Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Iowa Cubs will assume their Copa de la Diversión identities tonight, taking the diamond as Las Vihuelas de Nashville and Deminios de Des Moines in game five of the series. The Sounds took last night's contest 7-4. Righty Caleb Boushley gets the ball for Nashville, while Chicago pitching prospect Ben Brown makes the starts for Iowa.

Caleb Boushley: 29-year-old Caleb Boushley makes his IL-leading 11th start for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 2-1 with a 4.50 ERA (40.0 IP/20 ER). His last outing came on May 21 at Durham, when he allowed two runs in 4.0 innings, striking out four in a no-decision. Last season with the Sounds, Boushley went 12-2 with a 3.25 ERA across 25 starts, tying for the league lead in wins and finishing second in ERA. He was selected by Milwaukee in the Triple-A phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. The Wisconsinite was originally drafted by the Padres in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

Ben Brown: 23-year-old Ben Brown gets the start for Los Demonios tonight. The right-hander is 1-2 with a 4.34 ERA (18.2 IP/9 ER) through four starts with Iowa. In his last outing on May 21, Brown took the loss despite allowing just one run in 4.0 innings. The New York native started the season with Double-A Tennessee, giving up one earned run in 20.0 innings before his promotion on April 29. Last season, Brown went 6-5 with a 3.38 ERA in 23 starts between High-A Jersey Shore (PHI) and Double-A Tennessee. The Cubs' No. 6 prospect per MLB Pipeline, Brown was originally selected by Philadelphia in the 33rd round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft and was traded to Chicago-NL in exchange for RHP David Robertson on August 2, 2022.

Louie Two-Bags: Brewers first baseman Luke Voit knocked a pair of doubles and paced the team with three RBI last night. Voit has reached in all six games on the rehab stint with four hits (three for extra bases), five RBI and seven walks. Luis Urias did not play last night and is 0-for-9 through two games. Urias is the fifth Brewers player to join the Sounds on rehab this season (RHP Adrian Houser, OF Tyrone Taylor, RHP Gus Varland and INF Luke Voit).

Big Bat Pat Strikes Again: Patrick Dorrian swatted another home run last night, the third in as many appearances for the infielder. He's driven in eight over the span. The last time he had homered in three straight games was August 23-25, 2022 in Durham. He ranks third on the team in home runs this season with seven, despite playing in just 24 games. Dorrian also ranks third on the Sounds with 20 RBI.

Sterio to the Show: Andruw Monasterio was selected to Milwaukee today, lining him up to make his Major League debut. Monasterio was amid a 26-game on-base streak, the third-longest by a Sounds player this season (Toro, 31 & Singleton, 27) and the second-longest active streak in the International League (Spencer Horwitz of Buffalo, 28). Monasterio was tied with Eddy Alvarez for the team lead in stolen bases (11).

Pitcher Perfect: The Sounds pitching staff holds a 4.04 ERA (418.2 IP/188 ER), just trailing Norfolk's ERA of 4.02 for the best mark in Triple-A. Nashville hurlers pace the International League in WHIP (1.34) and have the fewest walks (189). The bullpen holds the lowest ERA among relievers at 3.49 (229.2 IP/89 ER).

Spray-ton Henry: Payton Henry bashed four hits last night, matching a career-high he'd set three times previously, most recently on June 2, 2021 with Biloxi. It was the Sounds' third four-hit performance of the season. Henry has been on a tear, batting .432 (16-for-37) with a 1.135 OPS over nine May appearances.

First (In A While): Darrell Thompson earned his first Triple-A win Nashville last night, tossing a clean eighth inning. Thyago Vieira earned the save, his first of the season, and his first in affiliated baseball since July 29, 2019 at Norfolk. Vieira spent 2020-22 in Japan's Nippon Professional Baseball.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville currently has three players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects, which has been updated due to the recent graduations of INF Brice Turang and OF Joey Wiemer. Outfielder Sal Frelick is the No. 2 prospect, left-handed pitcher Robert Gasser is the No. 7 prospect and left-handed pitcher Ethan Small is the No. 11 prospect.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his fourth season overall and third consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. The reigning International League Manager of the Year, Sweet led the Sounds to a 91-58 record in 2022, 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season and has compiled a 625-541 record during an eight-season span.

LAST OUTING: Boushley tossed 4.0 innings against the Durham Bulls last time out in his start on May 21. He allowed two earned runs on three hits, walked three and struck out four. Boushley did not factor into the decision as Nashville won 6-4 in 10 innings.

AGAINST OPPONENT: This is Boushley's first career appearance against Iowa.
