"FUN IS GOOD" FACTOIDS

LAST TIME OUT: Mike Paredes continued his dominant run of form, spinning four innings of one-run ball with six strikeouts, but the St. Paul Saints dropped their third consecutive game, a 5-3 loss in the series opener to the Omaha Storm Chasers on Tuesday. Omaha grabbed a 1-0 lead in the top of the first, striking on Brett Squire's RBI triple. After the early run, Paredes retired 10 of the last 12 he faced. Aaron Sabato tied the game with a one out, solo blast in the second, his ninth of the season and 7th in the past 13 games. St. Paul took their first lead in the third. With the bases loaded and nobody out, Kyler Fedko hit into a double play and the Saints came away with just a lone run to lead 2-1. Andrew Bash took over for Paredes and after retiring the first five he faced, the righty allowed back-to-back homers on consecutive pitches, flipping the script to 3-2 Omaha. The Saints tied it when Ben Ross singled with two outs in the sixth, but the Storm Chasers rallied for a run in the seventh and insurance in the ninth.

NEW GUYS: The Twins made several roster moves yesterday, including optioning INF Royce Lewis to St. Paul. RHP Travis Adams was recalled and INF Orlando Arcia and C Alex Jackson had their contracts selected with Ryan Jeffers going on the 10-day IL. Joining the Saints from Double-A Wichita are C Ricardo Olivar, who's .961 OPS with the Wind Surge ranked third in the Texas League at the time of his call up, and RHP's Alejandro Hidalgo & Ty Langenberg, who's 4.71 ERA ranks 10th (min 30 IP).

DOMO ARIGATO, MR. SABATO: First baseman Aaron Sabato has now homered twice in the last three games and seven times in his previous 12 games (he ranks second in MiLB in homers with his seven hit since May 5, trailing only Wilmington's Devin Fitz-Gerald with 8 in that span). After riding the bench in 12 of the first 16 games of the season for St. Paul, Sabato has started 24 of 29 games since April 16. In that stretch, the former UNC Tarheel is hitting .325 (27-for-83) with all nine of his homers this year and is producing an 1.169 OPS that ranks 10th among all Triple-A hitters with at least 30 PA in that run. Sabato currently ranks 2nd among IL hitters with at least 80 PA in slugging% (.677) and 7th in OPS (1.032).

GABBY'S GOT A BRAND NEW BAG: Gabriel Gonzalez brings a five-game hit streak into Wednesday, a stretch where the 21-year-old is 9-for-17 with 2 XBH and four walks. Gonzalez had entered play Friday mired in a slump where he was 5-last-54 (.093), including an 0-for-25 skid in the middle. The Twins' No. 7 prospect raised his average has raised his average 35 points the last five games (.174 > .209). Gonzalez is a year removed from leading the Twins system with a .329 average between three levels and is currently on pace for a career-high 26 home runs.

RISP MANAGEMENT: The Saints are coming off a series split against Columbus, a six-game slate in which they held a lead in every game. The Saints took a 3-1 series lead following just their second-ever doubleheader sweep as a franchise (and their first since 2021) on Friday, before letting leads slip on both Saturday and Sunday. Across the last three games, including Tuesday vs Omaha, the Saints have had traffic on the bases in 23 of their 27 offensive half-innings, including the leadoff man on in 15 of them. The Saints have combined to go just 5-for-42 (.119) with runners in scoring position over those three games. On the season as a whole, the Saints have hit .260 (109-419) with runners on second or further, ranking 7th/20 in the International League.

SAINTLY SLUGGERS: After blasting a ridiculous 24 home runs in a seven-game span from May 2-9, the Saints have hit just six round-trippers in their last eight games since and have been overtaken by the Charlotte Knights for the most homers in baseball. Over their last 14 contests (circa May 2), the Saints rank t-4th in MLB/MiLB in homers (30), 2nd in team SLG% (.568) and team OPS (.985), and are t-6th in runs scored (118, 8.4/gm). The Saints have homered in 25 of their past 32 games and have not gone back-to-back games without a homer since April 10-11 in Toledo. The Saints currently tout eight hitters with at least five homers on the season, tied with Louisville for the most of any team in MLB or MiLB.

YOU'RE HOT & YOU'RE COLD... The Saints have now dropped three games in-a-row, their longest skid since losing four straight from April 21-24 in Indianapolis. Despite the recent cold snap, St. Paul are still 14-7 over their past 21 games since April 25, tied for the 2nd best record in Triple-A in that span (Nashville are 15-7). During the run, the Saints have outscored their opponents 146-103 (+43) after they were a -38 (112-150) over their first 24 games to start the season in which they went 9-15. Over their last 21 games, St. Paul rank 2nd in the Int'l League in AVG & runs scored. Despite an ERA that ranks 7th, their SO:BB ratio of 2.47 is t-4th in the Int'l League.

LOWERTOWN LAUNCH PAD: Entering play Wednesday, CHS Field ranks 2nd among all full-season MiLB parks in combined OPS this season (.901 between the Saints and their opponents). The 91 homers featured in St. Paul already are the 3rd-most at an MiLB venue this year, trailing only Truist Field in Charlotte (110) & Louisville Slugger Field (92). Last Wednesday's game snapped a streak of 21 games-in-a-row featuring at least one homer from either team in Lowertown dating back to last season (the longest CHS Field homer streak is 47 consecutive games from Sept. 22, 2023-July 24, 2024). Over the previous five years (2021-25), the Saints' home ranked 3rd (.795) among IL ballparks in combined OPS, behind only Truist Field (CLT) & Werner Park (OMA) and 5th in the league in home runs (966), trailing Syracuse, Omaha, Durham, & Charlotte's parks.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Friday in game one of a doubleheader...allowed consecutive singles and conceded a run with the Clippers benefitting from an error in between...threw up zeroes in the 2nd, 3rd, and 4th innings, including retiring the side in order in the latter two...gave up a pair of home runs in a 3-run 5th inning...threw 25 sinkers (41%), 24 sliders (39%), 6 changeups (10%), 3 cutters (5%), 2 curveballs (3%), and 1 four-seamer (2%)...generated five swings-and-misses, all on the slider

ONE OF US, ONE OF US: Rozek became the fifth Minnesota-born player to suit up for the Triple-A iteration of the St. Paul Saints when he made his Triple-A debut on April 13 vs Iowa in 2024 (he's now one of six). He joins RHP Jake Petricka (2022, Northfield), LHP Caleb Thielbar (2022-24, Northfield), RHP Louis Varland (2022-24, Maplewood/St. Paul), OF Matt Wallner (2022-25, Forest Lake), and RHP John Klein (2025-26, Brooklyn Park). Thielbar is the only Minnesotan to have pitched for both the Saints independent and Triple-A franchise eras.

WORLD SERIES MEMORIES: A 2013 graduate of Burnsville High School (nicknamed "The Blaze"), the same alma mater as current Saints hitting coach Shawn Schlechter, Rozek was a member of the Burnsville Legion Baseball team that reached the American Legion World Series as a youth player in 2013 in Shelby, North Carolina. The Burnsville Cobras won their first game over Napoleon, OH before losing the next two to Brooklawn, NJ and Petaluma, CA that season, a summer that Rozek notes as one of his fondest memories of playing the game of baseball in his career.

TWINS TIES: Aside from his time with Minnesota State, Rozek spent his college years pitching for two summers in the Northwoods League for the St. Cloud Rox, where he was coached by former Twins infielder and World Series champion Al Newman. Not just Rozek's wood-bat league coach, he also had ties to Newman going back to his youth baseball days, where he was also coached by the 1987 World Series champion.
