OFFENSE STYMIED IN 7-3 LOSS TO TRAVS:

The Frisco RoughRiders fell to the Arkansas Travelers 7-3 on Saturday night from Dickey-Stephens Park. Arkansas (30-19) stole the spotlight with an incredible pitching performance from Ryan Sloan (1-2), who threw 6.0 perfect innings with 11 strikeouts in his start. The Travelers then owned a perfect game through eight innings, leading 7-0, before a **Corey Joyce** leadoff walk in the 9th broke it up for Frisco (25-23) and a **Frainyer Chavez** RBI double snapped the no-hitter. **Dylan Dreiling** then added an RBI single in the ninth and **Rafe Perich** plated a run on a fielder's choice, but Frisco dropped it 7-3. In the second, the Travelers jumped on starter **Austin Bergner** (0-1), scoring three times to take a 3-0 lead. They added on with three in the fourth and another run in the fifth on a Caleb Cali solo home run to take their 7-0 lead.

BAD DAY TO BE A BAT:

While the RoughRiders are 6th in the Texas League in ERA on the season (5.05 ERA), the Riders pitched it well in the doubleheader against Arkansas. They allowed just 4 runs over 13.0 IP (2.77 ERA) and **Dalton Pence** threw the 4th quality start on the season for the Riders in game two. Frisco is 4-0 when getting a quality start.

THE BUFFALO HAS ARRIVED:

Arturo Disla, nicknamed "The Buffalo", has been amazing since joining the RoughRiders. He has hit safely in 11 of his 14 games, he is hitting .370 (20-for-54)/.460/.611/1.071 with 2 doubles, 1 triple, 3 home runs and 14 RBIs. In his first 30 games of the season with High-A Hub City, Disla hit .314/.434/.559/.993 with 6 homers and 21 RBIs. Between both levels, he has dominated lefties, hitting .472 (17-for-36)/.574/.861/1.435 against southpaws. Among those with at least 35 PA vs. LHP, he is 3rd in the minors in batting average and OPS against lefties.

THIS IS OUR TOWNSEND:

Blake Townsend has been great over his last 2 starts for the Riders. In Midland, he went 7.1 innings, becoming just the second RoughRider starting pitcher to record an out in the eighth inning since 2018, joining **Nick Krauth** who did so in 2023. It was the longest start of any Double-A pitcher this year and tied for the 4th-longest start in Minor League Baseball. Over his last two starts, the first two quality starts of his career, he was allowed just 1 run over 13.1 innings (0.68 ERA).

GET RICH OR DIE DREILING:

RoughRiders outfielder **Dylan Dreiling** has been hitting well recently. The No. 10 prospect is 7th in the Texas League in batting average (.297). On a 19-game on-base streak (2nd-longest active streak in TL), he is hitting .311 (23-for-74)/.416/.554/.970 with 3 doubles, 5 home runs, 15 RBIs, 14 walks and 13 strikeouts. He is riding a 11-game hitting streak (T-longest active streak in TL), batting .311 (14-for-45)/.373/.422/.795 with 2 2B, 1 HR, 7 RBIs.

WATCH OUT FOR THE LONG BALL:

Frisco's 63 homers are the 2nd-most in recorded franchise history (since 2005) through 48 games (2022, 64 homers) and 3rd in the Texas League this year. The Riders are the only team in Double-A with 10 players who have hit at least 4 home runs this year.

GIMME THAT OFFENSE EARLY AND OFTEN:

The RoughRiders have been swinging the bat well in their last 30 games, going 17-13. During the stretch, they have scored 196 runs, first in the league (6.5 R/G), slashing .266/.370/.442/.812 with 38 home runs. Frisco's 44 runs in the first inning this year are tied for 6th in the minors, hitting .314 (60-for-191) in the first with 9 home runs. They have scored in the first inning in 20 games and have scored multiple runs in the first inning in 12 games this season. When scoring 7 or fewer runs, the Riders are 9-22 (including a combined 3-9 record when scoring 6 or 7 runs) and 16-1 when scoring 8 or more. Frisco is also 10-13 in 1 or 2-run games. The Riders have been shut out just twice this year, both in 7-inning doubleheader games.

YOU WANT THE HITS, WE GOT UM:

Through 48 games the RoughRiders are 2nd in the Texas League with 439 hits. They are first in the league in batting average (.270) and 2nd in runs (303, 6.3 runs per game). The RoughRiders have not led the Texas League in batting average since 2014. Frisco has scored 7 or more runs in 46 percent of their games (22-of-48). The Riders are 3rd in the Texas League in homers (63) while they are 1st in SLG (.447) and 1st in OPS (.812). For perspective, the Wind Surge led the league last year with a .780 team OPS.

ABOUT DYLAN

- Drafted in 2020 out of Central Catholic High School in Portland, Oregon.
- Named 2019 Oregon Gatorade Player of the Year in junior year, leading all Oregon pitchers in wins (10), ERA (0.81), strikeouts (128) and WHIP (0.71). Led Rams to 6-A State Championship game against Jesuit (nicknamed the "Holy War") and faced now-Phillies pitcher Mick Abel. Jesuit won 2-1 in 13 innings.
- Was named as the No. 2 pitcher in Oregon's 2020 class behind Abel.
- At 13 years old, he pitched for Oregon in the opening round of the 2015 Little League World Series. In 1-0 loss to Texas, he threw 5.2 innings, striking out 12 batters.
- Before signing with the Rangers, MacLean was committed to the University of Washington.

2026 SEASON

- Opened the season as the Saturday starter for the RoughRiders
- Opened season with 5.89 ERA in April.
- Threw first career quality start on May 24th vs. San Antonio: 6.0 IP, 5 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 2 K.

