NOTES AND NUGGETS

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

After an 0-4 start to the season, the Storm Chasers have won 9 of their last 13 games, including their last two series.

Last season, the Storm Chasers won just 6 of 27 series played ... after winning 4 of 6 games from Buffalo from March 31 to April 5, the Chasers won 3 of 5 in Iowa last week ... Omaha also won the first 2 games this week against Indianapolis.

DÉJÀ VU ALL OVER AGAIN

The Chasers have seen more success in recent years against Indianapolis than any other International League club, with a 55-31 record in 86 games since 2021.

A .640 winning percentage vs. Indianapolis is Omaha's best among the 7 opponents the Chasers have seen at least 20 times since 2021.

Among 54 IL matchups that have happened at least 20 times since 2021, Omaha's .640 winning percentage against Indianapolis is the 4th-best.

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Omaha Storm Chasers own the 3rd-best fielding percentage in the International League at .985, committing just 9 errors in 17 games, trailing Rochester (.991) and St. Paul (.986) and tied 8th among the 120 full season Minor League teams.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - of Omaha's 13 qualified fielders at a single position in the IL this season (min. 40.0 inn), 8 have a perfect 1,000 fielding percentage, with just 5 position players charged with an error ... **Kevin Newman** (100.0 innings) **Peyton Wilson** (83.1 innings), **Brandon Drury** (60.1 innings) and **Connor Kaiser** (59.1 innings) have been errorless in the infield, while **Kameron Misner** (134.1 innings) and **Gavin Cross** (107.1 innings) have been flawless in the outfield.

Toro has participated in 11 double plays while **Josh Rojas** has turned 9 - Omaha's 20 double plays turned as a team rank 2nd-most in the International League.

CHALLENGING THE SYSTEM

The Omaha Storm Chasers have been the best team in Triple-A at converting ABS challenges in their favor in 2026.

Omaha's 60% win rate on challenges ranks 5th at the Triple-A level ... 29 successful challenges are tied for the 3rd-most converted challenges (1st: Buffalo & Albuquerque, 30), while 48 total challenges rank 5th in Triple-A.

The Storm Chasers' success is driven largely by how aggressive their catchers have been ... **Elias Diaz** and **Luca Tresh** have challenged at a 3.2% rate, tied for the 2nd-highest among all 30 Triple-A clubs, yet have won 18 of 29 defensive challenges (62%), combining for a level-leading 6 strikeout flips and 4 walk flips.

At the plate, Omaha hitters have challenged at a 50% rate and converted 11 of 19 (60%), with 7 of the team's 11 challengers going a perfect 1-for-1 ... 5 strikeouts flips from the hitters rank tied for 2nd while 2 walk flips are tied 5th in Triple-A.

MISNER ON A MISSION

Outfielder **Kameron Misner** has been the heart of Omaha's offense to open the 2026 season.

Misner has reached base safely in 14 of 16 games this season, with hits in 13 of 16 ... he produced a league-best 11-game hitting streak from March 28 to April 10, going 13-for-37 (.351) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 14 RBI ... his 18 RBI rank 4th in the International League and tied 6th among all Minor League hitters.

Misner has driven in a run in 11 of 16 games ... prior to last Saturday, he had driven in runs in 6 straight contests, a stretch (April 4 to 10) where he hit .409 (9-for-22) with 10 RBI ... he homered the first two games of last week's series, April 7 and 8.

LET'S RAVE

Monday, Storm Chasers outfielder **John Rave** was recognized as the International League's Player of the Week for his performance last week in Iowa.

Rave went 9-for-19 (.474 average) at the plate against the Cubs ... he connected for 3 doubles and 2 homers with a league-leading 18 total bases and 9 RBI ... he posted a league-best .500 OBP, .947 SLG and 1.447 OPS, while adding 2 steals, 3 walks and three multi-hit games in the series.

In his fifth Triple-A season, Rave is hitting .296 (16-for-54) with a .920 OPS through 15 games ... he leads Omaha with 13 walks, while 2nd on the team in average, on-base percentage (.420), slugging (.500) and OPS.

- Ryan Ramsey is making his **4th overall appearance** with the Storm Chasers this year and his **3rd start** of the season with Omaha.
- Playing his **5th professional season** this year, all in the Royals organization.
- This is Ramsey's **2nd career start** against Indianapolis ... he made his Triple-A debut against the Indians last year, with a spot start on May 1, 2025 ... he allowed 4 runs on 4 hits over 3.1 innings in a losing effort.

