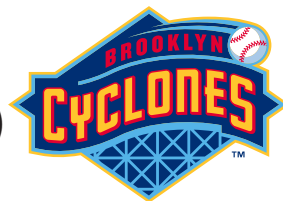

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn captured their 7th win in 9 games with a 3-2 walk-off win vs. Winston-Salem on Friday...2B **Chase Estep** started the bottom of the 9th with a triple and scored on 1B **José Mena's** game-winning single to left...The Dash jumped out to a 2-0 lead after 2 innings...Cyclones tied it on a single and error off the bat of CF **Alex Ramírez** in the 3rd and a double by Mena in the 4th...Mena finished with 2 hits and RBI...Estep and SS **Kevin Kendall** added multi-hit games for Brooklyn...RHP **Jeffrey Colón** tossed a season-high-tying 6.2 innings and struck out a career-best 9...LHP **Quinn Brodey** and RHP **Jace Beck** combined to hurl 2.1 frames of hitless relief.

TUNE-UP TIME: C **Omar Narváez** joined the Cyclones on a Major League rehab assignment on Thursday...He went 0-for-1 in his initial game with a walk and a strikeout, playing a scheduled 5 innings...The 31-year-old landed on the Mets' 10-day injured list on April 7 (retro 4/6) with a left calf strain...Narváez was transferred to the 60-day IL on May 4...In 5 games with New York, the Maracay, Venezuela native was 4-for-14 with the bat (.286), adding a pair of RBI...Narváez has appeared in 605 Major League games, slashing .258/.343/.385 and a .728 OPS with the Mets, Milwaukee Brewers, Seattle Mariners, and Chicago White Sox...He was named a National League All-Star with Milwaukee in 2021...Narváez last played on Coney Island with the Hudson Valley Renegades in 2013, when both were members of the New York-Penn League...He was 1-for-8 with 3 strikeouts in 2 games.

WALK (OFF) ON THE WILD SIDE: 1B **José Mena's** game-winning single in the bottom of the 9th on Friday provided Brooklyn its 4th walk-off win of 2023...1B **Chase Estep** delivered a game-ending, bases-loaded walk in the 11th on Opening Day vs. Jersey Shore...LF **Alex Ramírez** registered a walk-off RBI single in the 11th vs. Wilmington on April 22 and LF **Omar De Los Santos** provided a game-winning single in the 10th vs. Aberdeen...The Cyclones have at least 1 walk-off win in each home series this year...Brooklyn garnered 4 walk-off wins through the entirety of the 2022 campaign.

JEFE JEFFREY: RHP **Jeffrey Colón** matched his team season-high with 6.2 innings of 2-run ball in a no-decision on Friday night...The 23-year-old also matched a career-best with 9 strikeouts...That equaled his total from last August 28 at Jersey Shore...In his last 2 home starts, Colón has hurled 13.1 innings, allowing just 3 runs on 9 hits...The Las Matas de Farfán, D.R. native has a 2.03 ERA and permitted only 3 walks and punched out 16 in that span.

PITCHABILITY: The Cyclones' pitching staff has been marvelous over the course of the team's last 9 games...Since May 17, Brooklyn has permitted just 12 earned runs (18 total) on 52 hits through the last 78.2 innings...That is good for a 1.37 ERA...Cyclones' pitching has walked 34 and struck out 93 in that span...Brooklyn's team ERA during the stretch is nearly a full run better than the 2nd-best ERA by a South Atlantic League club...Greenville has a 2.30 ERA (22 ER in 86.0 IP) since that date...The 'Clones have outscored opponents, 42-18, over the 9-game stretch...Brooklyn is 7-2 during that span...On the year, the Cyclones are 2nd in the SAL in ERA (3.97)...Only Hudson Valley (3.94) has a better mark.

