RHP CHASE SILSETH (2-1, 4.43) vs. LHP CARSON PALMQUIST (1-2, 4.24)

TODAY'S GAME: Albuquerque tied the series at two games apiece vesterday after claiming a 5-2 come-from-behind victory last night ... Carson Palmquist is expected to take the hill for the Isotopes while Farmington native Chase Silseth is slated to start for Salt Lake.

30: Sam Hilliard has a 30-game Triple-A on base streak dating back to June 11, 2024, the 11th time in team history a player has reached base in at least 30 consecutive games

COME-FROM-BEHIND: Friday was the Isotopes third victory when trailing in the seventh inning or later, and all have come at home against the Salt Lake Bees. They also rallied via Braxton Fulford's walk-off home run on April 4, and Sam Hilliard's gameending double Tuesday in the series opener.

XBH: The Bees did not collect an extra-base hit last night, ending a streak of 182 games in which Albuquerque's pitching staff surrendered at least one. The last time the Isotopes allowed only singles was Sept. 22, 2023, vs. Oklahoma City.

HITS ALLOWED: Yesterday marked the fourth time in 2025 in which Albuquerque limited their opponent to four or fewer hits (last: April 15 vs. El Paso, four).

RUNS ALLOWED: The Isotopes have allowed two or fewer runs six times in 2025. The pitching staff had only accomplished the feat once through 31 games last season.

ISOTOPES RBI RECORD: Sam Hilliard has 228 RBI with Albuquerque, which ranks third among career leaders in team history. Jordan Patterson (2016-18) is second with 229 RBI.

OPPOSING STARTER: Salt Lake right-hander Shaun Anderson pitched 6.0 innings of one-run ball last night, the fourth time in the last 10 games an opposing starter worked exactly six frames. It was the second time in 2025 a hurler completed at least 5.0 innings while giving up one or fewer runs (also: Brett Kerry, April 1, no runs).

BEHIND THE DISH: Albuquerque catchers (Braxton Fulford, Austin Nola and Ronaiker Palma) have combined to slash .393/.438/.643 with 44 hits, 10 doubles, six homers and 16 RBI on the year, leading the PCL in hits, doubles, average, OBP and slugging percentage.

RUNS SCORED: Albuquerque snapped a streak of five consecutive games scoring three or fewer runs yesterday. After Friday's win, they have now plated 17 tallies across the last six contests

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard swatted a single yesterday to extend his 2025 on-base streak to 22 games, every game he's played this year. It's the longest on-base streak in the PCL this season and the third-longest in Triple-A ... Has a hit in five-straight games (7x20)

JC: Julio Carreras doubled yesterday to extend his hitting streak to nine games, third-longest active hit streak in the PCL and with three doubles, one triple and six RBI during the stretch ... It's his longest since Sept. 10, 2022-April 13, 2023, spanning two seasons with Hartford (10 contests).

THE VET: Austin Nola recorded two hits yesterday, including a double. Has a hit in six-straight games. Slashing .583/.600/.750 with four doubles, 14 hits and three RBI during stretch ... Has six multi-hit games on the year and five in his last six contests.

BRAX: Braxton Fulford doubled Thursday to extend his hitting streak to 10 contests, the second-longest active hit streak in the PCL. During the streak he is slashing .432/.488/.919 with three doubles, five homers and 11 RBI.

HIT STREAK: Fulford's hit streak is the first double-digit streak for an Isotope since Greg Jones (18) from Aug. 25-Sept. 15, 2024

KESTDADDY: Keston Hiura has recorded multiple hits in consecutive games for the third time in 2025 (also: April 2-5 vs. Salt Lake, April 16-17 vs. El Paso). Eight of his 15 knocks have come against the Bees.

STERLIN: Sterlin Thompson went 2-for-4 last, his third multi-hit game of the season (also: March 28 at Sacramento, April 17 vs. El Paso).

WARMIN' UP: Over Warming Bernabel's last 17 games, he is slashing .338/.387/.569 with nine doubles, two homers and 18

BOONIE: Six of Trevor Boone's 10 hits for Albuquerque this season have been for extra bases (three doubles, one triple and two homers) ... Has 13 RBI across 35 at-bats for Albuquerque in nine games.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Warming Bernabel is T-7th in XBH (14) and doubles (10) ... Ryan Ritter is T-4th in walks (23) ... Yanquiel Fernandez is T-2nd in homers (7) ... Sam Hilliard is 1st in triples (3).

NUCLEI	NOTES

SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 21st year as a minor league manager and third guiding the Isotopes. He is the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1 ... Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his fourth season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his third season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five seasons with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2014-17). He was also the Minor League pitching coordinator for the Miami Marlins form 2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his second year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... The former outfielder played in 33 games for the Isotopes and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the third-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 22) will host the second half winner (beginning June 24) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, on September 27.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Challenge System, in it's third full year in the PCL, will be used exclusively for every game this season. Under this system, the home plate umpire will call balls or strikes while each team has the opportunity to challenge the umpire's call with two challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
