### ROUGHRIDERS FALL IN BLOWOUT TO WICHITA:

The Frisco RoughRiders dropped the second game of the season to the Wichita Wind Surge 13-3 on Saturday night from Riverfront Stadium. RoughRiders (1-1) jumped in front early with two runs across in the third inning. **Aaron Zavala** started the scoring with an RBI single up the middle that hit the second-base bag and **Liam Hicks** then added a sacrifice fly on the following pitch. Wichita (1-1) answered in the third with three runs of their own to take the lead and then tacked on five in the fourth and another in the fifth to take a 10-2 advantage. Zavala reached and scored on a balk in the sixth, but the Riders could not muster any more offense on the night. In the eighth, the Wind Surge added on with a three-run home run from Kala'i Rosario, the first home run of the season. Frisco was just held to five hits, two from Hicks, who is 4-for-5 to start his season, and one from Zavala, **Josh Hatcher** and **Abimelec Ortiz**. On the hill, Riders starter **Emiliano Teodo** (0-1) took the loss, allowing four runs (all earned) over his 2.2 innings in his Double-A debut. Travis Adams (1-0) went five innings, giving up just the two unearned runs for Wichita to take the victory home. RoughRiders pitchers walked eight batters to just five strikeouts on the night.

### ACKER HACKS THEM UP:

Starter **Dane Acker** was strong in his start on Opening Day for the RoughRiders, tossing 4.2 innings, allowing just one run. His 4.2 innings start was the longest start for a RoughRiders pitcher on Opening Day since 2019 when **Brock Burke** went 5.0 innings. Acker fell just one out shy of tying his career high in innings pitched in a start.

### VERSUS THE WIND SURGE:

The youngest team in the Texas League, joining the league in 2021, the two teams have only played each other each of the last two seasons entering this year. The RoughRiders defeated the Wind Surge 2-0 in the 2022 Texas League Championship Series, but during the regular season, Wichita holds the head-to-head with 14 wins in the 25 games. Last season, Frisco hit .306/.388/.518/.906 against them, but allowed 8.3 runs per game and finished just 4-7 against the Twins affiliate. Out of returning players, **Kellen Strahm** (.300/.364/.425/.789 in 10 games with one home run) and **Scott Kapers** (.400/.500/.867/1.367 in four games with two home runs) led the way. In the 14 games between the two teams at Riverfront Stadium, the clubs have combined for 37 home runs.

### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

The RoughRiders had a historic season walking in 2023, leading the Texas League and setting a franchise record for walks as an offense. In the 2024 Opener, the RoughRiders added on, walking eight times. In 2023, Frisco shattered their franchise record for most walks in a season with 680 (5.0 per game), which also led all of Double-A. The previous record was 547 by the 2022 RoughRiders. Frisco's .355 on-base percentage is a new franchise record as well (previous record was .352 in 2004). The Riders had four players who cracked the top 10 in single-season walks in franchise history: **Evan Carter** (74, 5th), **Kellen Strahm** (74, 5th), **Aaron Zavala** (72, 7th) and **Trevor Hauver** (71, 9th). Strahm is also third in career walks in RoughRiders franchise history with 139.

### WE'RE GOING PROSPECTING:

After starting off the 2023 season with four of the top five prospects in the Rangers system, the RoughRiders welcome four top 30 prospects onto the roster to being this season. The prospects are paced by 1B/OF **Abimelec Ortiz** (No. 12, according to MLB.com). Ortiz was named the 2023 Tom Grieve Rangers Minor League Player of the Year, leading all of Minor League Baseball in slugging percentage (.619) while placing fourth in the minors in home runs (33) and OPS (.990) between Low-A Down East and High-A Hickory. The other ranked players include newcomer RHP **Emiliano Teodo** (No. 16), who sports a fastball that reaches over 100 mph, and returners OF **Aaron Zavala** (No. 21) and RHP **Dane Acker** (No. 28). Zavala will spend his third season in Frisco after missing the beginning of last year with right elbow surgery while Acker finished the season with the RoughRiders in 2023 and sported a 2.54 ERA overall.

