LAST TIME OUT

The Baysox walked-off the Senators twice in yesterday's doubleheader, winning game one 6-5 and winning game two 3-2 to win their fifth consecutive game. **Noelberth Romero** drove in the winning runs in both games with a walk-off two-run homer in the first game and a walk-off two-run double in the second game. Other highlights from the doubleheader included a two-run homer from **Connor Pavolony**, a three-hit game for **Jud Fabian** and strong relief outings from **Levi Stoudt** and **Lincoln Henzman**.

WE'VE GOT THE RUNS

Bowie has scored 38 runs in the series thus far, the second-most amongst Double-A teams this week. The Baysox also lead all Double-A teams in OPS (.980) this week. In July, the Baysox scored 69 runs, the fourth-fewest in Double-A.

IT'S NOELBERTH'S WORLD

Noelberth Romero became the first player in Minor League Baseball to hit two walk-offs in one day since August 12, 2021 when Aberdeen's (and former Baysox 1B) Andrew Daschbach collected two walk-off hits against Asheville. Romero hit his first homer of the season in game one with a walk-off two-run homer.

A WIN TODAY WOULD....

A win today would extend Bowie's season-best win streak to six games. A win today would also mark Bowie's first six-game series sweep since August 2-7, 2022 at Harrisburg and the first six-game series sweep at home since May 11-16, 2021 vs Reading

ALL-STAR SAMUEL

C/1B **Samuel Basallo**, the Orioles '24 All-Star Futures Game selection, leads the Eastern League in total bases (165) and is tied for 2nd among active Eastern League players in hits (101). Basallo is leading all qualified Eastern League hitters in August with a .455 batting average (15-for-33). The No. 2 O's/No. 12 MLB prospect will turn 20 years of age on Tuesday.

BENCOSME BARRELS

IF **Frederick Bencosme** recorded his first four-RBI game at Double-A with his first career grand slam on Friday. The Orioles No. 24 prospect has tallied a hit in 13 of his last 15 games. Over his last 10 games, the 21-year-old is batting .452 (14-for-31) with four doubles, two homers and six RBI.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** set a new a career-high in home runs on Tuesday with his 12th of the season. The 22-year-old has reached base in 74 of 92 games played in his second season with the Baysox. He leads the team in walks (52) and stolen bases (25), tied for second-most and tied for third-most in the Eastern League, respectively.

SECOND HALF SILAS

C **Silas Ardoin** is batting a team-best .349 since the All-Star Break with an on-base percentage of .481 and OPS of .900. The 23-year-old's season-best eight game hit streak ended after game two of the doubleheader. Defensively, Ardoin has been one of the best backstops in the Eastern League. His 22 base runners caught stealing is third-most in the circuit.

SIZING UP THE SENATORS

Entering this week, the Harrisburg Senators are in last place in the Southwest Division with a record of 12-21. The Double-A affiliate of the Nationals is at the bottom of the league in AVG, OPS and HR but its pitching staff owns the second-best ERA in the circuit. Eight of the Nationals top 30 prospects are on the Senators active roster - OF Daylen Lile (No. 9), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 16), OF Andrew Pinckney (No. 18), RHP Zach Brzykcy (No. 19), SS Kevin Made (No. 20), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (No. 25), RHP Andy Lara (No. 26), RHP Marquis Grissom (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Chase Solesky makes his ninth start of the season for the Senators. On Tuesday, Solesky gave up a season-high four runs on a season-high eight hits in five innings against the Baysox. The former White Sox farmhand began the season with Triple-A Charlotte before joining the Nationals on June 10 on a Minor League deal.

During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.



BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



COACHING STAFF

ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado on the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

JOSH BUNSELMAYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmayer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles' Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmayer's fifth season in the Orioles' system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

Fundamentals Coach

Facticeau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022.
