

LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn earned its 7th walk-off win of the season in a 4-3 triumph over Wilmington on Friday...The Cyclones tied the game on a SS William Lugo double and ended it on a 1B Drake Osborn sacrifice fly...3B Luis Guillorme went 0-for-3 in 5 in-nings as part of a Major League rehab assignment...CF Jett Williams and C José Mena each accrued multi-hit efforts...CF Daylen Lile, RF Andrew Pinckney, and 3B Yohandy Morales all totaled multi-hit games for Wilmington...RHP Benito García tossed 4.0 in-nings of 1-hit shutout ball — striking out 4 — to earn the victory in relief for Brooklyn.

ON THE FINAL FEW CORKSCREWS: Brooklyn is looking to secure a second-straight playoff appearance...The Cyclones are 37-27 in the second half and are a half-game ahead of Jersey Shore (36-27) atop the North Division of the SAL with 2 games left to play...Jersey Shore still has 3 left to play as a result of yesterday's rain out in Hudson Valley...The BlueClaws will play a twinbill starting at 3:35 PM ET on Saturday...Brooklyn can clinch the North Division crown with a win and 2 Jersey Shore losses on Satur-day...The Cyclones can also be eliminated with a loss and 2 BlueClaw victories...Jersey Shore holds the tiebreaker over Brooklyn because of winning the season series (15-11).

It's A WALK-OFF: Brooklyn earned its 7th walk-off victory of the 2023 season with 1B Drake Osborn's 9th-inning sacrifice fly on Friday night...The triumph marked the first walk-off win for the Cyclones since RF Omar De Los Santos scored on a wild pitch in the 9th in a 2-1 win vs. Hudson Valley on June 25...The 'Clones also earned game-end-ing wins on June 7 vs. Greenville (DH Kevin Parada single), May 26 vs. Winston-Salem (IB José Mena single), May 2 vs. Aberdeen (LF Omar De Los Santos single), April 22 vs. Wilmington (LF Alex Ramírez single), and April 7 vs. Jersey Shore (1B Chase Estep walk)...Friday's win also marked Brooklyn's 28th come-from-behind victory and 13th win in their final at-bat. in their final at-bat

SAY IT'S YOUR BIRTHDAY: The Cyclones celebrate a pair of birthdays on Saturday... Manager Chris Newell celebrates his 50th birthday and INF Junior Tilien celebrates his 21st birthday...RHP Dylan Hall turned 26 on Thursday.

THE GUI-EST OF HONOR: INF Luis Guillorme joined the Cyclones on Friday to start a Major League rehab assignment...The 28-year-old has been on the Mets' 10-day injured list since July 22 with a right calf strain...He went 0-for-3 with 3 strikeouts in 5 innings during his first contest...Guillorme has appeared in 50 games at the Major League level this year, posting a .238/.304/.347 slash line with a .651 OPS, adding a home run and 9 RBI...The left-handed swinger started the year on the Mets' Opening Day roster before being optioned to Triple-A Syracuse on May 17...He was recalled back to New York on June 9...In 331 MLB games with the Mets since 2018, Guillorme is a .263 (188-715) lifetime hitter with a .683 OPS in addition to 5 home runs and 48 RBI...The Venezue-lan-born infielder appeared in 125 South Atlantic League games with Single-A Savannah in 2014 and 2015, composing a slash line of .319/.391/.354 with a .745 OPS.

JETT THE MET: INF Jett Williams has been stellar since he made his Cyclones debut on August 1 and all summer long...Since returning from the All-Star break on July 14, the 19-year-old is slashing. 313/467/L589 with a 1.056 OPS, 35 runs scored, 13 doubles, 4 triples, 8 home runs, 21 RBI, 45 walks, and 16 stolen bases in 47 games between Brook-lyn and Single-A St. Lucie...Since that date, no player in Minor League Baseball (min. 210 PA) has a higher on-base percentage (.467) or OPS (1.056)...On the season, Williams is 5th in Minor League Baseball in walks (99)...With one more walk, the Texas native will be the first teenager in MiLB to reach the century mark in free passes since the stat portal started in 2005...Since making his SAL debut, the Rockwall, Texas, native has led the circuit (min. 120 PA) in on-base percentage (.447), OPS (1.005), walks (30), and extra-base hits (17)...He is also tied for 2nd in doubles (9) and hits (36), 3rd in slugging percentage (.558), tied for 3rd in stolen bases (10), and 5th in batting average (.300)... Among SAL players with at least 150 plate appearances in 2023, Williams is 2nd in the circuit in walk rate (19.7%), OBP (.447), wRC+ (174), wOBA (.451), and OPS (1.005).

