Today: The Lansing Lugnuts, the High-A affiliate of the A's, play the fourth in a six-game series with the Great Lakes Loons, the High-A affiliate of the Los Angeles Dodgers. The Lugnuts are now 8-10 vs. the Loons in their 18-game season series after losing two of the first three games in this series including a shutout last night.

Yesterday: Loons 5, Lugnuts 0. Great Lakes starter **Maddux Bruns** combined with three relievers on a four-hit whitewashing and **Dylan Campbell** went 3-for-4 with an RBI single plus a pair of singles, a pair of steals, and a pair of runs scored to lead the Loons to victory in a brisk two hours and five minutes. In the loss, Lansing starter **Kade Morris** fired seven innings for the second straight start, allowing four runs on seven hits and two walks while striking out four.

LUG NOTES

Adam Jaksa's Favorite Player: In his first Double-A start, **Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang** fired five scoreless innings for the Midland RockHounds last night, limiting Frisco to three hits and a walk while striking out three in an 8-5 victory. Zhuang has now tossed nine scoreless innings allowing only four hits in two appearances in Double-A.

Canada's Favourite Player: A 17-year-old when he first donned the Lugnuts uniform in 2016, **Vladimir Guerrero, Jr.** is the hottest hitter in baseball right now, drilling a two-run homer, an RBI triple and an RBI double with his father in attendance at last night's 7-6 Blue Jays victory over the Orioles, thus extending his hitting streak to 20 games. Over those 20 games, Vladdy has more home runs (10) and walks (11) than strikeouts (7); he also joined such luminaries as Rogers Hornsby, Jimmie Foxx, Lou Gehrig, Frank Thomas, Larry Walker, Richard Hidalgo and Chipper Jones as the only Major Leaguers to hit at least .500 with at least 10 home runs in a 20-game span.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the MWL in at-bats (3,489), base hits (867) and triples (35); tied for 1st in doubles (171); 2nd in batting average (.248), runs (517), total bases (1,318) and OPS (.717); and 3rd in slugging percentage (.378) and on-base percentage (.339).

RISPy Business: Lansing is 3-for-30 with runners in scoring position in this series, including 0-for-10 yesterday; the squad is slashing just .206/.331/.272 with a .603 team OPS in August, averaging 3.7 runs/game.

Prospecting: The Nuts have six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher **Luis Morales** (No. 2), outfielder **Ryan Lasko** (No. 16), pitcher **Kade Morris** (No. 20), infielder **Will Simpson** (No. 26), pitcher **Will Johnston** (No. 27) and outfielder **Jared Dickey** (No. 28).

The Future is Here: Lugnuts right-hander **Luis Morales**, tomorrow's starting pitcher, is the A's No. 1 pitching prospect. Morales tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2009: Tony Brown hit a grand slam in a seven-run 3rd inning, helping the Dayton Dragons turn a 4-1 deficit into an 8-4 lead. The Lugnuts narrowed the deficit to 8-7 with three runs in the home 3rd, and then narrowed a 10-7 deficit to 10-9 with solo tallies in the 7th and the 9th, but with the tying run at third base and the winning run at first base, pinch-hitter Jon Talley lined out and Chris Emanuele struck out looking to end a thrilling 10-9 loss at Oldsmobile Park. Each team collected 15 hits in the slugfest.

2013: The Lugnuts blew a 5-0 lead at home, with West Michigan scoring two in the 8th and three in the 9th, but DH Kevin Patterson's two-run homer in the 12th inning gave the Nuts a walkoff win, 7-5, in four hours and seven minutes before 11,166 at Cooley Law School Stadium. It was Patterson's 18th home run of the year.

2015: For the second straight day, the Beloit Snappers' Joe Bennie led off the game with a home run. This time it led to a Beloit victory, 9-4 at Lansing, avoiding a three-game sweep. In the loss, reliever Tim Mayza struck out six batters in 2 2/3 innings.

In a Nutshell: Excelled in his Lugnuts debut on May 2 vs. South Bend, becoming the club's 11th different starting pitcher this year and the 939th all-time player to put on the Lansing uniform... replaced the demoted Eduardo Rivera and tossed five scoreless two-hit innings, striking out six Cubs... followed up with eight strikeouts in three hitless innings with his mother in attendance at Great Lakes, May 8... grew up idolizing Max Scherzer... enjoys the great outdoors... notable splits:

Prospecting: Rated the A's No. 27 prospect and No. 12 pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline... grades: fastball 50, slider 45, change-up 55, control 50, overall 40... they write, "With low expectations, Johnston began his first full season of pro ball at age 23 with Single-A Stockton, but he threw so well out of the gate he earned a quick promotion up to High-A Lansing at the end of April... Johnston has shown a better feel for his three-pitch arsenal than some expected given his college numbers. He adds and subtracts from his fastball, throwing it typically in the 89-94 mph range, though he's shown in the past the ability to reach back for a 95 or 96-mph heater on occasion. The pitch has played up a bit because he can pitch north and south with it. His best pitch is now his split-changeup, which flashes plus and can be a true out pitch at times. His low-80s breaking ball can be on the slurve side, but it can be effective."
