RIDERS SCORE SEVEN RUNS IN EIGHTH TO COME FROM BEHIND IN WIN:

The Frisco RoughRiders erased a two-run deficit in the bottom of the eighth ining with a seven-run outburst, claiming a 12-7 win over the Northwest Arkansas Naturals on Friday night from Riders Field. Frisco (33-33, 71-63) took the lead for good in the eighth when Elih Marrero doubled to right field for his third hit of the night. Two runs came home to give Frisco an 8-7 advantage. Frainyer Chavez drew an RBI walk and Ian Moller added a pinch hit two-RBI double later in the inning. The Riders jumped ahead in the first inning when Keith Jones II launched a grand slam to left field. The Riders had loaded the bases on singles by Chavez, Sebastian Walcott, and Luis Mieses. Northwest Arkansas (33-34, 66-70) used a six-run inning in the third to take a 6-4 lead, which they held on to until the bottom of the eighth. Brett Squires doubled for the go-ahead two-RBI hit. Avery Weems (4-1) allowed one uncarned the indicate of the single of the size of the Naturals Caden. run in two innings of relief for Frisco to collect the win, and Emiliano Teodo struck out the side in the ninth. For the Naturals, Caden Monke (3-7) was charged with all seven runs in the eighth inning while recording one out, giving him the loss. **Danny Coulombe** made a rehab appearance for the Riders, pitching a 1-2-3 inning in the fifth with one strikeout. The Riders also used scoreless innings of relief from **Jackson Kelley** and **Bryan Magdaleno**.

FRAINYER ON FIRE:

Frainyer Chavez has been swinging a hot bat for the RoughRiders. Over his last 31 games (since August 7th), he is hitting .373 (44-for-118)/.476/.475/.951 with six doubles, two home runs, 14 RBIs, 24 runs, 23 walks and 21 strikeouts. On an 11-game hitting streak, he is batting .409 (18-for-44) with a 1.059 OPS. On Wednesday, he was named Texas Rangers Minor League Hitter of the Month, batting .337/.462/.407/.869 over the month with 19 walks to 17 strikeouts over his 24 games.

DAVALILLO WINS TEXAS LEAGUE PITCHER OF THE MONTH:

Frisco RoughRiders starting pitcher **David Davalillo** was named July Texas League Pitcher of the Month, Minor League Baseball announced on Thursday. The No. 7 prospect in the Rangers organization made five starts over the month, going 1-1 with a 1.82 ERA. Over his 24.2 innings, he struck out 23 while walking eight and surrendering only 17 hits. Opponents hit .191 against him and he totaled a 1.01 WHIP. The highlight of his month came against Midland on August 14th when he poured in 7.0 shutout innings, striking out one batter and ceding only three hits in a 4-1 Frisco win.

CAULEY'S HISTORIC NIGHT LEADS TO PLAYER OF THE WEEK AWARD:
The RoughRiders witnessed an incredible night from Cam Cauley against the Hooks on August 19th, when he tied a franchise record with three home runs. He tied his career-best with four RBIs as well. It was the fifth time in franchise history that a RoughRiders player has hit three home runs in a game and the fifth time in Double-A this season that a player hit three home runs in a game. He followed it up with another home run on the 21st, giving him four home runs in the first two games of the series. In three games, he is 7-for-11 and has increased his season OPS from .696 to .742.

ROTATION ROTATING:

With the RoughRiders' promotions of Trey Supak and Ben Anderson and the trade of Mitch Bratt, Frisco only has one remaining starter from the opening rotation of the year (Winston Santos).

THE BOYS ARE PICKIN' IT:

The RoughRiders have been fantastic on defense this season, owning the best fielding percentage (.982) in the Texas League while committing the fewest errors (83). After committing 20 errors in the first month of the season, Frisco owns a .984 fielding percentage since May 1st, which is the third-best in Double-A.

WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on July 18th, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

WALLY'S WORLD:

Rangers top prospect **Sebastian Walcott** has been incredible for a 19-year-old in Double-A. This season, his walk rate of 12.4 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 20.5 percent, a career low. By stealing his 30th base on September 4th, he joined an exclusive group as one of the only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A, joining **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott became the first Texas League teenager to have double-digit homers and 30-plus steals since Roberto Alomar in 1987 (12 HR, 43 SB with Wichita). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defensively. Walcott collected a walk-off single on Tuesday.
