### Today's Game

The Clippers will send LHP **Ryan Webb** to the mound today, needing a win to salvage a split (have won four straight final games to split last four series). St. Paul will counter with RHP **Taj Bradley**. Columbus is 18-10 (.643) versus right handers this year. Bradley has never pitched against the Clippers in his career, as today will mark his 17th game in the IL (with Durham, 2023-25).

### vs. the Saints

Columbus went 4-2 against the Saints in Minnesota last year, on the way to a 9-7 series record, and has won 47 of the last 76 overall opposing the Saints (416-330 run differential; 13 of 29 losses by a single run, only 10 losses by more than two runs). Individually, **Kahliil Watson** is 12x43 (.279) with 4HR and 14RBI against the Saints in his career (10G) and **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .333 (12x36) in 10G.

### Maximization

The Clippers hit double digits in the run column yesterday despite collecting only 6AB with runners in scoring position (all other 10+ games featured at least 10AB; going 3x6, was the second time with 10+ runs on only three hits). On the roadtrip, Columbus has 36 hits with RISP, 2nd most in the IL since 5/5 (St. Paul leads with 42, including 16 this week), while scoring 74 runs (2nd to St. Paul's 89).

### Crazy Eighthths

Columbus had an 8th inning scoring streak snapped at 7G on Tuesday, but has scored in each of the last 2G (also scored in five of six last 9ths). On the year, the Clippers have scored 78 runs from the 8th inning on (19 more than 2nd place), crafting a collective .972OPS (139 points ahead of 2nd). In the 8th alone, Columbus has 16 runs in the last 10G (more than four IL teams have all season).

### Not Seeing It

Since his return from injury (sore right hip, 4/24-5/2), **Cooper Ingle** has drawn only 4BB in 40PA (20BB in 54PA prior), going down on strikes 12 times (9K in first 15G). He reached base multiple times yesterday for the first time since 5/7, as his OBP had fallen to .517 (lowest since .500 on 4/1). He'll bat leadoff for the first time ever as a Clipper today (.311/.426/.485 in 47G at leadoff for Akron last year).

### Since the Option

**Juan Brito** is hitting .250/.360/.516 with 4HR and 17RBI in 16G since getting optioned on 4/28 (9G hit streak snapped Tuesday: .316, 12x38). All of Brito's homers have come from the right side of the plate this year, as he is slugging just .343 from the left (.426SLG vs. RHP from '24-25). **George Valera** is at .176 (9x51) with 4RBI in 12G since his option on 4/30 (.294, 10x34 with 12RBI in 8G April rehab).

### Watch Out for Watson

**Kahliil Watson** is hitting .319/.426/.649 with 16XBH in his last 25G (1XBH in first 12G), having reached base in each of 13G prior to Friday (.453OBP, 4/23-5/13). Since last Sunday, Watson has an IL-best 14RBI and is tied atop the IL with 4HR. However, he has not drawn a walk in his last 6G (28PA; hitting .333, 9x27), his longest walkless stretch since a 9G run from 7/24-8/5/25 (35PA; hit .118, 4x34).

### Misleading Streaks

**Nolan Jones** has reached base in 12 consecutive games, posting a .358OBP since 5/3, but has seen his OBP drop 10 points over the course of the streak, while his batting average has dipped 16 points (.227, 10x44). **George Valera** owns a 9G on base streak since 5/5, but has recorded only a .244OBP on the streak (lost 17 points on his season line), while hitting .184 (7x38; lost 31 points on average).

### Hey Now

After a rocky start to his Triple-A career (1x10, 2K), **Angel Genao** has hit .389/.421/.806 with 3HR and 7RBI in 9G, including four multi-hit games. Yesterday's homer was his sixth between Akron and Columbus in his 35th game (max of 10HR in 110G in 2024). Genao was leading the Eastern League in walks (22) at the time of his promotion, but has just a pair in 48PA with the Clippers (none since 5/9).

### No Experience Necessary

**Maick Collado** saw his Triple-A opening hit streak snapped at 9G on Friday (.382, 13x34 from 4/26-5/9 after skipping over Double-A to make his debut). He followed up with a homer in the nightcap though, giving him 8XBH in 11G with Columbus and 11XBH on the season (21G; career best is 18XBH in 94G with Lake County in 2024). With the bases empty, he is 10x21 (.476) with 6XBH (.857SLG).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

5/17/1978

The Clippers fell to Charleston by a score of 1-0 in 12 innings. Clipper starter **Rod Scurry** threw 10.0 scoreless innings in the game and allowed 7 hits and 2 walks with 8 strikeouts. **Bo McLaughlin** tossed 11.0 shutout innings for the Charlies, allowing just 6 hits with 0 walks and 5 strikeouts. The only run came with 2 outs in the bottom of the 12th as **Keith Drumwright** registered a pinch-hit single to plate **Luis Pujols**.

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 56-59 (.487) in pitch reviews, with batters going 33-43 (.434) and pitchers/catchers going 23-16 (.590). They have run out of challenges in 25G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## On the Runs

Starting with the embiggened 150G schedule in 2022, the Clippers scored over 800 runs in three consecutive seasons from 2022-2024 (855, 808 and 805 runs, respectively; accounting for the 3rd, 4th and 5th best totals in team history). Following a steep decline last season (670, fewest scored in a full season since 2018), Columbus is looking to easily top 800 again, with an outside chance to establish a new team high (on pace for 893, would rank as 2nd most all-time; 898 scored in 1983).

## On the Run

On the basepaths, the Clippers are making a run at the franchise mark in stolen bases, with 66 through the first 44G (on pace for 225SB). The team record was set in 2024 when Columbus swiped an even 200, but the team speed was throttled last year (129SB; still, the 2nd highest total since the Cleveland affiliation started in 2009). However, with 17CS so far, the Clippers are also pacing (58) for the most times caught stealing of the Cleveland affiliation (nabbed 79 times in 2008, last time over 51).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 77 grand slams and 1,920RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## In Big Trouble

The Clipper pitching staff is trending toward the worst ERA in club history, sitting at 5.82 through the first 44G (6.77ERA in last 15G, since 4/30). Since the reorganization of the minor leagues in 2021, Columbus has twice finished the season with a 5+ ERA (current record is 5.32, set in 2023), after having done so just once in the first 43 seasons (5.08 in 1983). However, the staff is pacing to give up only 150HR (lowest total since 133HR in 2018; averaging 182 per season since the Year of the Homer in 2019).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 13th in the IL this year (.976), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 22G this season (13-9, .591), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Stuart Fairchild** moved a runner into scoring position with a bunt single on 5/13 at St. Paul and that runner came around to score in a win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 86-23 (.789) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 3-2 mark this season (.600, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses last season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 408-428 (.488), 378-382 with Columbus (.497).
