**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels beat the Rumble Ponies, 5-2. **Seth Lonsway** started and pitched five scoreless innings, striking out six. **Mat Olsen** closed out his third save of the season. Richmond scored three runs in the first to take a 3-0 lead. After a leadoff double by **Wade Meckler**, **Carter Howell** hit an RBI single and later scored on an error. **Brandon Martorano** added a sacrifice fly to cap the frame. In the fourth, **Diego Velasquez** hit a solo homer for his first Double-A hit and opened a 4-0 lead. Binghamton scored its two runs with a pair of RBI singles by Jeremiah Jackson, one in the sixth and a second in the eighth to cut the lead to 4-2. In the bottom of the eighth, Velasquez picked up his third hit with an RBI single to extend the lead to 5-2.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels face the Binghamton Rumble Ponies, Double-A affiliate of the New York Mets, in the fifth of a six-game series at The Diamond. This is the only series between the two teams this season. This week marks the Rumble Ponies' first trip to Richmond since August 17-21, 2022, which was a series split. The Flying Squirrels played six games in Binghamton last May and went 1-5. The Flying Squirrels have gone 17-14 against teams from the Northeast Division this season and Binghamton is 16-20 against teams from the Southwest Division on the year.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have gone 3-7 in their last 10 games dating back to July 13 after winning their previous four games. For the year, the Flying Squirrels are hitting .228 and averaging 3.78 runs per game (185 runs/49 games) at home compared to a .235 batting average and 4.71 runs per game on the road (212 runs/45 games). The Flying Squirrels are 11-5 in their last 16 road games since June 12. Richmond is 7-16 in its last 23 home games dating back to June 6.

**THE RUMBLE PONIES** had won 10 straight games prior to going 2-4 in their last six games. After finishing tied for second in the Northeast Division in the first half, the Rumble Ponies are currently tied for second place in the division in the second half. Binghamton's roster includes seven of Baseball America's top-30 Mets prospects, including RHP Brandon Sproat (No. 6), RHP Nolan McLean (No. 7), OF Ryan Clifford (No. 8), C Kevin Parada (No. 16), OF Alex Ramirez (No. 20), RHP Tyler Stuart (No. 22) and INF Rowley Jordan (No. 30). There are five Binghamton players on MLB.com's top-30 Mets prospects list, including Clifford (No. 3), Sproat (No. 5), Parada (No. 9), Ramirez (No. 15), Stuart (No. 17) and McLean (No. 18).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Left-hander **Nick Swiney** makes his second start of the season. He pitched out of the bullpen on Wednesday against the Rumble Ponies and struck out the only batter he faced. In four outings in July, Swiney has a 1.80 ERA (1 ER/5.0 IP). He has pitched three consecutive scoreless outings spanning 3.2 innings. He has made one other Double-A start in his career, which came back on May 16 this year against Reading when he allowed one run in two innings in the second game of a doubleheader. He began the 2023 season with the Flying Squirrels, going 3-0 with a 1.15 ERA in six appearances before being promoted to Triple-A Sacramento in mid-May for the remainder of the season. Swiney was selected in the second round (67th overall) of the 2020 MLB Draft out of NC State, where he was teammates with current Flying Squirrels infielder **Will Wilson** and former Richmond catcher **Patrick Bailey**, now with the Giants in the majors. **For more on Swiney, see page two.**

**FOR BINGHAMTON:** Right-hander Brandon Sproat makes his 10th Double-A start. He last pitched on Sunday against the Sea Wolves and allowed three runs over four innings, striking out six. He had won each of his previous three starts from June 20-July 4. Sproat was selected in the second round (56th overall) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Florida and did not pitch last year. He began his professional career this season with High-A Brooklyn and went 2-1 with a 1.07 ERA (3 ER/25.1 IP) in his six outings (five starts). He was promoted to Double-A Binghamton on May 13. He was selected to pitch in the Futures Game earlier this month in Arlington, Texas and threw a scoreless third inning, retiring Cole Young (Mariners), Sebastian Walcott (Rangers) and Samuel Basallo (Orioles) in order. Sproat is rated by Baseball America as the No. 6 Mets prospect and No. 5 by MLB.com. He was selected in the seventh round of the 2019 MLB Draft out of high school by the Rangers and the third round of the 2022 Draft by the Mets before signing following last year's draft after being taken by the Mets a second time.

