

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned its third-straight victory, hanging on for a 6-5 triumph over Asheville on Friday night...Cyclones jumped out to a 6-0 lead entering the bottom of the 7th...Brooklyn scored one in the 4th and 5th on a DH Christian Pregent sacrifice fly and a SS Jett Williams home run...Cyclones tacked on 4 in the 7th on a throwing error, a 18 Ryan Clifford two-run home run, and a 3B William Lugo single...Asheville pulled within one thanks to a 3B Tyler Whitaker round-tripper in the 7th, plus a 3-run clout from C Miguel Palma and a run-producing ground out in the 8th...Tourists put the tying and winning runs at 2nd and 3rd and nobody out in the bottom of the 9th...LHP Eli Ankeney struck out the game's final 3 hitters for the save...RHP Joander Suárez tossed 6.0 innings of 1-hit, shutout ball to earn his 5th victory.

HOMER HAPPY: The Cyclones tied a season-high with 4 home runs in Thursday's win at Asheville...RF Stanley Consuegra clubbed a 455-foot solo home run to center in the 2nd, DH Ryan Clifford tacked on a 2-run blast to right-center in the 3rd, LF Omar De Los Santos added a 2-run clout to left in the 4th, and C Kevin Parada smashed a 2-run blast to right-center in the 7th...Brooklyn also blasted 4 long balls in a 6-1 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 23...Parada homered twice, while 3B William Lugo and LF Jaylen Palmer went deep, as well...The Cyclones had smashed 10 home runs (2.5 HR/G) in the first 4 games of the series, scoring 40 total runs (10.0 R/G)...Brooklyn has not clubbed that many round-trippers in a 4-game span since they walloped 10 between May 27-31 at Bowling Green and at Jersey Shore, tallying 41 total runs.

LAST TRAIN RUNNING: Brooklyn scored a then-season-high 12 runs in Wednesday's 12-5 victory over Asheville and surpassed it with a 13-run performance in Thursday's 13-12 triumph in 10 frames...The Cyclones' previous high water mark was 11 on 2 separate ocasions...Brooklyn bested Wilmington, 1-7, on both July 27 and 30 at Maimonides Park... The 13 runs scored are the most for the 'Clones since they scored 18 runs in an 18-1 win at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...RF **Stanley Consuegra** homered in both Wednesday's contest and the game on 8/28/22...The 25 combined runs over a 2-game period are the most for Brooklyn since scoring 26 between August 27-28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...The Cyclones beat the BlueClaws, 8-3, on August 27, and then throttled Jersey Shore, 18-1, on August 28.

THE HITS KEEP COMING: Brooklyn and Asheville united for 25 runs in the Cyclones' 13-12 win in 10 innings on Thursday night...The 25 tallies are the most combined runs in a single game for the 'Clones in 2023...t is tied for the 3rd-largest combined score in a South Atlantic League game this season...Aberdeen won at Greensboro, 16-14, in 9 innings on July 5, for a total ledger of 30 runs...The 25 combined runs were the most in a single game featuring Brooklyn since May 27, 2022...The Cyclones and Bowling Green Hot Rods united to scratch across 26 runs in Brooklyn's 20-6 victory.

WALK IT OUT: Brooklyn's 10 walks on Wednesday were the most for the squad in a 9-in-ning game this season...The Cyclones earned 12 free passes in an 11-inning, 9-8 win vs. Jersey Shore on Opening Day, April 7...The 10 walks were the most for Brooklyn in a 9-in-ning game since August 28, 2022, at Jersey Shore...LF Rhylan Thomas earned 4 walks in Wednesday's victory tying 3B Jaylen Palmer for the most by a Cyclone in a single game this year...Palmer accomplished the feat in Brooklyn's 9-8, 11-inning Opening Day win vs. Jersey Shore...The 4 free passes were the most by a Cyclone in a 9-inning game since 2B Nic Gaddis walked 4 times in a 10-3 win at Jersey Shore on July 22, 2022...Since Minor League Baseball's stat portal began in 2005, no Brooklyn player has walked more than 4 times in a single game.

JETT THE MET: INFs Jett Williams made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and has been stellar all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing .350/.494/.650 with a 1.144 OPS, 27 runs scored, 12 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, 18 RBI, 34 walks, and 15 stolen bases in 35 games between Brooklyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 155 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.494) or OPS (1.144)...On the season, Williams is 10th in Minor League Baseball in walks (88)...Among teenagers, Williams ranks 2nd in MiLB...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 100 PA) in batting average (.350), on-base percentage (.480), OPS (1.118), doubles (8), and extra-base his (13)...He is also tied for 1st in walks (19) and 2nd in hits (28) and stolen bases (9)...Among SAL players with at least 100 plate appearances in 2023, Williams leads in the circuit in OBP (.480), is 3rd in walk rate (19.0%), wRC+ (199), wOBA (.492), and OPS (1.118).

