#### SUNDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox ended a season-long 10-game losing streak on Sunday with a 7-3 victory in the series finale over Akron. Brandon Butterworth, Aron Estrada and Doug Hodo all homered to pace the offense. Estrada collected his first three RBI game at Double-A. Starter Juaron Watts-Brown struck out seven in 4.2 innings. Trace Bright collected the win with four innings of one-run ball.

#### CHIGUIRE ON THE COMEBACK

RHP Albert Suárez is scheduled to begin a rehab assignment in Double-A Chesapeake and is tonight's scheduled starter. The 35-year-old has been on the injured list since the third day of the regular season due to a right subscapularis strain. Suarez last pitched on March 28 in Toronto. The second-year Oriole pitched 32 games (24 starts) last season and recorded a 3.70 ERA in 133.2 innings pitched.

#### ESTRADA IS ELECTRIC

IF Aron Estrada was promoted to Double-A Chesapeake two weeks ago. In his first Double-A series against New Hampshire, Estrada homered in each of his first two games at the level and registered hits in five of six contests. The 20-year-old led High-A Aberdeen in AVG, H, 2B, 3B, RBI and OBP at the time of his promotion.

#### SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

IF Brandon Butterworth has adjusted to his new scenery just fine. One of six prospects received in the Ryan O'Hearn/Ramon Laureano trade, Butterworth has reached base in his first eight games since joining the Baysox. The 22-year-old had the sixthmost extra-base hits (35) and the most triples (7) in the Midwest League during his time with High-A Fort Wayne (SD).

#### SOMEWHERE OVERN THE RAINBOW

OF Austin Overn made his Double-A debut with Chesapeake on Tuesday. The No. 30 Orioles prospect leads the Orioles farm with 49 stolen bases this season between High-A and Double-A. In his first Double-A series in Akron, Overn hit safely in four of five games and swiped six bases without getting caught.

#### **BULLPEN TROUBLES**

The Chesapeake bullpen has been one of the team's strengths in 2025, posting a 3.38 ERA (8th-best in Double-A) this season. However, since July 30, the Chesapeake bullpen has posted a 6.08 ERA (28 ER/44.1 IP), which is fourth-highest in Double-A. Baysox relievers have tallied the second-most strikeouts in the Eastern League (517).

#### **CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL**

Chesapeake has won 21 games in one-run fashion - which is tied for the most in the Eastern League and is tied for the second most in all of Double-A. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is the most in full-season MiLB. The Baysox have played 38 one-run games this season, which is tied for the second-most in all of Double-A.

#### SIZING UP THE SEAWOLVES

The Erie SeaWolves - Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers - are playoff bound for a fourth straight season after clinching the first half in the Southwest Division with a 45-24 record. Erie is seeking its third straight Eastern League title. Erie's active roster includes seven of the Tigers' top 30 prospects (MLB.com) - IF Kevin McGonigle (No. 1), OF Max Clark (No. 2), C Josue Briceno (No. 3), C Thayron Liranzo (No. 5), RHP Jaden Hamm (No. 11), LHP Andrew Sears (No. 15) and IF John Peck (No. 17).

#### **TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER**

RHP Max Alba is scheduled to make his fourth Double-A start tonight for Erie. After giving up four earned runs in each of his first two starts. Alba delivered his first scoreless start at Double-A with five shutout innings on Wednesday vs Richmond. The 26-year-old started the year in High-A West Michigan and recorded a 1.14 WHIP in 18 appearances with the Whitecaps. Alba signed as an undrafted free agent in 2022 out of Liberty and was teammates with Trey Gibson for two seasons.

- · Signed by the Orioles to a minor league contract and received an invite to major league Spring Training after spending the previous five seasons pitching overseas between the KBO (Samsung, 2022-2023) and NPB (Yakult Swallows, 2019-2021); reassigned to minor league camp on March 22 and began the season with Triple-A Norfolk; had his contract selected by the Orioles on April 17, and spent the rest of the season in the majors
- Went 9-7 with a 3.70 ERA (55 ER/133.2 IP), 130 hits (17 HR), 56 total runs, 43 walks, three hit-by-pitches, and 108 strikeouts in 32 games (24 GS)
- Had his contract selected on April 17, from Triple-A Norfolk and started against Minnesota, spinning 5.2 scoreless innings on three hits, one hit batter, and one wild pitch with four strikeouts; marked his first MLB appearance since September 26, 2017 at Arizona (w/ SF, 6 years, 204 days ago), the most amount of time between major league appearances for an Orioles pitcher since Danny Boone on September 16, 1990 (7 years, 351 days apart), per the Elias Sports Bureau

- Eight of his 23 starts on the season were scoreless, tied for the second-most such starts in MLB (min. 2.0 IP/GS) behind Seattle's Bryce Miller (9)
- Registered a 1-0 record with a 3.09 ERA (4 ER/11.2 IP) in eight relief outings this season compared to a 8-7 record with a 3.76 ERA (51 ER/122.0 IP) in 24 starts...Three of his four earned runs surrendered as a reliever came in his last appearance out of the bullpen on August 1 at Cleveland

#### **CHESAPEAKE OYSTER CATCHERS**



For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

#### **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

#### **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