TOP OF THE LADDER: With his leadoff double in the bottom of the 6th on Thursday vs TOP OF THE LADDER: With his leadoft double in the bottom of the 6th on Thursday vs. Wilmington, OF Alex Ramírez broke a tie with INF José Peroza (162) for the Cyclones' all-time hit record...He added to his record with a single on Friday and is at 164 all-time... The 20-year-old is scattered among the Cyclones' all-time leaderboard despite joining the team last July 4...Entering Saturday, the Dominican native also surpassed Peroza for 1st in doubles (37), is 2nd in walks (70), tied for 2nd in runs scored (86), 3rd in RBI (87) behind OF Stanley Consuegra (88) and Peroza (91), and 3rd in total bases (242).

KING STANLEY: OF Stanley Consuegra broke a te with C Francisco Álvarez for the franchise record in career home runs by blasting his 23rd with Brooklyn in the top of the 5th on August 23 at Asheville...<u>He added another blast on Wednesday and is 1 home</u> run (21) behind Álvarez (22) for the single-season home run mark...He and Álvarez are the only two players in franchise history to record a 20-plus home run season... Entering Saturday, Consuegra is 4th in the SAL slugging percentage (.477), tied for 4th in home runs (21), tied for 7th in extra-base hits (40), and 8th in total bases (163)...Over his last 19 games since August 17, the 22-year-old is slashing .243/.309/.608 with a .917 OPS, adding 18 runs scored, 2 doubles, 2 triples, 7 home runs, and 20 RBI...Since that date, Stanley has led the SAL in homers (7) in addition to being tied for the lead in triples (2). in triples (2).

vs. WILMINGTON: Brooklyn returns home for the final regular season series in 2023 against the Na-tionals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks possess 7 of Washington's top 30 prospects per Baseball America: 3B Yohandy Morales (8), LHP Jake Ben-nett (10), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (13), OF Daylen Lile (14), OF T.J. White (16), RHP Andry Lara (19)... De La Rosa is currently on the 7-day IL and White is on the Development List...Through the first 28 meetings of the season, Brooklyn is 15-13 against Wilmington, including 8-8 at Maimonides Park... The Cyclones are 7-5 this year against the Blue Rocks at Frawley Stadium...The 'Clones are 41-37 all-time against the 'Rocks.

DON'T TREAD ON US: Brooklyn's outfield has done a marvelous job neutralizing runners on the basepaths in 2023...The Cyclones have set a franchise record for outfield as-sists in a single season with 41 dating back to the start of MiLB's stat portal in 2005... The previous franchise high was 30 set back in the 2006 season...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn leads all High-A teams in outfield assists and has 7 more than the squad with the second-most (Asheville, 34)...Among all MiLB teams, the Cyclones' 41 outfield assists are tied for 7th...In addition, Stanley Consuegra and Alex Ramírez are tied for the team's single-season franchise record for individual assists with 11...That mark is tied for 2nd in the SAL this year behind Greensboro's Sammy Siani (12)...Before 2023, the previous single-season high for Brooklyn was 9 held by 6 different players.

CLIFF NOTES: OF **Ryan Clifford** has been an on-base machine since joining the Cy-clones on August 3...The 20-year-old has reached base safely in 15 straight games dat-ing back to the start of Brooklyn's two-week road trip...Since making his debut with the 'Clones, Clifford is tied for 5th in the South Atlantic League in home runs (6) and tied for 7th in walks (18)...The North Carolina native already has nearly as many walks (21) as he did in 28 fewer games (30 to 58) and 118 fewer plate appearances (132 to 250) than he had with Asheville before the trade...The 2022 11th-round pick enters Saturday 3rd in the SAL in slugging percentage (.491) and home runs (22), 6th in OPS (.831), and 7th in RBI (65)...Clifford also leads in isolated power (.247) by a percentage point over teammate OF **Stanley Consuegra** (.246) and is 8th in wOBA (.370) and wRC+ (123).

LUGO LAND: INF **William Lugo** has been red hot over the last several weeks for Brook-lyn...Lugo has reached safely in 14 consecutive games and is 17-for-49 at the plate (.347) with 8 runs scored, 4 doubles, 9 RBI, and 9 walks...Since August 15, Lugo is slashing .38/.419/.446 with a .865 OPS...Lugo has also scored 10 runs, picked up 6 doubles, a triple, 15 RBI, and 10 walks in 21 games...The Dominican native is tied for 3rd in the league in doubles (6), tied for 4th in hits (25), and tied for 6th in batting average (.338), and RBI (15) in that span.

