SOD POODLES HIT FIVE HOMERS TO THUMP RIDERS:

The Frisco RoughRiders were downed by the Amarillo Sod Poodles 11-4 on Saturday night from HODGETOWN behind a barrage of homers. Frisco (7-7, 38-43) struck first in the first inning with an RBI single from **Thomas Saggese**, but Amarillo (9-5, 43-40) immediately answered in the first inning with a solo homer from Caleb Roberts, one of five long balls for the Sod Poodles and the first of two for Roberts. Amarillo scored one in the first, two in the second and six in the third to quickly open a 9-1 advantage on Frisco starter **Nick Krauth** (2-6). The Riders drew closer with an infield RBI single from **Josh Hatcher** in the sixth, followed by a two-run knock by **Liam Hicks** to make it 9-4. The Sod Poodles added on in the seventh and eighth to take a decisive 11-4 lead. Hatcher was the only player for the Riders to record multiple hits, going 2-for-4 for the second-straight game. Saggese also extended his hitting streak to 11 games with his single in the first while **Luisangel Acuña** saw his streak end at 14 games with an 0-for-3 day. **Matt Bush** made his season debut with the Riders after being signed by the Rangers last week, throwing a scoreless seventh inning with a strikeout.

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH

Since coming to Frisco in June, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 14 games, he has driven in 17 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .355/.371/.548/.919 with two homers and 13 RBIs in eight games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 19 games since his return, he has seven multi-hit games, batting .347 (26-for-75)/.412/.573/.985 with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBIs and 15 runs record.

SPEAS, STEPHAN HONERED FOR JUNE:

The Texas Rangers announced on Thursday that **Alex Speas** had been named the Rangers Minor League Relief Pitcher of the Month for June as part of four awards for Rangers minor league players. Speas, who made eight appearances in June for the Frisco RoughRiders before getting called up to Round Rock (AAA) on June 30, was named the Relief Pitcher of the Month for the second consecutive time. The 25-year-old Speas did not allow an earned run in June in nine appearances, covering 14 innings. **Josh Stephan** won Starting Pitcher of the Month for posting a 2.16 ERA across 25 innings, all with High-A Hickory. Stephan was promoted to Frisco on July 4th to make his Double-A debut.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 31 games, he is hitting .377/.458/.689/1.147 with nine home runs and 30 RBIs. Saggese is currently on an 11-game hitting streak, batting .405 (17-for-42) during that stretch. The California native is currently fourth in the league in batting average (.317), third in RBIs (65), seventh in slugging percentage (.519), second in hits (102), third in doubles (20) and second in total bases (167).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .586 average (17-for-29) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.544 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .463 (25-for-54) on the initial offering while his 25 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors.

SPEED KILLS

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 36 and is on pace for a career-best 60 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 110 bases in 132 attempts (83 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .378/.429/.467/.896 in July. He is fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.311), third in hits (99), third in doubles (20), second in runs (59) and first in steals (36). When the 21-year-old arrived in Frisco in 2022, he had a wRC+ of 68 while it has nearly doubled this season (117).
