Quintero was named Player of the Week Award, after torching Modesto last week, hitting .480 (12-for-25) with a homer, seven RBIs, four walks and four stolen bases. He's currently leading the league in homers (9), fifth in the league in RBIs (35), fifth in on-base percentage (.427) third in average (.333) and tied for first in hits (60). He also leads the league in slugging (.606) and is now first in OPS at 1.033. MLB Pipeline rates him as the Dodgers' eighth-best prospect.

JAKOB WRIGHT: 21-year-old left-hander Jakob Wright makes his fifth appearance of his pro career and first against San Jose. Wright has been on the Injured List once in 2025 and also missed a nearly-three-week stretch where he actually never went on the IL. In his last outing, he got the start in Modesto on May 29th and allowed two unearned runs on three hits over just two innings, marking the first runs he's allowed in his pro career. Wright was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2024 draft out of Cal Poly Pomona.

NIKO MAZZA: Right-hander Niko Mazza makes his ninth start of the year and second against the Quakes. In his lone outing against Rancho, he allowed five unearned runs on three hits over 3.2 innings in a loss on April 16th. In his last start overall, he allowed one run on three hits over four innings in a no-decision against the 66ers on May 28th. Mazza played college ball at Southern Mississippi and was drafted by the Giants in the eighth round of the 2024 draft.
