**Tonight's Game:** The Nashville Sounds and Memphis Redbirds play game three of a six-game series tonight. The Redbirds have won the first two games, including a come-from-behind, 7-6 win in extra innings last night. Right-hander Dylan File starts for Nashville against left-hander Kwang Hyun Kim for Memphis.

**Dylan File:** 25-year-old Dylan File starts for the Sounds tonight. The right-hander is 1-2 with a 5.03 ERA in four starts with the Sounds in 2021. He missed the first half of the season after having right elbow surgery on May 2. File has also made four rehab appearances between the ACL Brewers and Advanced-A Wisconsin. Overall in 2021, File is 1-3 with a 5.27 ERA (16 ER/27.1 IP) in eight starts. In 2019, File went 15-6 with a 3.24 ERA in 26 starts between Single-A Carolina and Double-A Biloxi. His 15 wins led all Brewers farmhands and he ranked second in innings pitched (147.0) and fourth in strikeouts (136). He was named a Carolina League All-Star in 2019 and a Midwest League All-Star in 2018. He was drafted by Milwaukee in the 21st round of the 2017 First-Year Player Draft.

**Kwang Hyun Kim:** 33-year-old Kwang Hyun Kim starts for the Redbirds tonight. The left-hander is making his first appearance as part of a Major League rehab assignment. He landed on the 10-day injured list on August 9 with left elbow inflammation. In 19 starts with the Cardinals this year, Kim is 6-6 with a 3.36 ERA. He has covered 91.0 innings and has allowed 80 hits and 31 walks to go along with 70 strikeouts. Tonight's start marks the first Minor League Baseball appearance for Kim who signed with the Cardinals as a free agent on December 17, 2019. He debuted in the big leagues last year and went 3-0 with a 1.62 ERA (7 ER/39.0 IP) in eight games (seven starts).

**2021 Standings:** The Sounds have spent the following number of days in the Triple-A East Southeast Division standings in 2021: First: 23, Second: 59, Third: 5, Fourth: 15, Fifth: 2, Sixth: 0, Seventh: 0.

**Six-Game Skid:** Nashville has lost a season-high six consecutive games. The last time a Sounds team lost seven straight games was when the 2015 team went on a seven-game skid from July 22-28. They dropped the final two games in Colorado Springs before getting swept at home by New Orleans in four games. They dropped the first game at home to Iowa on July 28 before a 6-4 win against the I-Cubs on July 29 snapped the losing streak. The longest losing streak in franchise history is 12 games in 1987.

**Dahl's Addition:** Outfielder David Dahl the club yesterday after being signed to a minor league contract earlier in the day. He went 2-for-4 with a double and RBI in his first game action since August 1 vs. Seattle. He was designated for assignment by Texas on August 1 and released by the Rangers on August 6. Dahl was a first round (10th overall) pick by the Rockies in 2012.

**Rare Loss:** Last night's loss was a rare one in a variety of ways. Nashville lost when leading after seven innings and is now 39-3 when that happens. They are also now 37-10 when outhitting the opponent, something they did 12-7 last night. They also scored 4+ runs and are now 42-9 when doing so.

**Three Knocks Each:** Luke Maile recorded his second 3-hit game of the season last night, and first since May 28 at Columbus, and Pablo Reyes notched his second. It was the first three-hit game for Reyes since June 2 at Charlotte.

**Hiura is Back in Action:** Infielder Keston Hiura was reinstated from the 10-day injured list (covid) on Tuesday and has re-joined the Sounds. Hiura has played in 21 games with Nashville this year and is hitting .405 (30-for-74) with 15 runs, 8 doubles, 5 home runs, 14 RBI and 14 walks. He has reached base safely in every game he has played with the Sounds.

### THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On August 19, 2019, both Matt Davidson and Patrick Wisdom drilled their 28th home run of the season in an 11-5 win in Oklahoma City. Davidson had a three-run shot in the first inning and Wisdom hit a two-run blast in the eighth.

**How Sweet It Is:** Manager Rick Sweet is at the helm for the Sounds in 2021, as he was in 2014 when he led the club to a 77-67 record. Sweet has managed for all or parts of 30 seasons in the minor leagues and has compiled a managerial record of 2,081-1,966. The 2,081 wins are 11th-most all-time among all minor league managers. 10th on the list is Lefty O'Doul who won 2,094 games from 1935-57.

**The Milwaukee Era:** A new era of Nashville Sounds baseball began on February 12, 2021 when the club announced its affiliation with the Milwaukee Brewers. The affiliation with Milwaukee came after the Sounds signed a 10-year Professional Development License (PDL) with Major League Baseball as part of the 20-team Triple-A East League. Within the Triple-A East League, the Sounds are a member of the seven-team Southeast Division.
