### GAME INFORMATION

EASTERN LEAGUE AWARDS: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies swept the Eastern League Weekly awards for the second-straight week, with RHP Jonah Tong (EL Pitcher of the Week) and OF Nick Morabito (EL Player of the Week) taking the honors from May 12-18. Tong has won the award in back-to-back weeks and 1B/OF Ryan Clifford won EL Player of the Week prior to Morabito. Tong (W, 6.0 IP, 2 H, 0 R, 2 BB, 8 K, 94 pitches) was dominant against Hartford on Saturday, in his first start since tossing 6.2 perfect innings with 13 strikeouts in a combined perfect game against Reading. It marked Tong's third time winning EL Pitcher of the Week in his career. Morabito had his best series of the season in Hartford last week (7 G, .462 AVG, 12-for-26, 1.248 OPS, HR, 3 RBI, 6 R, 5 XBH, 6 SB) and won EL Player of the Week for the first time.

LAST GAME: The Binghamton Rumble Ponies defeated the Hartford Yard Goats, 5-4, in the series finale at Dunkin' Park on Sunday. Binghamton won the seven-game series, 4-3, and moved into sole possession of first place in the Northeast Division. LHP Zach Thornton (W, 5 IP, 4 H, 2 R, 2 ER, 0 BB, 6 K) earned his first Double-A win in his second start of the series. RHP TJ Shook recorded his second save. Binghamton hit a season-high seven doubles and was led by three-hit efforts from both Nick Morabito and Jett Williams. Binghamton has 20 runs on 40 hits over its last 3 G.

MURE MURABITU: OF Nick Morabito, the Mets No. 17 prospect (MLB Pipeline), was named the Eastern League Player of the Week for his strong series in Hartford last week (7 G, .462 AVG, 12-for-26, 1.248 OPS, HR, 3 RBI, 6 R, 5 XBH, 6 SB). Morabito finished the series with back-to-back three-hit games and three-straight multi-hit games. Morabito is riding a 9-game hitting streak, hitting .424 (14-for-33) with a 1.139 OPS, HR, 4 RBI, 8 R, 5 2B, 6 XBH, and 7 SB in that span. In 15 games in May, Morabito is hitting .309 (17-for-55) with an .832 OPS, 1 HR, 5 RBI, 12 R, 6 XBH, and 7 SB. Morabito currently ranks among the EL with 25 R (T-3rd), 14 SB (T-3rd), and 10 2B. The 22-year-old is in his first AA season and was the 2024 Mets MiLB POY.

CLEARED FOR TAKEOFF: INF Jett Williams, the Mets No. 1 prospect and MLB's No. 51 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline), went 3-for-5 with an RBI double and two runs on Sunday at Hartford, which marked his second three-hit game. Williams has reached base in 30 of his 33 games and has recorded a hit in 26 of his 33 game this season. The 2022 first-round pick had a strong series at Hartford last week (7 G, .320 AVG, 8-for-25, 2 HR, 5 RBI, 5 R, 2 2B, 6 BB, 1 SB). Williams is riding a sixgame hit streak and nine-game on-base streak. Since April 15 at Reading, Williams has reached base in 25 of 26 games. The 21-year-old ranks among the EL with a .385 OBP (5th), .898 OPS (8th), .513 SLG (10th), 10 2B (T-4th), and 16 XBH (T-4th most), 21 R (T-9th) & a .291 AVG (11th).

CLIFFORD CRUSH: 1B/OF Ryan Clifford, the Mets No. 4 prospect (MLB Pipeline), has recorded three-straight multi-hit games and over his three-game hit streak, Clifford is hitting .600 (6-for-10) with an 1.184 OPS, HR, 6 RBI, 4 R, 2 2B, and 4 BB. His BAbip over the last three games is .833. In 16 games in May, Clifford is hitting .309 with a .969 OPS, 4 HR, 16 RBI, 9 R, 7 XBH, and 7 BB. In May, Clifford is tied for the Eastern League-lead with 16 RBI. Clifford is tied for the third-most HR (7) and fourth-most RBI (25) in the EL this season. The 21-year-old was the EL Player of the Week last homestand (May 7-11 vs. Reading - .474 AVG, 3 HR, 9 RBI).

JACK ATTACK: RHP Jack Wenninger, the Mets No. 28 prospect (MLB Pipeline), is slated to make his eighth start of the season tonight. Wenninger is 4-2 with a 3.19 ERA through seven starts and is coming off the first complete game of his professional career on Wednesday at Hartford (L, 6.0 IP, 3 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 0 BB, 6 K, 84 pitches, 63 strikes). Wenninger ranks among the Eastern League with 4 W (T-2nd most), 0.98 WHIP (5th), 43 SO (T-6th), .207 BAA (9th), 36.2 IP (10th), and 3.19 ERA (13th). Wenninger's 0.98 WHIP ranks 7th in Double-A. The 23-year-old has gone 5+ innings in six of his seven starts (4.2 IP in the other) and 6 innings in each of his last two starts.

## MANAGER

-Reid Brignac is now the second-longest tenured manager in Binghamton history, behind Pedro Lopez (2012-16).
-In 2024, Brignac led a Rumble Ponies team that at one point won 10-conesecutive games, which marked the franchise's longest winning streak since 2006. Brignac also oversaw Eastern League Pitcher of the Year and Mets Minor League Pitcher of the Year Brandon Sproat's dominant stint at Double-A. Brignac helped the Mets' MLB staff after the MiLB season.
-In 2023, Brignac led Binghamton to the postseason for the first time since 2017, going 39-27 in the second-half and 17-5

in the final 22 games. Binghamton swept the Somerset Patriots in the Eastern League Division Series to advance to the Eastern League Championship Series for the first time since 2014, before falling to the Erie SeaWolves.

-In 2022, he led a team that saw five players make their major league debut with the Mets after starting the season with the Rumble Ponies, tying a franchise record (Francisco Álvarez, Brett Baty, José Butto, Nate Fisher, Bryce Montes de Oca).
-Brignac enjoyed a long and successful playing career, spending parts of nine years in the major leagues with the Tampa Bay Rays, Colorado Rockies, Atlanta Braves, Philadelphia Phillies, New York Yankees, and Miami Marlins. He was initially drafted by the Rays in the second round of the 2004 MLB Draft, out of St. Amant High School in Louisiana.