2025 SEASON

- Returned from injury to High-A Hub City, dominating at home (2.45 ERA as opposed to a 4.08 ERA on the road)
- After allowing five runs in his second appearance, he dominated in his last 19G (10GS), to the tune of a 3-1 record and 2.70 ERA.
- Started two games in the playoffs, allowing three runs in 8.0 innings, striking out 7 to 1 walk

2024 SEASON

- Missed the entire season with "Tommy John" surgery.

2023 SEASON

- Lead the team with 7 wins on the season
- As a starter, went 1-1 with a 2.89 ERA over 7 games. As a reliever, went 6-4 with a 3.38 ERA.

CHAD COMER

Years with Rangers: 10

Years with RoughRiders: 2 (1st as manager)

Comer returns to Double-A Frisco in 2026 after managing at the High-A level over the last three seasons. The native of Mansfield, Texas will enter his 10th season with the Rangers and his second in Frisco.

In 2022, Comer helped pilot the Riders to their second Texas League Championship in franchise history, serving as a development coach. Over the last three seasons, Comer managed High-A Hickory (2023-2024) and High-A Hub City (2025), going 197-191 (.508).

Prior to Frisco, Comer was the hitting coach for the High-A Hickory Crawdads in 2021, after serving as a coach at various levels of the Rangers system from 2016-2019.

The former University of Texas at Arlington catcher played two seasons in the Atlanta Braves organization, reaching High-A Lynchburg in 2012. He was drafted by Atlanta in the 29th round of the 2011 draft after four seasons at UTA.

THOMAS ST. CLAIR

Years with Rangers: 5

Years with RoughRiders: 1

St. Clair joins the Riders as the pitching coach after leading a Hub City staff that finished third in the SAL with a 3.50 ERA in 2025. St. Clair also will serve as the assistant pitching coordinator in the Rangers farm system in 2026.

Initially, St. Clair came to the Rangers as a coach in the Dominican Summer League in 2022 before serving as a pitching coach for the ACL Rangers from 2022-23. Before professional baseball, he spent two and a half years as pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at North Carolina Wesleyan College.

The right-hander pitched three professional seasons in the St. Louis Cardinals system from 2017-19 after he was picked in the 24th round of the 2017 June draft, making 88 outings for the organization's Rookie and Single-A affiliates.

The Winston-Salem, North Carolina native played four years (2014-17) at Division II Lenior-Rhyne University in Hickory, N.C.

HITTING COACH

JASON HART

Years with Rangers: 13

Years with RoughRiders: 9

Hart returns as the hitting coach in Frisco for the first time since he served as the RoughRiders hitting coach from 2012-2019. Before that, most recently, he was the Major League hitting assistant for the Miami Marlins under current Rangers manager Skip Schumaker.

In 2015, Hart was named the Mike Coolbaugh Texas League Coach of the Year for his work with the Riders hitters. Prior to joining Frisco, Hart spent two seasons as the hitting coach with Low-A Hickory. His tenure with the Rangers began after he assisted the Single-A Clinton staff with coaching responsibilities for a portion of the 2008 season and continued when he accepted the role of hitting coach for the Arizona Rangers before the 2009 campaign.

Hart played professionally for parts of eight seasons from 1998-2006, with stints in the Oakland, Texas and Minnesota organizations. He made his Major League debut with the Rangers in 2002, when he batted .267 (4-for-15) with three doubles over a span of 10 games. He missed the 2004 campaign following the removal of a benign brain tumor, but returned to the field in 2005 and hit 21 home runs in 128 games with Frisco.

Originally drafted by Oakland in the fifth round of the 1998 draft, Hart was acquired by Texas in a January 2002 trade with the Athletics. He attended Southwest Missouri State University, where he paced the conference in homers in 1997 and was named a Missouri Valley Conference All-Star in 1998.

Hernandez joins the RoughRiders for his first season with the Rangers organization.

During 2020, Hernandez managed the Texas Collegiate League Frisco RoughRiders after the MiLB season had been canceled. In 2025, he served as a bench coach for Triple-A Jacksonville and spent 19 seasons with the Marlins as a coach and coordinator. As part of that stint, he served eight seasons as a manager, most recently in 2022 with High-A Beloit.

Hernandez started his coaching career at the University of Mobile in 1993 as a hitting coach and stayed there through 2001. From 2005-2006, Hernandez served as the hitting coach for the Independent Pensacola Pelicans.

Sullenger joins the Riders in 2026 as the Development Coach. He made his professional managerial debut in 2021, leading the ACL Rangers.

Before joining the professional ranks, Sullenger led the baseball program as head coach at Biola University in La Mirada, California, from 2013-2018.

Additionally, he worked one season in stadium operations for the Tampa Bay Rays. Sullenger attended Spotswood (Va.) High School and went on to play baseball at Florida Southern College (one season) and Liberty University (three seasons).

He holds a bachelor's degree from Liberty and earned a master's degree in Kinesiology with a focus in Athletic Administration/Coaching from James Madison in 2003.

Brown makes his Double-A debut in 2026. Before being the athletic trainer for High-A Hub City in 2025, Brown was the ACL Rangers athletic trainer in 2024.

Brown was also a student athletic trainer at Slinger (Wisc.) High School (2022) and Carroll University in Waukesha, Wisc. (2021).

The Louisville, Ky. native holds an associate's degree in Biology (McHenry County College), a Bachelor's degree in Exercise Science (Upper Iowa University), and a Master's in Athletic Training (Carroll University).
