PLAYOFF BOUND

The Omaha Storm Chasers won the International League 1st Half title with a 49-24 record and 3.5-game lead on second-place Syracuse to end the half, the best Minor League team in the 1st half of the 2024 season.

- Winning the first half in the league secures the Storm Chasers home field advantage in the International League Championship Series, a best-of-three series that will be played at Werner Park from September 24 to 26.
- This September will mark Omaha's first appearance in the playoffs since 2014, when the Chasers won their 2nd of back-to-back Triple-A National Championships.
- The Triple-A Omaha franchise has 17 playoff appearances in the last 55 years, including most recently four straight seasons: 2011 to 2014.

NOTES AND NUGGETS IN GOOD STANDINGS

While the standings reset for the start of the 2nd half on June 25, Omaha's enters today a season-best 31 games over .500 with an overall 75-44 record (.630 winning percentage).

- Of 120 full season Minor League teams, Omaha's .630 winning percentage overall this year is the BEST in the Minors ... the next-best team in Minor League Baseball is the Palm Beach Cardinals (70-43 / .619 winning %).
- 75 wins are the most of any team in Minor League Baseball this season, one ahead of Triple-A Sugar Land and one of five Minor League teams with 70 wins.
- The Storm Chasers have still been 1st or 2nd in the Minors in wins every day since May 25 ... Omaha previously held sole possession of the best winning percentage in full-season Minor League Baseball for 30 days, June 5 to July 5.
- Omaha is currently on pace for 93 wins ... the franchise record is 86 wins from the Omaha Royals in 1990 ... the best winning percentage in Triple-A Omaha history was .607 (85-55) in the inaugural 1969 season ... over 54 seasons of Triple-A Omaha baseball, there have been seven 80-win seasons, most recently the 2012 (83 wins) and 2015 (80 wins) Storm Chasers.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

72 of Omaha's 119 games this year have been decided by 3 runs or less (61%), including 28 of 44 losses in 2024, with 15 of 44 losses by just one run (32%).

- Close games have been a struggle for Omaha in recent weeks, with the bullpen converting just 13 of its last 26 save opportunities, since June 5 (50%).
- Omaha is 23-15 in 1-run games this season, which ranks as the 4th-most 1-run wins of any Minor League team ... Akron lead MiLB with 25 1-run wins.
- Omaha's 33 saves are tied for the most in the league, tied 2nd-most at the Triple-A level and tied 8th in the Minors ... **Evan Sisk** has recorded the team's last 7 saves.

I'M DIFFERENT, YEAH, I'M (RUN) DIFFERENT(IAL)

Omaha has outscored its opponents 656 to 523 this season, a +133 run differential.

- A +133 run differential this year ranks as the best mark both in the International League and at the Triple-A level as well, ahead of Tacoma (+107).
- Omaha is 7th in Minor League Baseball in run differential ... the Midland RockHounds lead the Minors in run differential at +143 (569 to 423).

COMEBACK KIDS

Omaha has 40 come-from-behind wins this season, meaning over half (53%) of this year's wins have been games where the Chasers trailed at some point.

- Omaha has trailed for 3 innings or more in 16 of the 40 comeback wins.
- The Storm Chasers have 6 wins where the club had to overcome multiple deficits.
- Omaha has 11 victories in games where the Chasers trailed after the 6th inning.
- The Storm Chasers have come back from down as many as 5 runs to win and have overcome a 3+ run deficit to win on 11 occasions.

KICKSTART MY GAME

Storm Chaser starting pitchers have been some of the best in Triple-A in August.

- Omaha's starters have combined for a 2.02 ERA (20 ER in 89.0 IP) over 17 games this month, 4th in the Minors ... a 0.98 WHIP is tied 3rd in MiLB.
- Omaha has a quality start in 7 of 17 games this month, with 3 from **Noah Cameron** and 2 from **Daniel Lynch IV** ... 13 of 17 August starts have been at least 5.0 innings.
- 72.1 innings this month from Omaha's starters rank as the 5th-most in Minor League Baseball ... in the 2nd half, 30 of Omaha's 46 starts have been at least 5.0 innings.

BACK IN BUFFALO

This week, the Omaha Storm Chasers travel to Sahlen Field in Buffalo, New York to play the Buffalo Bisons, the first meeting between the clubs since 1997.

- Omaha and Buffalo previously played in the Triple-A American Association together from 1985 until 1997 ... in 1998, Omaha moved to the Pacific Coast League and Buffalo joined the International League, with Omaha joining the IL in 2021.
- In 1997, the Omaha Royals (Kansas City Triple-A) and Buffalo Bisons (Cleveland Triple-A) played 18 games against each other, 9 at Rosenblatt Stadium and 9 at what was then named North AmeriCare Park.

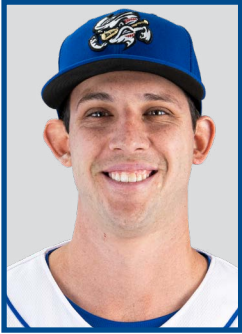

TODAY'S START

- Lynch IV is making his 21st Omaha start this season, his 24th overall start and 26th overall appearance in 2024... Daniel is on his 4th stint in Triple-A with Omaha, previously with the Storm Chasers March 29 to May 4, May 10 to May 29 and May 31 to June 1. He ranks 3rd in the International League in ERA (3.57), 3rd in innings pitched (113.1), 4th in WHIP (1.27) and tied 8th in opponents' average (.261) ... leads Royals Minor League pitchers in innings pitched, tied 2nd in starts (20). Added the 'IV' to his name before his July 18, 2023 start vs. Detroit to honor his father, Daniel Lynch III, and grandfather, Daniel Lynch II.

LAST OUTING: WEDNESDAY, AUGUST 14 vs. LOUISVILLE

Snapped a streak of 4 straight quality starts, allowed 4 runs on 5.0 innings on 92 pitches ... 11 hits allowed are the most by a Storm Chaser pitcher this season ... allowed 2 runs in the 1st inning on five hits and a walk, stranded the bases loaded ... worked around a double in the 2nd ... 3 singles loaded the bases, got a double play ball and escaped with 1 run allowed ... allowed a pair of singles in the 4th ... surrendered a solo homer to P.J. Higgins in the 5th inning, the first time since June 29 he allowed more than 3 runs in a game.

2024 HIGHLIGHTS

- Daniel was optioned to Triple-A Omaha on March 20 and started Opening Day for the Storm Chasers, March 29 @ Iowa, his first of 15 Omaha starts that have been 5.0 innings or more this season.
