**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** C **Nic Gaddis** and OF **Matt Rudick** each homered, but Hudson Valley had the last laugh, beating Brooklyn 8-5 on Wednesday night at Dutchess Stadium. Brooklyn RHP **Mike Vasil** had an early 3-0 lead but gave up five over 3 2/3 innings, while RHP **Matt Sauer**, the Renegades starter, allowed one run over 5 2/3 innings after allowing a first-inning three run home run. INF **Shervyen Newton** went 2-3 with a double in the loss. RHP **Michael Krauz** made his affiliated debut, tossing a scoreless eighth inning.

**METS-YANKS:** Brooklyn faces Hudson Valley 30 times this season, having already played 14 times. The Renegades have won eight of the 14 games. The Cyclones are hitting just .165 with a .283 on-base percentage against the Renegades over 14 games with a 33% strikeout rate. Against the rest of the league, the Cyclones are hitting .220 with a .312 on-base percentage with a 25% strikeout rate.

**BOMBOSAS:** Since the May 22nd doubleheader against Hudson Valley where the Cyclones blasted five home runs in Coney Island, Brooklyn has completely turned around its power at the plate. The Cyclones have run into 30 home runs in the past 37 games after just seven over the team's first 34 games.

**JT'S JUNE 1B** **JT Schwartz** leads the team with 34 total bases in June, batting .304 with a .354 OBP. The No. 19 prospect in the Mets organization has raised his batting average from .241 to .267 this month. The tall lefty has played a team-high 66 games in 2022.

**THE GRANT POOBAH:** RHP **Grant Hartwig** earned his sixth save of the year last week, sitting one off league leaders Jason Ruffcorn of Jersey Shore and Joe LaSorsa of Bowling Green. Hartwig is a perfect six for six in saves and owns a staff-best 45% strike-

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The New York Yankees farm club has won eight of the 14 games so far with 16 head-to-head games remaining. The Renegades host seven of the Yankees' Top 30 prospects, including a trio of Top 10 prospects: No. 6 SS Trey Sweeney, No. 8 RHP Yoendrys Gomez, and No. 10 OF Everson Pereira. The Renegades are managed by first-year skipper Tyson Blaser.

out rate. The former Miami RedHawks pitcher has allowed just one run in 13 innings.

**ARMS STRONG:** Brooklyn arms have posted a 3.59 earned run average in 28 games with 16 home runs in June, after posting a 5.27 ERA in 23 May games with 20 home runs allowed. In April, the Cyclones pitching staff stood as one of the best in the minors, posting a 2.98 ERA with just four home runs allowed and a 27% strikeout rate.

**MURPHY'S NEW LAW:** OF **Tanner Murphy** has been on a tear over his past 10 games, going 12-32 (.375) with a double, triple, and two home runs -- good for an .656 slugging percentage over the stretch and a 1.115 OPS. Murphy is hitting .244 over 28 games with Brooklyn this year. Last year, Murphy hit just .181 through 23 High-A games.

**FIVE MILLION:** This past home series against Jersey Shore, Catherine Bruning was celebrated as the five-millionth fan. The Cyclones crossed over the plateau into 5,000,000 on Friday night.

**SECOND HALF START:** Thursday, June 24th, marked the start of the second half of the season in the South Atlantic League. Brooklyn finished the first half 30-36. Aberdeen won the North Division, while Bowling Green won the South. The final 66 games of the season determine the next two teams to make the playoffs.

**GLORIOUS JUNE:** Nick Zwack has been Brooklyn's best pitcher in June, allowing one run over 19 innings, good for a 0.47 ERA. Last week, Zwack continued his stretch with five scoreless with Jersey Shore.

**SWEET STRIKEOUT SUCCESS:** Zwack tossed just 12 2/3 innings with Low-A St. Lucie, making two starts and two other relief appearances, striking out 24 batters. The southpaw's strikeout rate was 46% in the Florida State League with a 3.8% walk rate.

**YEAR ONE:** After his draft selection mid-summer in 2021, Zwack reported to Florida to pitch for the Complex team, making five relief appearances with 13 strikeouts and two walks over just seven total frames.

**BIG EAST BEST:** Zack earned Big East Conference First-Team accolades after his 2021 campaign for the Xavier Musketeers, tossing a team-high 80 innings. He finished his Xavier career with the 12th-most wins in team history (15) and the sixth-most strikeouts in school history (214).

**X MARKS THE SPOT:** Xavier has been involved with two Hall of Famers -- Frank Robinson who spent 21 years in the Major Leagues with Cincinnati, Baltimore, Los Angeles (NL), California, and Cleveland. Robinson enrolled in Xavier after his first MLB season. On the pitching side, Jim Bunning, who pitched 591 games in the big leagues, represents the most famous arm out of the small Cincinnati college.

**MINNESOTA!** The left hails from Monticello, Minnesota where he played baseball, hockey, and was the quarterback on his high school football team. He is the only player from his high school -- Monticello High School - to ever play professional baseball.