### FAMILIAR FACES IN FRISCO:

The RoughRiders return 19 players in 2024. **Kellen Strahm** has the most experience with the Riders, having played 225 games over the last two seasons in Frisco. Along with Strahm, **Josh Hatcher** and **Aaron Zavala** are back in the outfield while **Cody Freeman** and **Frainyer Chavez** return on the infield and all three catchers (**Liam Hicks**, **Scott Kapers** and **Cooper Johnson**) are former Riders as well. On the mound, the familiar starters are **Dane Acker**, **Nick Krauth** and **Ryan Garcia**. In the bullpen, **Aidan Anderson**, **Robby Ahlstrom**, **Ricky DeVito**, **Avery Weems**, **Reid Birlingmair**, **Andy Rodriguez** and **Grant Wolfram** are back.

### CARDOZA IS BACK IN NORTH TEXAS:

Skipper **Carlos Cardoza** returns to Double-A Frisco in 2024 after managing the RoughRiders in 2023. He led the Riders to a 64-73 record last season, missing the playoffs. Following the season, he managed the Surprise Saguaros of the Arizona Fall League to an AFL Championship and was a bench coach in the Roberto Clemente Professional Baseball League in Puerto Rico with Cangrejeros (Crab Eaters) de Santurce. The Puerto Rico native piloted the Hickory Crawdads to a 66-65 record in 2022 and has amassed a 376-280 (.573) total over his seven seasons as a skipper. With Down East, he took the Wood Ducks to the Low-A East Championship Series before falling to Charleston. Prior to his time in Down East, he managed the Arizona League Rangers (2019), winning the AZL Championship, and Dominican Summer League Rangers (2016-2019), twice reaching the championship series. Hired on by the Rangers in 2015, Cardoza was the head coach at his alma mater, Decatur High School, in Georgia for two years. As a player, Cardoza spent two seasons at Georgia State University and two years at Armstrong Atlantic State, where he was a gold glove second baseman and All-Peach Belt Conference selection.

### ABOUT NICK

-Went to Northgate High School in Walnut Creek, California (across the Bay from San Francisco, east of Berkeley). His senior season, he went 6-5 with a 2.20 ERA over 11 games.

-Krauth then went to the University of New Mexico for the 2018 season, where he was teammates with current RoughRiders pitcher Justin Slaten.

-After New Mexico, transferred to Diablo Valley College in Pleasant Valley, California where he went 5-4 with a 2.20 ERA. Following that strong season, he transferred again, this time to the University of Connecticut, where he was one of the best pitchers in the country for the 2020 season before it was cut short due to COVID. In his four starts, he went 4-0 with a 0.36 ERA and a .167 BAA. This included five one-run innings against the No. 1 Michigan Wolverines on February 23rd.

-Due to the 2020 MLB Draft getting shortened to five rounds, Krauth went undrafted and signed with the Rangers as a free agent on June 15th.

-Brother, Ben Krauth, pitched for the San Antonio Missions in 2022, making nine starts and recording a 7.18 ERA. In two starts against Frisco, the Rough Rider touched him up for a combined seven runs, six earned, over 7.2 innings while handing him two losses. Ben was released by the Padres organization at the end of the year and retired after six seasons of MLB experience.

### 2024 SEASON

-Krauth enters 2024 in the RoughRiders starting rotation.

### 2023 SEASON

-Krauth made first appearance of the season out of the bullpen on Friday, April 7th, allowing three runs over four innings.

-In his first start, Krauth went shutout five innings at San Antonio on April 14th to earn the first win among RoughRiders starting pitchers.

-Threw four scoreless innings on April 20th before game was suspended due to rain in the top of the fifth with the Riders up 9-0, ending his night early. The Riders and the Travelers went on to finish the game on April 21st with Frisco winning 13-5.

-Allowed a run in the fourth inning against Amarillo on April 26th, snapping a 14.2-consecutive innings scoreless streak dating back to April 7th.

-Joined Triple-A Round Rock on May 2nd for a spot start and make two appearances. In his start, he went 3.2 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 0 ER, 3 BB, 1 K. Allowed a grand slam to David Freitas of Oklahoma City in relief appearance.

### 2022 SEASON

-Spent time as both a starter and reliever, going 4-7 with a 5.38 ERA in 17 starts and 1-0, 2.25 ERA out of the bullpen.

-An extreme groundball pitcher, Krauth rolled groundballs at a 50.2% clip with the Crawdads.

### 2021 SEASON

-Showing his durability, Krauth led the Low-A East and the Rangers organization with 102.2 innings pitched. He also made a team-high 20 starts.

-Earned Low-A East Pitcher of the Week twice, including once for a complete-game, one-hitter on August 28th vs. Fayetteville (9.0 IP, 1 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 2 BB, 9 K).