SUPER SUÂREZ: With 6 strikeouts on Friday night, RHP Joander Suárez broke a tie with RHP Blade Tidwell (112) for Brooklyn's single-season strikeout record...The 23-year-old holds the all-time mark with 118 punch outs in 2023...Tidwell set the mark earlier this season...Over his last 12 appearances (11 starts) since June 14 at Aberdeen, Suárez holds only a 4-5 record, but a 3.34 ERA (21 ER in 56.2 IP), 17 walks (7.3 BB%), and 79 strikeouts (33.8 K%)...Narrowed down to his last 8 starts, the Cumaná, Venezuela native is 2-4, yet holds a 2.72 ERA (13 ER in 43.0 IP) with 10 walks (5.7 BB%) and 54 strikeouts (34.1 K%)...Since the start of July, Suárez is tied for SAL and Minor League lead in strikeouts (63) with Greensboro's RHP Thomas Harrington.

HE'S THE HOME RUN KING: OF Stanley Consuegra broke a tie with C Francisco Álvarez for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on Wednesday night...He added another blast on Thursday and is 3 home runs (19) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...Consuegra homered in each of the first 3 games of the series in Asheville, tying SS Jett Williams (8/19-22) for the most consecutive games with a round-tripper this year...The multi-home run night marked the 2nd of the season for Consuegra...Stanley tallied a pair of solo blasts in a 6-4 loss at Hudson Valley on July 19...He and C Kevin Parada (6/23 vs. HV & 7/15 vs. GBO) are the only 2 players to post multi-homer contests for Brooklyn in 2023...Since the Minor League stat portal began in 2005, Consuegra and Parada are just 2-of-3 Cyclones to post multiple 2-plus home run games...INF Nick Evans accomplished the feat in 2005 on July 22 vs.

vs. ASHEVILLE: Brooklyn begins a 2-week road trip with 6 games against the Astros' High-A affiliate...The Tourists possess 4 of Houston's top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*: OF **Jacob Melton** (1), RHP **Miguel Ullola** (13), OF **Zach Cole** (18), RHP **Nolan DeVos** (24)...Brook-lyn and Asheville are meeting for the second time in each franchise's history...Both squads met at McCormick Field to open the 2021 season...The Tourists took 3-of-5 games in the series from May 4-9...The final game of that series was canceled due to weather.

Jamestown and again on August 24 at Williamsport...Entering Saturday, Consuegra is tied for 4th in the SAL in home runs (19) and 6th in slugging percentage (.474).

DOWN THE STRETCH THEY COME: Brooklyn's looking to manufacture a second-straight playoff appearance and has dropped just 2 of their last 9 series since Greenville won 4-of-6 on Coney Island from June 6-11...The Cyclones are 6-2-2 in their last 10 sets...The Cyclones are 31-21 in the second half and a game ahead of Jersey Shore (30-22) atop the North Division of the SAL with 14 games left to play...The BlueClaws hold the tiebreaker over Brooklyn as a result of winning the season series (15-11).

CLIFF NOTES: OF Ryan Clifford was added to Brooklyn's roster on August 3...The 20-year-old was acquired by the New York Mets with OF Drew Gilbert from the Houston Astros in exchange for RHP Justin Verlander on August 1...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Saturday ranked 2nd in the South Atlantic League in slugging percentage (.507) and 3rd in home runs (20)...He is also 5th in OPS (.849)...Clifford is also 1st in isolated power (.257), and 7th in wORb (.272) and wCb (.4127) wOBA (.375) and wRC+ (127).

THE RHY-T STUFF: In 35 games since July 4 at Wilmington, OF **Rhylan Thomas** has put up bonkers numbers...He is slashing .368/.444/.462 with a .906 OPS at the dish and a 153 wRC+...Thomas has added 17 runs scored, 5 doubles, 2 home runs, 16 RBI, and 17 walks (12.6 BB%) to only 8 strikeouts (59 K%)...Since the start of July, Thomas has led the South Atlantic League in batting average (.358) and has 7 fewer strikeouts (9) than any other batter (min. 130 PA)...He is also 2nd in on-base percentage (.439).

