ABOUT LAST NIGHT... The Vancouver Canadians used a career performance from starter Luis Quinones to beat the Eugene Emeralds (Giants) 7-5 Thursday night, as the right-hander's team-high eleven strikeouts were backed by contributions from up and down the lineup to end a two-game losing skid.

Quinones (W, 1-0) came out firing on all cylinders. The Arcibo, PR native worked five innings, allowed one hit – a first inning two-run home run from Logan Wyatt that gave the Ems an early lead – walked three and missed a ton of bats. He struck out the side in the first, third and fourth innings.

Trailing 2-0 heading into their first at-bat, the C's tied the game with a Tanner Morris walk, a Spencer Horwitz RBI double and a run-scoring two-bagger from Ryan Gold.

Vancouver took the lead for good in the third after Eric Rivera singled with two outs, stole second and came home on Tanner Kirwer's RBI triple.

A three-run fourth proved to be the difference. Ronny Brito got things started with a solo homer before Rafael Lantigua doubled, Kirwer walked and both men scored on a Morris single to left field to make it 6-2.

Eugene made it interesting in the later innings. They mustered two runs on two hits and a missed catch error in the eighth and had the tying run in scoring position with no outs, though they failed to add on after Marcus Reyes (S, 1) – who came into the game unexpectedly after an injury to Hagen Danner – managed to retire the next two batters via a strikeout then got an inning-ending fielder's choice after a two-out walk loaded the bases.

The C's added a crucial insurance run in the bottom of the eighth. After Gold worked a lead-off walk, Lantigua brought him in with a two-out double to make it 7-4. A one-out triple and a fielder's choice scored another run for Eugene in the ninth, but Reyes struck out the potential tying run to end the game and secure the win.

Seven of nine Vancouver batters recorded at least one hit with Lantigua's three knocks leading the way. Brito's home run was his second of the year.

Cobi Johnson turned in his third consecutive scoreless outing with two innings of relief after Quinones left the game.

FEELING GREEN: The Eugene Emeralds, Advanced-A affiliate of the San Francisco Giants, come to town this week for their first taste of the Canadians this season. This is the first of just two series between these two clubs in 2021; Vancouver will visit PK Park June 22-27 for the remaining six games of the 12-game season set. The C's went 3-4 against the Ems in 2019 when both clubs were their parent organization's Short-Season A affiliate.

HOME AWAY FROM HOME: Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 as the visitors).

START THE WEEKEND EARLY: After last night's win, Vancouver is a perfect 5-0 on Thursdays.

ACES OF ON BASE: The C's have three players – Spencer Horwitz, Tanner Kirwer and Tanner Morris – among league leaders in on-base percentage, with Horwitz and Kirwer occupying the top two spots and Morris ranked sixth.

THE T-MO SHOW: Tanner Morris continues to rake through the early goings of the season's second month. After logging just one extra base hit in May (a home run), the Crozet, VA native has doubled twice and tripled in three June games. He's 5-for-9 with three runs scored, three RBI and four walks so far this month.

ON THE HILL: Nick Frazier climbs the hill for Vancouver looking to continue his recent stretch of dominance. The right-hander's last outing on May 28 was his most impressive of the year; that night, Frazier held Everett to just two hits over six scoreless innings in which he walked one and struck out seven to earn his team-best third win. Frazier, 23, is the active league leader in opponent batting average (.145) and WHIP (0.61). He's from Dallas, TX.

Right-hander Travis Perry will go for Eugene in his first start and seventh appearance of 2021. He last took the mound on May 27 against Spokane, when he worked four innings of relief and limited the Indians to one run on three hits with no walks and a season-high seven strikeouts. Perry will be a tough task for the C's; the Morristown, NJ native has limited opposing hitters to a .106 average in 14.1 innings pitched. Perry, 24, was San Francisco's 28th round pick in 2018 out of Indian River JC in Florida. He owns a career ERA of 3.35 in 99.1 professional innings.