RECENT FORM

- STARTER'S ORDERS:** Ramsey made just two spot starts last year for Omaha, but cracked the Storm Chasers' Opening Day roster ... when he opened last year in Double-A, his first appearance came as a "piggyback" pitcher behind starter Hunter Owen ... in 2024, his first 4 outings of last year came in relief, while 2 of his first 3 appearances this year have been starts.
- Y2K ROTATION:** Ramsey is one of five players on the Chasers' active roster, and one of three starting pitchers that were born in 2001, however he is the oldest of the five ... he's approximately 7 months older than Lunder Avila (born 8/21/01).

LAST OUTING: SATURDAY, APRIL 11 @ IOWA

- In his 2nd start of the season, opened the afternoon with 4.0 scoreless innings ... double plays erased baserunners in the 1st and 3rd, while he worked a 1-2-3 inning in the 2nd and struck out the side in the 4th ... got the first two outs of the 5th, but 5 batters reached base and scored 3 runs to end his outing.

2026 HIGHLIGHTS

- Appeared in 1 Cactus League game with the Royals while up from Minor League camp, working 1.0 scoreless inning ... opened the 2026 season on the Storm Chasers' roster.
- Worked 5.0 innings of 1-run relief on April 5 vs. Buffalo (TOR), 1 out shy of tying his longest career relief appearance.

CAREER NOTES

- 2025**
- Began the season with Northwest Arkansas (AA) and spent most of the year in Double-A, also making a pair of spot starts for Omaha ... posted a 5.54 ERA (65 ER in 105.2 IP) in 25 appearances (18 starts) at Double-A ... his 114 total strikeouts ranked tied with **Shane Panzini** for the Royals organization lead.
 - Pitched to a 3.73 ERA (17 ER in 41.0 IP) over his first 9 appearances (7 starts) from April 9 to May 31 which included a 5.2-inning, 5 strikeout, scoreless performance May 18 @ Tulsa (LAD).
 - Made his first Double-A start on April 15 @ San Antonio (SD), throwing 5.2 innings of no-hit ball to start what became the fourth no-hitter in Nationals history ... relievers **Chazz Martinez**, **Ryan Brady** & **Brandon Johnson** finished it off ... was NWA's third combined no-no, the club's first no-hitter since 2013.
 - Was transferred to Omaha on April 30 and made his Triple-A debut on May 1 vs. Indianapolis (PIT) ... returned to the Nationals on May 2 and returned to Omaha for a start on September 19 @ Columbus (CLE).

MINOR LEAGUE CAREER

- Spent the entire 2024 season with Quad Cities (A+), splitting time between the bullpen and as a starter ... appeared in 22 games (11 starts) with a 2.43 ERA (24 ER in 89.0 IP) and 97 strikeouts to 30 walks (3.23 K/BB) at High-A ... had a career-high 25.2-inning scoreless streak from July 25 to August 27, the River Bandits' longest scoreless streak in their Royals-affiliate era (since 2021).
- Largely split 2023 between Columbia (A) and Quad Cities (A+), but also made 2 rehab appearances (1 start) with the ACL Royals (R) ... pitched to a 0.54 ERA (2 ER in 33.1 IP) with 38 strikeouts across 7 starts with Columbia before earning a promotion to Quad Cities ... made 5 appearances (2 starts) at High-A with 22 strikeouts in 14.1 innings (13.8 K/9) ... set a fireflies record with a 24.0-inning scoreless streak from April 21 to July 29, spanning 5 outings and stints on the Development List and Injured List.
- Made his professional debut in 2022 with the ACL Royals (Rk) after Kansas City drafted him in the 13th round of the 2022 MLB Draft ... pitched in 1 game in the ACL that season, a scoreless, 2.0-inning relief appearance with 3 strikeouts against the ACL Diamondbacks Red (AZ).

MISCELLANEOUS

- Pitched 3 seasons (2020-22) for the University of Maryland (Big Ten), working a career 17-2 record with a 3.13 ERA (47 ER in 135.0 IP) and 140 strikeouts to 58 walks (2.41 K/BB) for the Terrapins ... named 2022 First Team All-Big Ten and 2021 Second Team All-Big Ten ... in 2022, went 11-1 with a 3.22 ERA (33 ER in 92.1 IP) and 90 strikeouts to 41 walks (2.20 K/BB) across 16 appearances (15 starts).
- Threw a 9.0-inning perfect game for the University of Maryland on April 29, 2022 against Northwestern.
- Was drafted by Cleveland in the 36th round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of Pascack Hills High School but elected not to sign and instead attend the University of Maryland.
