Today's Game: The Sounds take on the Mud Hens in game two of the three game series. Toledo took control early and held on late for a 4-2 win in their home opener. Right-hander Evan McKendry will try and even the series, making his first start in the second game of the season. He'll go against Toledo's Keider Montero.

Evan McKendry: The 26-year-old makes his ninth start with Nashville after being traded to Milwaukee from Tampa Bay in exchange for catcher Alex Jackson on August 1, 2023. McKendry returns to the Triple-A level after a strong 2023 campaign, spent mostly with Durham. He led the International League in wins and tied for the league lead in shutouts. McKendry was named the league Pitcher of the Month and Tampa Bay's Minor League Pitcher of the Month in May after going 3-0 with a 0.31 ERA (29.1 IP/1 ER) in five outings (4 starts) for the Bulls. He also earned the IL Pitcher of the Week honor three times for May 8-14, Ma 29-June 4 and August 21-27. The Pembroke Pines, Fla. native was originally selected in the ninth round of the 2019 First-Year Player Draft by the Rays out of the University of Miami.

Keider Montero: The 23-year-old is also making his ninth appearance (8th start) with Toledo after finishing last season on the Mud Hens pitching staff. Montero had a breakout season in 2023, finishing 15-4 with a 4.66 ERA (127.1 IP/66 ER) between Double-A Erie (15), Toledo and High-A West Michigan (4). He is listed as the No. 9 prospect in the Tigers system by MLB Pipeline. Montero has a four pitch mix of fastball, curveball, slider and changeup. He was added to Detroit's 40-man roster in the offseason to avoid free agency. Montero was born in Santa Teresa del Tuy, Venezuela on July 6, 2000 and signed with the Tigers for \$40,000 in 2016.

Opening Day Blues: The Sounds lost on Opening Day for the 25th time in franchise history, snapping a short winning streak after taking back-to-back victories to start the season in 2022 vs. Durham and 2023 vs. Louisville. Each of their most recent Opening Day losses have come at Toledo (May 4, 2021 and yesterday). Nashville pitchers combined for 14 strikeouts, the most in a Sounds opener since April 4, 2019 vs. Iowa (Nashville also lost that game 5-4).

Paint it Black: Tyler Black picked up where he left off last season, adding a hit in yesterday's contest. Dating back to September 7, 2023, Black has a 15-game hitting streak with the Sounds. He's batting .439 (25-for-57) with 17 runs, 5 doubles, 2 triples, 2 home runs, 11 RBI and 8 walks during the streak. Only Luken Baker's 18-game hitting streak is longer in the league, dating back to last season.

It's Miller Time: Owen Miller added a pair of doubles, including a run-scoring smack to the left field wall in the sixth inning. It was Miller's fifth multi-extra-base hit game and third multi-double performance since joining the Brewers organization last season. In 30 career Sounds games, Miller is batting .291 (32-for-110) with 10 doubles and 18 RBI.

Raging Bullpen: The Sounds bullpen kept them in the game yesterday, limiting Toledo to a run over five innings of work. Kevin Herget worked a scoreless fourth and fifth inning, scattering three hits in his debut with Nashville. Ryan Middendorf added 1.1 scoreless (2 K) and veteran Rob Zastryzny retired the side in order in the eighth.

Dorrian Did Not Miss: Patrick Dorrian scored Nashville's first run with a solo shot off the batter's eye in the third inning. His 440 foot blast was his fifth home run of at least 440 feet since the start of the 2023 season. Since the Sounds joined the International League in 2021, Dorrian has the third-most home runs by a Sounds player with 33, trailing only Keston Hiura with 37 and Jon Singleton with 34.

It Seems We've Got Your Attention: Nashville and Toledo played in front of a crowd of 12,800 fans at Fifth Third Field yesterday afternoon. According to Mud Hens officials, it was the fifth-largest Opening Day crowd in ballpark history. Home or away, it was the largest Opening Day crowd to watch the Sounds since April 4, 2001, when the Sounds and Redbirds played in front of an attendance of 15,776 fans at the then-new AutoZone Park (Memphis won 3-2).

The Sweet Life: Manager Rick Sweet returns for his fourth consecutive season as the Sounds manager (5th overall) and his 34th season as a manager in MiLB. Sweet is the winningest manager in Nashville Sounds history, earning his 321st victory in the 2023 season finale vs. Jacksonville. This is his 11th season as manager of the Brewers' Triple-A affiliate and boasts a 683-584 record (Nashville in 2014, Colorado Springs from 2015-18, San Antonio in 2019 and Nashville 2021-). Overall, Sweet has a career managerial record of 2,275-2,104 - that's the fifth most wins in MiLB history and second among active managers (only Buddy Bailey with Single-A Myrtle Beach has more wins).

Sounds Manager Rick Sweet ranks fifth among Minor League managers in wins. He has the second-most among active managers, trailing Single-A Myrtle Beach manager Buddy Bailey.

MCKENDRY'S 2023 GAME-BY-GAME WITH DURHAM & NASHVILLE

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is McKendry's first career start against Toledo.

- After tough April (6.75 ERA in 6 G), went 3-0 with a 0.31 ERA (29.1 IP/1 ER) in five May games (4 starts)... included was six scoreless innings against Nashville on May 18 (2 H, 2 BB, 8 K)...was named International League Pitcher of the Month after leading minor leagues in ERA and ranking second in opponent average (.111)
- Named International League Pitcher of the Week for May 8-14 after holding Charlotte to two hits over 7.0 shutout innings on May 12 (2 BB, 6 K)...earned honor again for May 29-June 4 after seven-inning complete game shutout of Jacksonville in first game of May 31 twin bill (2 H, 6 K)
