LAST GAME

The Baysox fell just short of a series sweep, with a 5-2 loss to the Erie SeaWolves on Sunday afternoon. Bowie was held to just four base hits until the ninth inning, with only seeing a runner advance to second on two ocassions - as John Rhodes stole second base after a single in the first and a walk in the sixth. The SeaWolves struck first off right-handed starter Chayce McDermott in the second, stringing together three hits, including an RBI double from Luis Santana to take a 1-0 lead. In the third, Erie tacked an unearned run via a wild pitch and throwing error from catcher Tim Susnara. That was the only damage allowed by McDermott in his four frames, as the SeaWolves would plate three more in the sixth on a two-run single by Colin Burgees and an RBI groundout from Trei Cruz to take a 5-0 edge. In the ninth, the Baysox would make things interesting in the top of the ninth with an RBI single from Billy Cook and a bases loaded walk to Susnara which put the tying run on base with two outs, but Joseph Rosa grounded out to end the contest and snap Bowie's five-game winning streak.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Richmond Flying Squirrels enter this week with a record of 25-31 - fifth place in the Southwest division and 1.5 games ahead of the Baysox. Since entering their series in Bowie against the Baysox in late April atop the division standings, the Flying Squirrels are 12-24, having lost three of their series, while splitting the other three, and dropping 5.5 games out of first place in the process. Richmond has the second-fewest errors (40) in the Eastern League and the fewest home runs hit away from home (19) of any team in Double-A, but are going against a Baysox team with the second-most errors (55) and home runs allowed at home (56) in the league. The Flying Squirrels roster includes 10 of the Giants' top 30 prospects (via MLB Pipeline) - INF Marco Luciano (No. 2 SF/No. 18 overall), OF Vaun Brown (No. 5 SF), LHP Carson Whisenhunt (No. 8 SF), RHP Mason Black (No. 10 SF), RHP Landen Roupp (No. 13 SF), RHP Carson Seymour (No. 17 SF), RHP Randy Rodriguez (No. 25 SF), RHP Ryan Murphy (No. 26 SF), RHP Jose Cruz (No. 29 SF), and OF Wade Meckler (No. 30 SF).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Richmond looks to kick off the week by sending southpaw Carson Whisenhunt to the mound. Whisenhunt has flown through the Giants' system, as Tuesday will be his 15th career professional start and the second at the Double-A level. He threw 13.2 innings through four starts at Single-A San Jose to open the season, before allowing just four runs in 25.1 innings at High-A Eugene (1.42 ERA). Whisenhunt made his Double-A debut this past Wednesday against Altoona, where he threw five shutout frames, yielding just two hits and two walks, while striking out seven. In total this season, the left-hander has struck out 63 and walked 14 in 44 innings, holding opponents to a .151 average. A second-round pick of the Giants in 2022 out of East Carolina, Whisenhunt features a mid-90s fastball, mid-80s changeup, and upper-70s curveball.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox, Mayo leads the Double-A level with 19 doubles and is third with 28 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles'/ No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, also has nine walks in his last eight contests and nine multi-walk games this season. Mayo leads the Baysox with 34 walks and a .917 OPS. He is in the midst of a 25-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 28 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29) and the fourth-longest such streak in the Eastern League.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 75 hits and a .362 average. The No. 16 Orioles' prospect went 11-for-23 with 9 RBI last week in Erie, with at least three-hits in three of the five games, including his second four-hit performance of 2023 this past Thursday. Prieto has nine contests on the season with at least three knocks through his first 52 games. In addition, Prieto sits fifth in the Eastern League with his

NOT YOUR AVERAGE JOE

INF Joseph Rosa has been a spark at the top of the lineup since joining the Baysox last week. Rosa has at least one hit in each of his first six games with Bowie, scoring five runs and driving in four as a key part of the Baysox offensive success last week in Erie. Overall, the switch-hitter went 9-for-26 (.346), including a pair of home runs, as part of a Bowie lineup that averaged seven runs per game en route to the Baysox first fivegame winning streak of the season. Overall, Rosa has hit .352 in 18 games between Bowie and Triple-A Norfolk since signing with Baltimore in late May from the independent Mexican League.

COACHING STAFF

Manager - Kyle Moore

2023 will be Kyle Moore's second season as the manager of the Baysox, and his 14th within the Orloles' organization. After leading Bowie to a division-best 41-28 through the back half of last season, Moore continues to display consistency at the helm of recent successful learns throughout the Orloles system. Moore led Class-A belianza to a minor league-best 90 wins as manager in 2019. The Shorebia were named MLB. Som Allantic Manager of the Year honors. Moore's career managerial ecord sist at 254-216 (540) entering the 2023 season. Prior to his managerial career, Moore also spent three seasons as a player/coach in the Orloles system (2013 Frederick Keys, 2014 Bowie Baysox, 2015 Delmarva Shorebirds). He then took a position as the Shorebirds hitting coach in 2016, before joining the Keys in the same role in 2017. Moore played collegiately at Alabama, before signing with Baltimore as an undrafted free agent in 2010. He currently resides in Sarasota alongside his wife Whitney, and his two daughters, Madliyn and Cameron.

Hitting Coach - Sherman Johnson

Johnson had a brief sith in the major leagues with the Los Angeles Angels back in 2018 and spent parts of nine minor league seasons across the Angels, Reds and Minnesota Twins organizations. Pitching Coach - Forrest Herrmann
