Today's Game

The Fightin Phils continue their final home series, and penultimate series, of the 2024 season against the Erie SeaWolves, Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers. It's the only meetings between the teams this season. Reading and Erie did not face off in 2023, and this is the first meeting between them since July 26-31, 2022, at Erie (Erie won series 5-1). It's the first time the SeaWolves come to FirstEnergy Stadium since May 4-9, 2021 (Erie won 4-2) to open the 2021 season.

Game 128 Recap

The Fightin Phils fell 5-1 to Erie on Thursday night to snap a two-game winning streak. Jackson Jobe dominated Reading hitters as MLB's top pitching prospect went a career-high seven innings, allowing one run on three hits, with eight strikeouts. Braeden Fausnaught started for Reading and after a rough first inning, he settled into to allow four runs on seven hits over five innings, with four strikeouts. Justin Crawford, Aidan Miller and Erick Brito all had base hits.

Piling on the Strikeouts

Fightin Phils pitching set a new season-high with 18 strikeouts in Thursday night's game against Erie. That mark surpasses their previous season-high of 16, that was last done last Saturday at Somerset. Tommy McCollum punched out a career-high six batters over two innings of work. Andrew Schultz added four as well.

A Rare Comback

Wednesday's game was not the first time in R-Phils' history that they won a game on catchers' interferance. Reading had a walk-off catchers' interference on June 20, 2007, when Jason Hill drew the interference to five Reading a 3-2 win over Binghamton. Wednesday's win was the second time this season Reading won a game when trailing entering their final at bats. The other instance was on July 14 against Akron at home.

A Duo of Honors for Tonight's Starter

After being named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week on Monday, Moises Chace was named Phillies Pitcher of the Month of August, along with former R-Phil Seth Johnson, on Thursday. Chace is coming off a career outing where he set career-bests in IP (6) and strikeouts (13). His 13 strikeouts are the most by a Reading pitcher this season, with the previous high being 11, done three times. In total, Chace retired 18-of-19 hitters and the final 16 he faced. 13 of his 18 outs were via a strikeout (72%). He collected 19 swing and missed on the night, with 13 of those coming against his fastball.

It's Miller Time

The Philadelphia Phillies announced on Tuesday that No. 1 prospect (according to MLB Pipeline) Aidan Miller was promoted to Reading from High-A Jersey Shore. Miller was the Phillies first round draft pick in the 2023 draft. He began the season with Single-A Clearwater and after a strong start with the Threshers, Miller was promoted to Jersey Shore on June 11. Miller was named South Atlantic League Player of the Month on Thursday after his strong August.

Crawford Cruising

Justin Crawford turned in another stellar performance on Wednesday night. The Phillies No. 3 Prospect had two hits, one run and a stolen base. Crawford now owns 14-multi hit games over his 33 appearances on the season, meaning he has two-plus hits in a game 42% of the time. He also leads the team with six three-hit games sine joining Reading on July 19.

Home Cooking

Following Wednesday night's win, the Fightin Phils are 35-31 at FirstEnergy Stadium this season. After Wednesday night, Reading clinched a winning record at home for the first time since going 36-33 in 2022. This comes after the R-Phils posted a 23-44 record at home last season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

September 6, 2023: At Reading, Phillies No. 2 Prospect Mick Abel tossed six-shutout innings and allows just one hit with seven strikeouts as Reading wins 3-2 over Portland. Marcus Lee Sang hit a two-run homer, but Abel did not factor in the decision as Portland tied the game in the seventh. Ethan Wilson hit a goahead double in the eighth to score Oliver Dunn and Tristan Garnett got the save and Dominic Pipkin the win.

Sup SeaWolves

Erie enters tonight with a 33-26 record in the second half, which is second-best in the Southwest division. They went 38-29 in the first half and won the division. The SeaWolves will play Akron in the Southwest division finals in two weeks. Their roster has four players on the Tigers' top-30 prosepcts list, according to MLB Pipeline: Jackson Jobe (2), Hao-Yu Lee (8), Troy Melton (12) and Eric Silva (29).

On the Mound for Erie

Righty Wilkel Hernandez makes the start tonight for Erie. This season, Hernandez is 4-7, with a 4.57 ERA over 26 games and 25 starts (108.1 IP, 109 H, 52 BB, 100 SO). Hernandez last piched on Aug. 31 against Richmond, taking the loss as he allowed five-earned runs on five hits over 1.2 innings pitched. Hernandez spent all of 2023 with High-A West Michigan, going 3-8, with a 3.65 ERA over 26 games/20 starts. The 25-year old signed with the Los Angeles Angels in 2015 as an International Free Agent. He was traded to the Tigers in 2017, with Troy Montgomery, for Ian Kinsler.
