YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels split a doubleheader against the Akron RubberDucks. Richmond won Game 1, 4-1. Akron took a 1-0 lead in the third on an RBI single by Dayan Frias. In the sixth, Vaun Brown scored on a sacrifice bunt attempt by Aeverson Arteaga, who reached on a throwing error. Later in the inning, Jairo Pomares hit a three-run homer to give the Flying Squirrels a 4-1 lead. **Nick Garcia** and **Tyler Myrick** each threw two scoreless innings. Akron won Game 2, 2-1, in nine innings. **Seth Lonsway** took a no-hit bid into the sixth inning and closed his day with 5.2 scoreless innings pitched. **Sabin Ceballos** gave the Flying Squirrels a 1-0 lead in the top of the ninth with a sacrifice fly. Jorge Burgos ended the game with a two-run double in the bottom of the ninth. Trent Harris threw 1.1 scoreless innings.

TODAY'S GAME: The Flying Squirrels play the finale of a six-game road series against the Akron RubberDucks, Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians. The RubberDucks swept a three-game series at The Diamond to open the season from April 4-6. Richmond returns to Akron for a six-game series from July 8-13. The RubberDucks play one more series at The Diamond

PACKING THE HOUSE: Last year, the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A teams in average (6,595) and total (435,295) attendance. Among the 120 MiLB teams, the Flying Squirrels were 10th in average attendance. It was the third straight year the Flying Squirrels led all 30 Double-A clubs in average and total attendance, which had not been done prior to 2022. Last year's total attendance is the highest since 2013 (434,769) and the fourth-highest average in team history. April 4 marked the 15th consecutive Opening Night sellout, marking every home opener in franchise history to date. This year, the Flying Squirrels are averaging 7,347 fans per home game, which ranks second among all 120 MiLB clubs.

THE FLYING SQUIRRELS went 2-4 in last week's home series against Chesapeake after going 2-4 in the previous week's road series at Harrisburg. In the Eastern League, the Richmond offense is tied for fourth in hits (142), fifth in batting average (.225), 10th in runs (61), ninth in total bases (201), 11th in doubles (23), tied for eighth in homers (12), 11th in RBIs (52), ninth in walks (62) and first in strikeouts (144 - fewest). The Richmond pitching staff is ninth in ERA (4.27).

THE RUBBERDUCKS dropped four-of-six last week at Erie, their first series loss of the season. After sweeping Richmond to open the season from April 4-6, they won four-of-six against the Curve in their first homestand of the year from April 8-13. Akron's roster includes five of Baseball America's top-30 Guardians prospects, including 2B Travis Bazzana (No. 1), C Cooper Ingle (No. 7), 1B C.J. Kayfus (No. 8), RHP Austin Peterson (No. 24) and OF Kahlil Watson (No. 30). Bazzana is also ranked No. 23 on Baseball America's top-100 prospects list. MLB.com's top-30 Guardians prospects list features four Akron players, including Bazzana (No. 1), Ingle (No. 7), Kayfus (No. 8) and Peterson (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Left-hander **Joe Whitman** makes his second professional appearance in his hometown of Akron. He started the first game of the series on Tuesday and was hit with a loss after allowing three runs in four innings. In his first full professional season last year, Whitman split the year between Low-A San Jose and High-A Eugene, going 3-8 with a 4.63 ERA in 23 starts. He finished the year ranked ninth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (108) and tied for ninth in games started. Whitman was selected in the second round of the 2023 MLB Draft by the Giants out of Kent State, where he was the MAC Pitcher of the Year that season. Before transferring to Kent State near his hometown of Akron, Ohio, Whitman pitched at Purdue. Entering 2025, Whitman was ranked by Baseball America as the No. 10 Giants prospect and No. 7 by MLB.com. *For more on Whitman*, see page two.

FOR AKRON: Right-hander Tommy Mace makes his fourth start of the season and the eighth of his career against the Flying Squirrels. He was Akron's Opening Day starter on April 4 at The Diamond and allowed one run over five innings. On Tuesday, Mace picked up a win, allowing one run over six innings. For his career, Mace is 3-1 with a 1.37 ERA (6 ER/39.1 IP) in seven starts against Richmond dating back to 2023. He spent all of 2024 with Akron, going 8-7 with a 3.71 ERA. He finished the year ranked fifth in the Eastern League in ERA, tied for first in games started (27), fourth in innings pitched (145.2), seventh in BAA (236) and fourth in WHIP (1.22). Mace was selected by the Cleveland Guardians in the second round (69th overall) of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida.

DON'T RUN ON RICHMOND: The Flying Squirrels' catching unit of Adrián Sugastey and Zach Morgan have combined to throw out 14 stolen base attempts this season, which is first among all 30 Double-A teams and ranks tied for eighth among the 120 MiLB teams. Sugastey is tied for first in Double-A with eight runners caught stealing, which leads the EL. Morgan is second in the EL with six.

