Good Morning

This morning, the Reading Fightin Phils begin a six-game series at home against the Harrisburg Senators. It is the first of 12 matchups between the teams this season; one series in Reading and another series in Harrisburg from Aug. 22-27. In 2022, the Fightin Phils went 4-8 against the Senators, including dropping five-of-six games at home in April and split the six-game series in Harrisburg in August.

Looking Back at the Jersey Trip

While it wasn't a trip to the shore, it was a quite beachy weekend for the R-Phils at Somerset. After taking just one-of-four to start the series, Reading responded with back-to-back wins to end the series. A 6-5 win Saturday and 3-1 win Sunday. The bullpen was sharp in both wins, while Oliver Dunn, Madison Stokes, Matthew Kroon and Nick Podkul all turned in impressive series against the Patriots.

Shutout Streak

Through 38 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-three teams in double-A and one-of-14 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Altoona joined Reading as the other Eastern League team to not be shuout as of Friday, but proceeded to get no hit by Bowie. Reading pitching has also not thrown a shutout so far this season.

Gettin' On Base

Oliver Dunn's team/season-high on-base streak of 14 games came to an end Sunday, when he went 0-4 at Somerset. But, Nick Podkul reached base again for the 11th-straight game. Cam Cannon and Carlos De La Cruz both each own nine-game on-base streaks as well.

A Look at the Bullpen

There may be no more hot and cold group this season than the Reading bullpen. The last two games have been perhaps their best of the season. Over that span, the bullpen has combined to allow zero runs over nine innings pitched, picking up nine strikeouts. In wins, the bullpen has been flat-out dominant, posting a 2.39 ERA over the Fightin Phils' 15 wins. But, in losses, it has been the complete opposite. In Reading's 23 defeats this season, the bullpen has posted a 7.05 ERA. A drastic 4.66 earned-run difference between wins and losses.

Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies opened a series with the Arizona Diamondbacks with a 6-3 loss. Lehigh Valley returns home to begin a six-game series against Buffalo this morning. The Iron Pigs took just two-of-six games at Worcester last week. Jersey Shore opens up at Aberdeen after a 3-3 week at home against Wilmington. Clearwater is at St. Lucie after a 5-1 week against Bradenton to improve to a league-best 29-10 on the season.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 23, 2007: At Manchester, Jason Hill's solo home run in the 10th inning lifts the R-Phils to a 2-1 win over New Hampshire. Mike Zagurski goes 2.0 innings in relief, giving up one hit and fanning three in his final appearance before being called up to Philadelphia.

Coming from the Capital

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Harrisburg, The Senators sit tied for third in the Eastern League Southwest standings at 19-19 on the season. Last week, the Senators split a six-game series at home against Erie, winning the last two games like the R-Phils. Next week, Harrisburg stays on the road for a six-game series at Bowie.

Senators Southpaw

For just the fourth time this season, Reading faces a lefty starter in Alex Troop. He is making his eighth start and is 2-3 with a 4.73 ERA. Over 32.1 innings, Troop has allowed 27 hits, issued 16 walks and picked up 29 strikeouts. Wednesday vs Erie, he went five, allowing three runs on three hits with four walks and four strikeouts. He spent most of 2022 with Harrisburg, with one game at Rochester, going 8-5 with a 3.35 ERA over 28 games