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.41 ERA (286 ER in 754.1 IP) over their last 86 games, holding a 48-38 record in that span, which is tied for the lowest in the minors...The Rangers' Single-A Down East (3.41) is also tied atop MiLB...The Cyclones have hurled 9 shutouts — which is tied for 3rd in MiLB — in that span...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.18), batting average against (.216), and opposing OPS (.642) in that period.

THE AMAZING ALEX: OF Alex Ramírez is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leader-board despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native is 2nd in franchise history in RBI and is 6 (85) behind INF José Peroza (91) for the all-time mark...He surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in total bases (232), hits (158), and walks (69), and 3rd in runs scored (83)...Ramírez is 4 hits behind Peroza (162) for the franchise record.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: Baseball America released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects last Wednesday...10 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Chris-tian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Raimon Gómez (24), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects...Former Cyclones listed include INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasil (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)...In all, 15-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline released their updated list last Thursday evening...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS Jett Williams (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (5), OF Ryan Clifford (6), RHP Blade Tidwell (10), OF Alex Ramírez (11), RHP Christian Scott (12), IF Jacob Reimer (13), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Raimon Gómez (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF Ronny Mauricio (No. 4), RHP Mike Vasil (9), RHP Dominic Hamel (16), and OF Matt Rudick (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100. in the Top 100.

DE RECORD SETTER: OF Omar De Los Santos entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hud-son Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 36 swipes breaks INF Walter Rasquin's franchise record for single-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 105 stolen bases in that span, which is 7th most in MiLB... Only Red Sox prospect INF David Hamilton (119), Mariners farmhand OF Jonatan Clasé (118), D'Backs prospect OF Wilderd Patifo (116), Aberdeen OF Luis Valdez (114), Marlins farmhand INF Nasim Núñez (113), and Cardinals prospect OF Mike Antico (111) have tallied more...De Los Santos has also snagged 57 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time... Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF Jaylen Palmer is 2nd with 49.

LAST TIME OUT: Did not receive a decision in his first start since being reinstated off the injured list last Saturday vs. Hudson Valley...Allowed 3 runs on 5 hits over 4.0 innings... Walked 2 and struck out 3...Induced a double play...Surrendered a 2-run home run to LF Christopher Familia in the top of the 2nd...Relieved by RHP Kolby Kubichek to start the top of the 5th with the Cyclones leading 5-3...Renegades took the lead in the top of the 7th, but a go-ahead 2-run triple from 1B William Lugo was the difference in the Cyclones' 8-7 win.

ON THE MEND: Geber is set to make his 2nd appearance with Brooklyn since landing on the 7-day injured list on May 14...The 24-year-old joined the Florida Complex League Mets on a rehab assignment on July 19...Did not receive a decision and accrued a 6.75 ERA (4 ER in 5.1 IP) with 6 strikeouts over 3 appearances (2 starts)...Rehab transferred Single-A St. Lucie on August 6...Went 0-1 with a 13.50 ERA (8 ER in 5.1 IP) with 4 strikeouts in 2 appearances (1 start).

2022: Signed with the Mets as an undrafted free agent on August 3...Prior, made 4 appearances (3 starts) with the Frederick Keys of the MLB Draft League...Went 2-1 with a 4.96 ERA (9 ER in 16.1 IP) and 16 strikeouts...Assigned to Single-A St. Lucie on August 5...Composed a 1-0 mark with a 5.00 ERA (15 ER in 27.0 IP) and 25 punchouts in 6 outings (4 starts)...Transferred to Double-A Binghamton on September 16...Permitted 3 runs on 4 hits in 2.0 innings, striking out 3, in his lone Rumble Ponies effort on September 18.

MOUNT HOKIE: Geber split his college career between Mount St. Mary's University (Emmitsburg, Md.)...Spent 4 seasons with the Mountaineers...Named to the All-Northeast Conference First Team as a reliever in 2021...Tallied a 2-3 clip with a 3.88 ERA (26 ER in 60.1 IP) with 68 K's in 11 outings (10 starts)...Transferred to Virginia Tech for his graduate season in 2022...Accrued a 1-2 record with a 5.40 ERA (21 ER in 35.0 IP) and 40 whiffs in 16 appearances (7 starts) for the Hokies.

FIRST DRAFT: Geber became one of the first two players to sign with a Major League franchise straightout of the brand new MLB Draft League in 2022...The 23-year-old was the first member of the Keys to sign with a parent club since the league formed prior to the 2021 season...Fellow Cyclones' RHP Joe Joe Rodríguez was the first MLB Draft Leaguer to sign.
