YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox saw their late rally fall just short on Friday in a 4-3 loss to Akron. The RubberDucks built a 4-0 lead, before the Chesapeake comeback effort was sparked by **Adam Retzbach**, who reached base four times and had three hits. Retzbach crushed a solo homer in the seventh to get the Baysox on the board. **Anthony Servideo** tripled home a pair in the ninth, but was stranded on third base as the game's tying run. **Doug Hodo** flew out to the warning track to end the game on a running catch from Akron's Joe Lampe. The loss was Chesapeake's ninth in a row.

ROAD RETZ

After enduring an 0-for-24 and 1-for-29 stretch entering play Thursday, C/1B **Adam Retzbach** has gone five for his last seven and reached base six times over the past two games. Friday night, Retzbach finished a triple shy of the cycle and tallied his fourth three-hit game of the season and the fifth such game of his professional career. Retzbach has been one of the Baysox best hitters in 2025 - particularly away from home. On the road this season, Retzbach is hitting .309 with an .895 OPS (both 4th in the EL - min. 150 PA). 13 of Retzbach's 16 doubles and 18 of his 28 extra-base hits have been on the road this season.

SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

IF **Brandon Butterworth** has adjusted to his new scenery just fine. Part of the return in the Ryan O'Hearn/Ramon Laureano trade, Butterworth has reached base in his first six games since joining the Orioles organization and immediately being promoted to Double-A. Butterworth had the sixth-most extra-base hits (35) and most triples (7) in the Midwest League during his time with High-A Fort Wayne (SD). Saturday night is Butterworth's first start in the outfield for the Baysox, where he played five times for Fort Wayne this season after playing strictly on the infield through college and his first professional season in 2024.

PHAMILY REUNION

Right-hander **Alex Pham** is set to start for the Baysox on Saturday. It will be the right-handers first start for Chesapeake since April 27 due to a forearm injury. Pham's 35 strikeouts back in the month of April led the Eastern League at the time of his injury.

BULLPEN TROUBLES

The bullpen has been one of the strengths for Chesapeake in 2025, posting a 3.36 ERA. However, Baysox relievers have struggled as of late. In the last nine games, the Chesapeake bullpen has allowed 24 earned runs across its last 36 innings (6.00 ERA - 3rd-highest in Double-A).

CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL

Chesapeake has won 21 games in one-run fashion - which is the most in the Eastern League and is the second most in all of Double-A. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is the most in full-season MiLB. The Baysox have played 38 one-run games this season, which is second-most in all of Double-A.

WHERE THE RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD

The Akron RubberDucks - Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, currently sit at 18-19 in the second half and third in the Southwest division. This comes after the RubberDucks narrowly missed out on the first half title. Akron is led by the 2024 No. 1 overall pick Travis Bazzana (No. 13 OVR prospect, per MLB.com). This is the back-half of a two-week homestand for Akron, who split with Erie last week. The Baysox enter with the third-highest road winning percentage (.571) in the league this season.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Yorman Gomez is Saturday's projected starter for Akron. Gomez has pitched just three times for Akron, but already has two winning decisions. He's allowed 11 hits and six walks in 13.1 innings at Double-A, but allowed just a single earned run. Gomez allowed an unearned run on five hits in four and a third innings against Erie last time out. Gomez spent the first three-and-a-half months of the season with High-A Lake County, where he posted a 2.84 ERA in 76 innings. He was an international free agent signing of Cleveland in 2019 out of Venezuela.

Collected 3rd-most K in Eastern League and 6th-most in Double-A last year

2025: Activated off IL on 8/5. First start for Baysox since 4/27. Made one rehab start each with FCL-Orioles on 7/21 and High-A Aberdeen on 8/2 (3.1 scoreless IP with 2 K). Placed on IL 5/3. Struck out Double-A high 11 in 5.1 IP on 4/22 vs ALT....Enters third season in Chesapeake. Named Opening Day starter for second year in a row. Only second Baysox pitcher ever to receive two Opening Day starts.

2024: Spent entire season in Double-A Bowie. Completed second season as full-time starter after beginning pro career in bullpen. Named Opening Night starter. Pitched career-high 119.0 IP and struck out career-high 138 batters over 50 walks to a 4.24 ERA. Led team in IP and K. Finished 2nd in O's system in K and IP. Was 3rd in Eastern League and 6th in Double-A in K. 2nd in EL and 4th in Double-A in K/9 (10.44). After a 5.85 ERA in first half, posted 2.59 ERA in second half. Allowed only 3 HR in second half after allowing 11 HR in first half. Named EL Pitcher of Week for 7/9 -7/14 for first time in career after dealing 6.0 shutout IP with 6 K on 7/11 @ Altoona. Threw 19 consecutive scoreless innings from 8/1- 8/18, which was longest scoreless streak by a Baysox pitcher this season. Baysox won 16 of last 23 games that Pham has started in.

Career Notes: Began '23 season with High-A Aberdeen, going 3-3 with a 2.45 ERA in 12 outings. Won South Atlantic League Pitcher of the Month award in May, posting a 1.54 ERA and 34 K in 23.1 IP. Promoted to Bowie on 6/2. Was named an Orioles' Organizational All-Star in 2023....Spent first portion of '22 on the IL before eventually being activated by Single-A Delmarva on April 26. Earned promotion to Aberdeen on May 24...Debuted professionally in '21 between FCL – Orioles and Delmarva.

College: Pitched for four seasons at the University of San Francisco, finishing 7th in program history with 215 strikeouts and fourth with 11 saves.

Personal: Drafted by the Orioles in the 19th round of the '21 Draft out of San Francisco...Holds a black belt in kung fu. Skilled with martial arts weapons. Favorite pitcher growing up was Tim Lincecum.

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

Roberto Mercado returns for his second season as Baysox Manager in 2025 after completing his first year at the Double-A level last season. The 17th manager in franchise history, he led the Baysox to a 62-75 overall record, oversaw 18 player promotions to Triple-A and coached two former Baysox who would go on to make their Major League debuts in the same season. In November 2024, the Baysox officially announced the team's renaming to the Chesapeake Baysox during a special event at The Chesapeake Bay Foundation in Annapolis, Maryland.

The updated team name represents a new chapter in Baysox baseball, expanding the brand to better reflect the broad and diverse community of fans who support the team across the region. The Baysox will continue to play at their home, Prince George's Stadium, in Bowie, Maryland.

The Chesapeake Baysox logos were created by Baltimore-based Younts Design, whose clients over the years have included a variety of professional baseball teams (including the Baltimore Orioles).



ALTERNATE IDENTITIES

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE



The Cangrejos Fantasma De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™" - a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasma de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

BOWIE PIT BEEF



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
