On this date in 2009, the Sounds won 8-4 at Salt Lake with a pair of 3-hit perforand Mat Gamel. Adam Heether contributed with 3 RBI, including a 2-run homer in the 9th. Chris Cody picked up one of his eight wins that season (6.0 IP, 10 H, 3 R, 3 BB, 4 K).

Among League Leaders: Shortstop Brice Turang continues to pace among the best hitters in the International League. Amongst all IL hitters, Turang is 2nd in hits (113), 3rd in runs (66), tied for 6th in stolen bases (23) and ninth in batting average (.288). Jon Singleton is 1st in walks (84), tied for 7th in home runs (19) and 10th in on-base percentage (.377).

Big Hits, Every Game: Brice Turang has hit safely in 17 consecutive games, the longest streak by a Sounds player in 2022. During Turang's current 17-game hitting streak, he's batting .323 (21-for-65) with 18 runs,

on-base streak (5/13-6/12). Both streaks are the longest active streaks in the International League, respec-

5 doubles, 4 home runs, 12 RBI, 13 walks and 5 stolen bases. He has also reached safely in 24 straight games which is the longest on-base streak for the Sounds this season, passing Jonathan Davis's 23-game

mances from Corey Patterson Pablo's Streak: Infielder Pablo Reyes had two hits yesterday to extend his on-base streak to 22 games, the second-longest active on-base streak in the International League. Reyes is hitting .402 (33-for-82) with 14 runs, 8 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs, 16 RBI and 13 walks during the streak.

> 200-Plus: Rick Sweet won his 211th game as Nashville's manager on Wednesday, good for 5th-most in franchise history. Don Money has the 4th-most wins in franchise history with 223. As well as Nashville, Sweet has 200+ wins with four other Triple-A teams: 1993-95 Tucson (251), 2001-03 Portland (212), 2005-11 Louisville (539) and 2015-18 Colorado Springs (282).

LAST OUTING: Lindblom last pitched on July 5 at Norfolk in game four of the series. He took the loss, allowing four runs on three hits and three walks in 5.0 innings. Lindblom struck out six Tides on 82 pitches (52 strikes).

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Lindblom's fourth start against the Stripers in 2022.