BULL-PEN ON PARADE: The Cyclones' relief staff has been exquisite at quelling fires in 2023...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has the best bullpen ERA (3.28) in the entire South Atlantic League...Wilmington (3.59) is 2nd in the circuit...The Cyclones' relief ERA is also the best in the New York Mets' farm system by a wide margin...Class-A St. Lucie is 2nd, about a run and a half behind (4.74)...Brooklyn is tied with the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (Milwaukee) for the best bullpen ERA at the High-A level...The 3.28 ERA is tied for 5th best in all of Minor League Baseball.

CYCLONE SHUFFLE: Brooklyn made a series of roster moves prior to Saturday's affair...RHP **Brendan Hardy** rejoined the squad from Class-A St. Lucie, while LHP **Daniel Juárez** and RHP **Kolby Kubichek** were transferred to Double-A Binghamton...In 17 regular season appearances with the 'Clones dating back to last season, Juárez yielded only 2 unearned runs in 20.0 innings...The 22-year-old has not surrendered an earned run in 25 straight appearances dating back to last year...Juárez last allowed earned runs on June 22, 2022, with St. Lucie at Palm Beach...Hardy made 17 relief appearances with Brooklyn in 2022, tallying a 1-0 record and a 3.48 ERA (8 ER in 20.2 IP)...Kubichek has garnered a 6.48 ERA (6 ER in 8.1 IP) and 1 save in 6 relief outings over 2 separate stints on Coney Island.

IN THE 'PALM' OF HIS HAND: IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** has scattered himself across the Cyclones' all-time leaderboards...Entering Saturday, the 22-year-old is Brooklyn's franchise record holder in games played (176), at-bats (580), plate appearances (692), runs scored (92), walks (93), and stolen bases (44)...Palmer passed INF **Ronny Mauricio** '21 for 2nd place in Cyclones

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn returns to Coney Island for a 6-game set against the White Sox High-A affiliate...The Dash poses 9 of Chicago's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...RHP **Norge Vera** (8), RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (11), RHP **Kohl Simas** (13), RHP **Jared Kelley** (14), OF **Wilfred Veras** (17), INF **Wes Kath** (18), OF **Terrell Tatum** (24), INF **Loidel Chapellí** (26), and RHP **Andrew Dalquist** (28) are featured...The Cyclones went dropped 5-of-6 to Winston-Salem in their first meeting at Truist Stadium from April 11-16...In last year's meeting at Maimonides Park, Brooklyn split the 6-game set from August 2-7.

history in RBI (64) on Tuesday and is 5 behind INF **José Peroza** (69) for the all-time mark...The Canarsie native is 2nd all-time in total bases (188), tied for 5th in home runs (15), and 6th in hits (110).

THRILL OF THE 'CHASE': After a bumpy month of April, INF **Chase Estep** has picked up the pace at the plate in the season's second month...Entering Saturday, former Kentucky Wildcat has an 8-game hitting streak stretching back to May 14 at Wilmington...Estep is hitting .357 (10-28) with 5 runs scored, 4 doubles, 2 triples, and 7 RBI with a 1.043 OPS...In his last 15 games played dating back to May 5, the 23-year-old is slashing .327/.375/.577 with a .952 OPS...Estep has accumulated 9 runs scored, 6 doubles, 2 triples, a home run, and 10 RBI in 56 plate appearances...The Corbin, Ky. native has also registered a 10 wRC+...Estep has garnered at least one knock in 13 of those 15 games...In his first 12 outings, he was just 2-for-43 (.047) at the dish with a wRC+ of -21.

RAMÍ ROCKETS: OF **Alex Ramírez** has reached base safely in 8-straight games since May 18...In that time, the 20-year-old is slashing .345/.441/.586 with a 1.027 OPS...Ramírez has 3 runs scored, 4 doubles, a home run, 6 RBI, and 5 walks in those contests...Since joining Brooklyn's roster on July 4 of last year, Ramírez leads the South Atlantic League in hits (102), doubles (25), and total bases (153)...He only trails teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (36) in extra-base hits (34) and is tied with Jersey Shore's 1B **Rixon Wingrove** in RBI (57).

