## HOW TO PARTICIPATE!

### Option #1: On-Campus Assembly

The Gwinnett Stripers mascot, Chopper, and his friends at the Gwinnett Stripers will host an on-campus, 30-minute “pep-rally” style education assembly to get students excited about the “Hooked on Books” reading program! \*\* Available to schools within a 15-mile radius of the Stripers. \*\*

### Option #2: Virtual Participation

The Gwinnett Stripers will provide a “Hooked on Books” hype video to get students excited about our reading program, as well as instructions regarding student participation.

“Hooked On Books” assemblies will run from **January 12th to March 16th, 2026**. Materials to track student progress will be provided to schools before their chosen assembly date.