BRYCE IS BACK: Northern Virginia native Bryce Eldridge returned to the Richmond roster on Tuesday after missing the start of the season with an injury. He hit a solo home run in his first plate appearance of the year. The 20-year-old first baseman played at four levels in the Giants organization in his first full professional season last year, including nine games with Richmond in September. For the year in 116 games, Eldridge hit .291 with 23 homers and 92 RBIs. He is ranked by Baseball America as the No. 11 prospect in baseball. Eldridge is also the fifth Virginia-born player to suit up for the Flying Squirrels in franchise history.

HAMMERIN' JAIRO: In the first game of Saturday's doubleheader, **Jairo Pomares** gave the Flying Squirrels a 4-1 lead in the sixth with a three-run homer. It was his fourth homer of the year, which is tied for third-most in the Eastern League this season. Last year, Pomares led the team with 12 homers. Eight-of-his-10 RBIs this year have come on home runs.

PLAY THE HITS: The Flying Squirrels have collected 142 hits through their first 20 games this season, which is the tied for fourth-most in the Eastern League. The team is batting .225 (142-for-630), which is fifth-highest in the league. However, the Richmond offense is batting .180 (29-for-161) with runners in scoring position, which is 10th the league. In this week's series, the Flying Squirrels are batting .107 (3-for-28) with runners in scoring position, including going 1-for-17 in the second game of Saturday night's doubleheader

WHERE DID THESE GUYS COME FROM?: There are players from six different counties on the Flying Squirrels' roster, including the United States (21 players), Venezuela (2), the Dominican Republic (2), Cuba (1), Panama (1) and Puerto Rico (1). Among the 21 American-born players, 12 different states are represented, including North Carolina (3), Florida (3), Ohio (3), California (2), Michigan (2), Pennsylvania (2), Kentucky (1), Minnesota (1), North Dakota (1), Rhode Island (1), Texas (1) and Virginia. There are 12 players who joined the Giants organization out of the MLB Draft, six were signed as non-drafted free agents, five as international free agents, four who were picked up in trades and one who was claimed in the minor-league phase of the Rule 5 Draft. For 23 players, the Giants were their original affiliated organization and five have played with other major-league organizations.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: In the Eastern League, Victor Bericoto is seventh in batting average (.319), fifth in OBP (.439), first in SLG (.496) and second in OPS (1.035). **Jairo Pomares** is tied for third in homers (4) and tied for seventh in total bases (33). **Jack Choate** is sixth in strikeouts (25). **Seth Lonsway** is sixth in innings pitched (20.2) and 10th in WHIP (0.97).

PROSPECT WATCH: Richmond's roster includes seven players are ranked in Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects, including Bryce Eldridge (No. 1), Joe Whitman (No. 10), Diego Velasquez (No. 13), Sabin Ceballos (No. 16), Trent Harris (No. 26), Aeverson Arteaga (No. 27) and Jack Choate (No. 28). There are also seven players ranked in MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list, including Eldridge, (No. 1), Whitman (No. 7), Harris (No. 11), Velasquez (No. 15), Arteaga (No. 16), Ceballos (No. 23) and Choate (No. 27). Eldridge is also ranked No. 11 overall by Baseball America and No. 22 by MLB.com.

THIS DATE IN RICHMOND
BASEBALL HISTORY

1957: The Virginians beat the Montreal Royals, 8-0, at Parker Field. Jim Coates threw his second straight shutout, holding the Royals to four hits with 11 strike-outs. 1962: The Virginians beat the Buffalo Bisons, 4-1, at Parker Field. Bob Lasko made his Triple-A debut and struck out 13 batters, a modern team record at the time. It was two shy of the Virginians record of 15, which was set by Allen Russell in 1915. 1992: The R-Braves beat the Tidewater Tides, 5-4, at The Diamond. Down 4-1 in the ninth, pinch-hitter Andy Tomberlin hit a three-run homer. The next batter, Ryan Klesko, hit a walk-off homer to center. Tides manager Clint Hurdle said, "You can't play better for 8 ½ innings, but that's why Abner [Doubleday] made the games nine innings long." 2003: Former Richmond Braves pitcher Kevin Millwood threw a no-hitter as the Philadelphia Phillies beat the San Francisco Giants, 1-0, at Veterans Stadium. It was just the second no-hitter thrown at The Vet, which was in its final season. 2006: The Richmond Braves beat the Rochester Red Wings, 11-10, at The Diamond. Rochester scored five runs in the top of the ninth to take a 10-8 lead. Scott Thorman hit a two-out, three-run homer off Pat Neshek in the bottom of the ninth to win the game. 2010: The Flying Squirrels swept a doubleheader against the New Britain Rock Cats on the road. In the second game, David Mixon threw the first complete-game shutout in franchise history. 2011: The Flying Squirrels beat the New Britain Rock Cats, 5-4, in 13 innings. The Rock Cats scored two runs in the ninth to force extras and took a 4-2 lead in the top of the 13th on a two-run homer by Aaron Hicks. In the bottom of the 13th, Chris Dominguez closed the score to 4-3 with a double and Juan Perez hit a walk-off, two-run homer. 2014: The Flying Squirrels beat the Rock Cats, 5-5, after trailing 5-0 in the seventh. Ricky Oropesa capped a six-run eighth with a two-run single to match the largest comeback win in team history at the time.