OMAR ON THE RUN: In addition to his 16 stolen bases in 2023, OF **Omar De Los Santos** remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The 23-year-old has accumulated 86 stolen bases in that span, which tied for 4th most in MiLB...Only Red Sox prospect INF **David Hamilton** (94), Aberdeen OF **Luis Valdez** (93), Marlins farmhand INF **Nasim Núñez** (92) and have nabbed more...De Los Santos has also snagged 49 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 37...Omar is already 16 swipes shy of matching INF **Walter Rasquin's** franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017.

STU'S CRUISE: RHP **Tyler Stuart** has been as consistent as any starting pitcher in the South Atlantic League in 2023...The 23-year-old extended his scoreless inning streak to 14.2 innings with 6.1 spotless frames in game one at Hudson Valley last Sunday...Stuart punched out 8 batters for his first pro win and leads the SAL in ERA (1.13) by more than a full run over Hickory's RHP **Josh Stephan** (2.17)...Stuart is also 3rd in the league in batting average against (.197) and 4th in WHIP (1.13)...Analytically, the right-hander is also among the SAL's best...Stuart is 2nd in FIP (2.89), 3rd in xFIP (3.49), 4th in strikeout rate (32.3%) and strikeouts per nine innings (11.81).

MEET THE 'NEW' BOSS: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18).

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts 3 of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America* and 5 of the Top 30...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 1 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (2/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (5/9)...INF **William Lugo** (24/26) and RHP **Christian Scott** (28/26) also appears on both lists...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 19 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision in Game 2 of last Sunday's doubleheader at Hudson Valley...Retired the first 12 batters he faced...Departed in the bottom of the 5th after yielding a leadoff single to C **Rafael Flores**...Did not walk a batter and struck out 2...Tossed 45 pitches (30 strikes)...Relieved by RHP **Joshua Cornielly** with 1 on, nobody out, and the game scoreless...Renegades walked-off in extras, 3-2, on a CF **Grant Richardson** single in the bottom of the 9th... Brooklyn took the opening game of the twinbill, 6-0.

BACK IN BROOKLYN: Scott was transferred back to the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie on May 5.

2022: Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on May 10...Collected a 3-3 mark with a 4.82 ERA (20 ER in 37.1 IP) and 52 strikeouts in 12 appearances (4 starts) with the Mets...Placed on the 7-day injured list on July 3 and reinstated on July 27...Transferred to High-A Brooklyn on August 8...Did not receive a decision and accrued a 3.80 ERA (9 ER in 21.1 IP) with 25 K's in 6 outings (5 starts) with the Cyclones...Did not appear for Brooklyn in the postseason.

FREE 'FALL'-IN: Following the 2022 Minor League season, Scott was one of several Mets prospect selected to participate in the prestigious Arizona Fall League...The 23-year-old made 4 starts for the Peoria Javelinas, tallying an 0-2 record and a 10.38 ERA (15 ER in 13.0 IP) with 10 strikeouts...Scott was teammates with fellow 2023 CycloneS OF **Stanley Consuegra** and INF **Kevin Kendall**, as well as former Brooklyn standouts OF **Brandon McIlwain '22**, INF **Luke Ritter '21**, and RHP **Grant Hartwig '22**.

GREAT SCOTT: Scott entered the 2023 season ranked as one of the New York Mets Top 30 prospects according to various publications...The right-hander is deemed New York's No. 26 farmhand by *Baseball America* and No. 28 by MLB Pipeline.

BEAM ME UP: The 23-year-old split his time between the rotation and bullpen in 2022...In 9 starts between St. Lucie and Brooklyn, Scott managed a 1-2 record with a 4.81 ERA (18 ER in 33.2 IP), adding 44 strikeouts (11.76 SO/9)...In 9 games in relief, the Coconut Creek, Fla. native registered a 2-1 mark plus a 3.96 ERA (11 ER in 25.0 IP), snatching 33 K's.
