### LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox won their third straight game in a 6-4 victory over the Erie SeaWolves. Dylan Beavers launched a go-ahead two-run homer in the eighth inning to give the Baysox the lead for good. After falling behind 2-0 at the end of the third inning, the Baysox tied it up in the fourth on a Collin Burns two-run single. Erie retook the lead in the fifth but Bowie tied it in the sixth on a Jud Fabian homer and a Ryan Higgins bases loaded walk. In his Double A debut, Cameron Weston went four scoreless innings with eight strikeouts to pick up the win.

### SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie Seawolves suffered their first series loss of the season this past week, dropping three of five to Harrisburg at home. Sunday's finale was postponed due to inclement weather. Entering this series, Erie owns the second lowest ERA (2.56) in the league but has scored the fewest runs in the league (71). The defending Eastern League champion's roster includes five of the Tigers' top 30 prospects, per MLB Pipeline - RHP Jackson Jobe (No. 3), RHP Troy Melton (No. 11), IF Hao-Yu Lee (No. 14), RHP Tyler Mattison (No. 27), and OF/INF Trei Cruz (No. 30).

### TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Wilkel Hernandez gets the start for Erie today. The 25-year-old is coming off his worst start of the season after giving up three runs on five hits in just one inning of work last week vs Harrisburg. Before the start, Hernandez had allowed just one run through his first 12.1 innings pitched. The La Carlota, Venezuelan native is in his first season with the SeaWolves after pitching all of last year in High-A West Michigan. The righty threw the sixth-most innings out of Detroit MiLB pitchers last season at 106 innings thrown.

### LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** came through late for the Baysox yesterday with a go-ahead two-run homer in the eighth to give Bowie the lead and the win. All three of Beavers' homers have been go-ahead homers, including two that have been hit in the seventh or later. The Orioles No. 7 prospect owns the third-best batting average in the league (.324) and has the fifth-best OBP (.414). The 22-year-old is tied with Erie's Jake Holton and three other players for the longest on-base streak in the league this season.

### BASALLO HITS BOMBS

After C **Samuel Basallo** recorded his first multi-homer game of the season and his first multi-homer game in Double-A in Richmond on Sunday, the Orioles No. 2 prospect homered again last night, his fourth of the season. The 19-year-old also drove in three RBI for a second consecutive game. In his last two games, Basallo is 5-for-9 at the plate with three homers, a double, and six RBI.

### HOME SWEET HOME

The Baysox have the best home record in the league so far at 9-2. No other Eastern League team has won nine games at home. At Prince George's Stadium, the Baysox lead the league in batting average (.279), home runs (18), OPS (.853), and are tied for first in runs scored with Hartford (78). Bowie pitching has also posted a 2.97 ERA at home this season, fourth-best in the league.

### BRIGHT AT NIGHT

RHP **Trace Bright** makes his fifth start of the season and his eighth career Double-A start. The 23-year-old currently owns the eighth-lowest ERA in the league (2.41) through his first four starts. The Orioles No. 16 prospect has a 1.04 ERA in two home starts. Bright has pitched five innings in his last three starts after going five innings last week at Richmond, allowing just one run on four hits with six strikeouts in the defeat. The fifth-rounder out of Auburn in 2022 is in his first full season on the bump for the Baysox after debuting at Double-A last year. He made his Double-A debut against Erie on August 26, 2023 and went four scoreless innings with five strikeouts in a no decision at UPMC Park.

### CATCHER IN THE RYE

C **Silas Ardoin** has been arguably the best defensive catcher in the league, thus far. The 23-year-old has caught a league leading 11 base runners stealing and has allowed only nine stolen bases. Yesterday, Ardoin committed his first error of the season, which is just his second career error in Double-A. The Orioles fourth round pick in 2022 has yet to give up a passed ball this season.

**2024:** Named to Bowie Opening Day roster. **Has gone five innings in last three starts. Punched out six over five innings of one-run ball on season-high 84 pitches on 4/26 @ RIC in loss...** Struck out 14 batters over 8.2 innings in first two starts of year. Gave up career-high nine hits on 4/20 vs ALT but gave up only 1 ER thanks to defense turning four double plays.

**2023:** Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen. Made 22 appearances (18 starts) and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 innings. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished four in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26 at Erie. Struck out five over four scoreless innings on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

**2022:** Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

**College:** Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

**Personal:** Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

### CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE

The “Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake” are an alternate identity of the Baysox, as a part of MiLB’s “Copa de la Diversión™” or “Fun Cup™”. During select games during the 2024 season, the Baysox will take the field as the Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake, as the Baysox look to continue to embrace the culture of local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie’s “Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake” identity came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.



### CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the “Chesapeake Baysox.” This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stenciled outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince George’s Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

### BOWIE PIT BEEF

The “Bowie Pit Beef” is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore’s east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.



## COACHING STAFF

### ROBERTO MERCADO

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization’s Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticut. He began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent time as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

### AUSTIN MEINE

Pitching Coach

Meine joins Mercado in the move from High-A Aberdeen. Meine served as the IronBirds pitching coach in 2023, where he helped Aberdeen post the third-lowest ERA (3.81) and second-most strikeouts (1,363) across the South Atlantic League. He previously spent two seasons on staff at the University of North Carolina at Charlotte, where he guided the 49ers to the two highest single-season strikeout totals in program history. Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

### JOSH BUNSELMEYER

Hitting Coach

Bunselmeyer served as the hitting coach for the Orioles’ Single-A affiliate, the Delmarva Shorebirds, last season. 2024 is Bunselmeyer’s fifth season in the Orioles’ system after also spending the previous three campaigns as a hitting coach in both the Florida Complex League and Dominican Summer League. He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.

### CHASE SEBBY

Fundamentals Coach

Sebbly joins the Baysox staff as the Fundamentals Coach in 2024. Sebbly was the fundamentals coach in Aberdeen last season and was a development coach within the Orioles’ organization in 2022. Sebbly played collegiately as a catcher at Cypress College and Ball State.

### BILLY FACTEAU

Development Coach

A familiar face in Bowie, Facteau rejoins the Baysox staff in 2024. Facteau was the development coach in Aberdeen last season, but began his professional coaching career as a development coach on the Baysox staff in 2022. Prior to his first stint with Bowie, Facteau first served in the Orioles’ organization as a technology intern.
