FRES-NOTES

POSTSEASON CHANCES DASHED BY VISALIA: The Fresno Grizziles (26-33, 64-60) were overwhelmed by the Visalia Rawhide (34-25, 63-61) 6-3 Saturday night from Valley Strong Ballpark. The Grizziles fell to 49-16 all-time against the Rawhide (6-5 this season). Fresno has won 30 of their last 41 contests against their Highway 99 rivids. The Grizziles postseason chances were dashed as the San Jose Giants cliniched the second half and a playoff berth thanks to a head-to-head tiebreaker. For the fifth straight game (nine of their last 1), the Grizziles socred first, clutching a 1-0 lead in the opening inning. Aidan Longwell swatted a leadoff single and advanced to second on a Caleb Hobson sacrifice bunt. Then, Braylen Wimmer smacked a single, extending his hit streak to eight contests. The two singles already surpassed Fresno's hit total from yesterday. On the next batter, Longwell scampered home on a Visalia fielding error. Fresno mustered two final runs in the top of the eighth. Blake Wright provided a single to right, etching Hobson. Wimmer strolled home on a double play to round out the scoring. Grizziles' righty Bryan Perez (5-8) suffered a tough-luck loss despite achieving a quality start. Perez tossed six innings, allowing three runs (two earned), on six hits and a pair of walks while striking out six. Justin Loer was tagged for three runs in his one frame and Yanzel Correa laid a zero in the eighth. Rawhide starter Daniel Nunez (3-1, win) hurled six and two-thirds innings of one-run ball. Nunez scattered six hits and one walk while punching out eight. Rio Britton locked up his first save of the season after two and one-third frames. Britton fanned five to give Visalia the series lead 3-2.

HIGHWAY 99: The Fresno Grizzlies and Visalia Rawhide (Arizona Diamondbacks Single-A affiliate) conclude their six-game series today at Valley Strong Ballpark. This is the last of two regular season series between the clubs in 2024 and the only meeting in Visalia. The Grizzlies are 26-4 at home (three sweeps) and 49-16 all-time against the Rawhide. The Grizzlies have also won 27 of their last 36 contests against their Highway 99 rivals. On the other side, four of the Rawhide's 16 wins have come via one-run walk-offs. The two cities are 39.26 miles from one another, or if you drive non-stop, 43 minutes or so. From Fresno to Visalia, you would drive in a southeast direction, following the CA 99 route.

STU MAKES THE START: LHP Stu Flesland III will toe the rubber today for the Grizzlies. Flesland III was selected by the Rockies in the 11th round (Pick 322) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Washington. He played three years at Washington, earning all Pac-12 honors in his final season. Flesland III attended Mt. Spokane High School in Spokane, Washington and was teammates with fellow Grizzlies RHP Brady Hill.

TRANSACTION-HEAVY MONTH: Since July 30, the Grizzlies have had 33 transactions. Prior to that date, the Grizzlies had 27 total transactions for the season. Among those 33 transactions, 16 of them have been players added to the Grizzlies' active roster. Six of those other moves have been promotions to upper-levels, three have been Rockies' releases, six have been injury list placements and two have involved MLB rehab players.

THE 2024 DRAFT PICKS HAVE ARRIVED: The Grizzlies have added eight 2024 Rockies' Draft Picks to their roster. 2nd-round OF Jared Thomas (Texas), 4th-round INF Blake Wright (Clemson), 6th-round LHP Konner Eaton (George Mason), 7th-round RHP Fidel Ulloa (LSU), 9th-round UTL Tommy Hopfe (Fresno State), 13th-round LHP Justin Loer (LSU), 19th-round RHP Nathan Blasick (New Orleans) and 20th-round RHP Hunter Omlid (Arizona State).

#CLAWSANDPAWS: Grizzlies' UTL Tommy Hopfe became the 10th Fresno State Bulldog to don a Fresno Grizzlies uniform (LHP Dean Hartgraves, '98, RHP Steve Soderstrom, '98-99, C. Giuseppe Chiaramonte, '00-'01, RHP Mark Gardner, rehab, '01, OF Tom Goodwin '02, LHP Adam Pettyjohn '04, C. Trent Woodward, '15 and '17, RHP Justin Miller, '19 and OF EJ Andrews Jr., '22-24). The former Diamond Dog was selected by the Rockies in the 9th round (Pick 258) of the 2024 MLB Draft.

CALAZ IS NAMED ACL MVP: Minor League Baseball announced on August 29 that current Grizzlies' OF Robert Calaz was named the 2024 Arizona Complex League MVP in their end-of-season awards. Calaz was also selected as one of the three top outfielders in the league and the only Rockies prospect named to the All-Star Team. Calaz led the Arizona Complex League (ACL) in seven different offensive categories; batting average (349), homers (10), RBI (45), on-base percentage (462), slugging percentage (651), OPS (1.113) and total bases (112). The Rockies #10 prospect also had 46 runs, \$2 walks and 12 stolen bases in his 2024 MVP campaign. His outstanding season led to a Fresno promotion on August 2nd, where he now sits on the injured, Isolaz made 13 appearances with the Grizzlies, batting 3.271/386/571/957 with a pair of clouts, triples and doubles. Calaz recorded 11 RBI, 10 runs, five walks and three stolen bases in that span as well. His first Grizzlies longball came on August 11 at Rancho Cucamonga, where it left the bat at 109 MPH and went an estimated 455 feet. Calaz is expected to headline the Grizzlies 2025 roster and lineup. If you are ready to watch Calaz next year, make sure to lock in your place for the 2025 Fresno Grizzlies season. Season Ticket renewals are NOW OPEN with some great incentives for paying for your seats early. Secure your spot with only a 25% deposit by September 20.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot (44 games), he has reached base 80 times in 208 plate appearances (39% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 12 of those 44 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 40 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 10-for-35 (286) with a double, eight walks and one hit-by-pitch (19-for-44, 43% of the time he reaches base in his first plate appearance). Nine of his 10 hits have been singles with four of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 23 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in six of those leadoff games (42/48 in stolen bases on the season).

RUNNING INTO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson continues to climb the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Record Books with 42 stolen bases (joined with his 35th stolen base on August 20, 6th inning vs. Stockton). He currently sits tied for third all-time with those 42 stolen bases (Calvin Murray, 1999). Up next for Hobson is Eddy Diaz (2021), who had 48 stolen bases that year.

TEN OUT OF TEN(A) FOR TRIPLES: Grizzlies' OF Felix Tena is one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Record Books in Top 10 Single-Season Triples. Tena looks to catch former teammate Andy Perez (2023 and 2024), as well as Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999), who each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons.