**GO, DIEGO, GO!:** On Friday in his second Double-A game, **Diego Velasquez** hit a solo home run in the fourth inning for his first Double-A hit. He finished the night with three hits, adding an RBI single in the eighth inning. In his debut on Thursday, he walked twice and added a sacrifice bunt. Between Richmond and High-A Eugene this year, Velasquez has hit .280, which is fourth-best in the Giants organization. He is also ranked fourth in hits (77), fourth in stolen bases (18), sixth in OPS (.769), tied for sixth in doubles (16), tied for sixth in triples (3), seventh in OBP (.365), eighth in SLG (.404) and tied for ninth in total bases (111). With his debut on Thursday, Velasquez became the sixth-youngest player in Flying Squirrels history, the ninth player to debut for Richmond at age 20 or younger and the first player in team history born in 2003.

**BERICOTO BASHING:** In his last 36 games dating back to June 6, **Victor Bericoto** is hitting .320 (47-for-147) with three homers, eight doubles, eight walks and 18 RBIs. After leading the Giants organization in homers (27) last year, Bericoto hit just one homer in his first 34 games this season through May 21. From May 22-28, he homered three times in five games. He went deep again on June 14 at New Hampshire and added a homer on June 18 at Portland, but he has not homered in his last 26 games. In his last 46 games since May 22, Bericoto is batting .307 (55-for-179) with six homers, nine doubles, 14 walks and 27 RBIs. Bericoto has picked up multiple hits in 13-of-28 games dating back to June 15 and is batting .321 (36-for-112) in that stretch.

**RETURN OF THE MECK:** In his six games with Richmond this year, **Wade Meckler** has picked up nine hits, batting .375 (9-for-24). He first reached the Flying Squirrels last season and batted .336 (50-for-149) over 39 games, which as the third-highest average in the league (min. 170 PA) for the year. He hit .371 (115-for-310) in the minors last year, which was the highest in MiLB (min. 350 PA). It was the second straight year that a Flying Squirrels player led the minors in batting average, with **Vaun Brown** topping the charts (min. 350 PA) with a .346 average in 2022.

**SCORELESS WORK FROM SILVA:** Reliever **Eric Silva** has thrown nine consecutive appearances dating back to June 19 without allowing a run, spanning 12.2 innings. It is the longest active streak of scoreless games pitched in the Eastern League. He has 18 strikeouts in that time frame. That span has lowered his season ERA from 6.41 to 4.35. Since throwing an immaculate inning on June 9 against the Curve, Silva has gone 3-0 with a 1.10 ERA (2 ER/16.1 IP) with 23 strikeouts and four walks. Earlier this season, Silva threw six consecutive scoreless outings from May 1-21, spanning 9.2 innings with 10 strikeouts. Over his next six outings prior to his current scoreless streak, he posted a 10.38 ERA (10 ER/8.2 IP) from May 26-June 14.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** The Flying Squirrels drew an average of 7,113 fans in April for their home games at The Diamond to open the season, their highest April average in franchise history. The previous high was 6,891 in 2014 followed by 6,571 in 2019. This season, the Flying Squirrels are leading all 30 Double-A teams and are ranked eighth among the 120 minor league clubs in average home attendance (6,642), just shy of the highest average attendance in franchise history (6,689 in 2013).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** Four of Baseball America's top-30 Giants prospects are on the Richmond roster, including OF **Wade Meckler** (No. 12), RHP **Trevor McDonald** (No. 17), RHP **Eric Silva** (No. 21) and SS **Diego Velasquez** (No. 26). On Baseball America's Best Tools list, Meckler is rated the best hitter for average and best strike-zone discipline and LHP **John Michael Bertrand** is rated as having the best control. MLB.com's top-30 Giants prospects list features five Richmond players, including McDonald (No. 12), Meckler (No. 16), Velasquez (No. 18), OF/1B **Victor Bericoto** (No. 19) and OF **Jairo Pomares** (No. 26).

**BOULEVARD TO THE BAY:** This season, 10 former Flying Squirrels players have reached the majors for the first time. That is tied for the second-most in a season in franchise history. Last year also saw 10 former Flying Squirrels players debut in the big leagues, including a team-record five from that season's Richmond roster. In 2014, a team-record 11 alumni made their MLB debuts, including **Joe Panik**, **Adam Duvall**, **Andrew Susac**, **Matt Duffy**, **Jackson Williams**, **Edwin Escobar**, **Hunter Strickland**, **Chris Dominguez**, **Gary Brown**, **Brett Bochy** and **Chris Heston**. The Flying Squirrels alumni to debut in the majors this season are **Erik Miller** (2023 Flying Squirrels), **Landen Roupp** (2022-23), **Kai-Wei Teng** (2022-23), **Nick Avila** (2022), **Randy Rodriguez** (2022-23), **Mason Black** (2023), **Gerson Garabito** (2021), **Spencer Bivens** (2023), **Raymond Burgos** (2023) and **Hayden Birdsong** (2023-24). Dating back to 2022, 20-of-the-last-21 Flying Squirrels alumni who have reached the majors have debuted with the San Francisco Giants, with Garabito (Rangers) being the only exception.