BEST IN SHOW: Since the start of a 4-game winning streak at Hudson Valley on May 17, the Cyclones' pitching staff has, statistically, been one of the most dominant in Minor League Baseball...Entering Saturday, Brooklyn has posted a 3.45 ERA (327 ER in 853.1 IP) over their last 98 games, holding a 54-44 record, which is the 2nd lowest in the minors...Tampa Bay's Single-A Charleston (3.42) holds the lowest mark...The Cyclones have hurled 10 shutouts in that span, tied for 3rd most in MiLB...For the entire season, Brooklyn holds the 6th-lowest ERA (3.76)...Additionally, Brooklyn pitching holds the 3rd lowest opposing OPS (.647), and 4th lowest hits-per-9 innings (7.34) and batting average against (.220).

DE RECORD SETTER: OF **Omar De Los Santos** entered as a pinch-runner and caught Hudson Valley napping to steal second base on July 21, giving him 33 stolen bases in 2023...The current 37 swipes breaks INF **Walter Rasquin**'s franchise record for sin-gle-season stolen bases (32) which was set back in 2017 when Brooklyn played in the short-season New York-Penn League...He is also 4th in the SAL in stolen bases for 2023...De Los Santos remains among the best base stealers in Minor League Baseball since the beginning of 2022...The Dominican native has accumulated 107 stolen bases in that span, which is 8th most in MiLB...De Los Santos has also snagged 58 more bases than any other Mets prospect in that time...Fellow 2023 Cyclone IF/OF **Jaylen Palmer** is 2nd with 49.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: *Baseball America* released their updated list of Top 30 New York Mets' prospects...11 members of the 2023 squad are featured...OF Ryan Clifford (No. 3), SS Jett Williams (4), C Kevin Parada (7), RHP Blade Tidwell (9), RHP Christian Scott (10), OF Alex Ramírez (12), 3B Jacob Reimer (14), RHP Tyler Stuart (22), RHP Rai-mon Gómez (24), RHP Layonel Ovalles (28), and RHP Jordany Ventura (29)...Williams (No. 98) and Clifford (99) also appear on the publication's list of Top 100 prospects... Former Cyclones listed include INF Ronny Mauricio (No. 6), RHP Mike Vasil (8), RHP Dominic Hamel (19), OF Matt Rudick (20), and RHP Junior Santos (27)...In all, 16-of-30 members of BA's Top 30 have experience playing on Coney Island...MLB Pipeline re-leased their updated list, as well...8 members of the 2023 team are recognized...SS Jett Williams (No. 3), C Kevin Parada (5), OF Ryan Clifford (6), RHP Blade Tidwell (10), OF Alex Ramírez (11), RHP Christian Scott (12), IF Jacob Reimer (13), RHP Tyler Stuart (17), and RHP Raimon Gómez (25)...Former Brooklyn stars featured are: IF Ronny Mauricio (No. 4), RHP Mike Vasil (9), RHP Dominic Hamel (16), and OF Matt Rudick (27)...Williams (No. 84), Mauricio (93), and Parada (96) are recognized in the Top 100.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no decision in his first start for the Cyclones last Sunday at Greenville...Allowed 4 runs on 7 hits over 5.0 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 3...Threw 77 pitches and 54 strikes (70.1%)...Relieved by RHP Miguel Alfonseca to start the bottom of the 6th with the game tied at 4...Both teams traded leads multiple times in the final few innings, as the Drive defeated the Cyclones, 9-8.

BETTER CALL SAÚL: García joined Brooklyn from Single-A St. Lucie on Tuesday...The 20-year-old made 22 appearances (8 starts) with the Mets prior to joining the South Atlantic League...García tallied a 5-9 record with a 5.35 ERA (40 ER in 67.1 IP) and 2 saves...The righthander walked 48 (15.9 BB%) and struck out 96 (31.9 K%)...García best outing of the season came in his peniumlate appearance with St. Lucie...In Game 1 of a doubleheader on August 18 vs. Jupiter, the Venezuela native earned the win by striking out a career-high-tying 9 in a career-long 6.0 shutout innings of 1-run ball.

2022: Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on June 5...Pitched predominantly as a reliever, making 14 appearances, but just 2 starts...Composed a 2-2 record with a 4.94 ERA (17 ER in 31.0 IP) and 1 save... Walked 23 (15.6 BB%) and punched out 46 (31.3 K%).

STARTING ON THE RIGHT FOOT: García is slated to make his 10th start of the year and his 2nd at the High-A level...In his first 8 starts with St. Lucie, the 20-year-old registered a 2-5 mark with a 4.82 ERA (15 ER in 28.0 IP) and 24 walks (18.6 BB%) to 41 strikeouts (31.8 K%)...His numbers were not quite as good in relief...García held a 3-4 clip with a 5.72 ERA (25 ER in 39.1 IP) and 2 saves... The right-hander walked 24 (14.0 BB%) and struck out 55 (32.0 K%).
