TODAY'S HEADLINES

LAST GAME'S RESULT - The St. Paul Saints were on the other side of a 13-3 score on Wednesday afternoon against the Iowa Cubs. A day after beating the Cubs 13-3, the Saints gave up nine runs over the first two innings which was too much to overcome. Tim Beckham, playing in his first game with the Saints, went 2-3 with an RBI. Jake Cave continued his hot hitting going 2-5 with a home run, RBI, and a run scored. Jake Petrick returned from the COVID-19 list and tossed 2.0 hitless, scoreless innings of relief.

MIRROR IMAGE: The St. Paul Saints defeated the Iowa Cubs 13-3 on Tuesday, May 31. In the next game on Wednesday, June 1, the Saints lost by the identical score of 13-3. It was the first time since August 5 & 6 that the Saints played back-to-back games where the score was reversed. The Saints lost 1-0 to the Louisville Bats at CHS Field on August 5 and then came back on August 6 to win 1-0.

GOOD RIDDANCE, MAY: The St. Paul Saints closed May on a strong note, winning five of their final six, but finished 9-17 tied for the 2nd fewest wins in Triple-A. It wasn't enough, however, to overcome a good portion of the month. Here is how they stacked up in the International League in some important categories: AVG (.254, 7th), Runs (149, 1st), Home Runs (29, 18th), OBP (.340, 7th), and Slugging (.404, 13th), ERA (5.83, 19th), Home Runs Allowed (31, 16th), K's (240, 7th), Fielding% (.965, 19th).

CAVE DWELLINGS: Jake Cave is now one game shy of the longest hitting streak by a Saints player in franchise history. With his two hits on Wednesday he has now hit safely in 13 straight games. Over that time he is hitting .333 (20-60) with two doubles, triple, five home runs, and 17 RBI.

MUSCLE BEACH: The St. Paul Saints hit another home run on Wednesday and have now homered in seven straight games. During the seven-game stretch they have hit 11 long balls. The seven-game homer streak is the longest of the season and tied for the fourth longest in franchise history. The longest such streak is 15, from July 13-29, 2021.

RUN AT YOUR OWN RISK: The St. Paul Saints catchers have a done superb job cutting down would be base stealers. They have thrown out 18 runners trying to steal, tied for the fourth best in Triple-A, only behind the 20 of the Nashville Sounds, and 19 of the Buffalo Bisons and El Paso Chihuahuas. Overall, they have cut down 18-of-65 base stealers, a 27.7% clip.

FINALLY, A CLEAN SHEET: After 18 consecutive games with an error, the Saints finally played mistake free baseball on May 29. The St. Paul Saints were fourth in fielding percentage in all of Triple-A over the first month of the season with a .987 fielding percentage and had committed just 13 errors in 28 games, fourth fewest errors in Triple-A. Over the next three weeks the Saints committed an error in a franchise record 18 consecutive games, surpassing the five straight from August 26-September 1, 2021. They committed 30 errors in those 18 games, a .954 fielding percentage, the worst in Triple-A during that time. The next closest during that timeframe was Indianapolis at .961.

IMPRESSIVE ERRORLESS STREAK ENDS: July 1, 2018. That was the last time Mark Contreras committed an error. That streak ended with two outs in the 1st inning on Thursday, May 19. The throwing error by Contreras was his first error in 343 games, a total of 1985.1 innings played since his last error when he was at High-A Fort Myers.

WAS THAT A BUNT?: It took until game 105 last season before the Saints laid down a sacrifice bunt. On May 11, the Saints laid down their first of the season when David Bañuelos dropped one down in game 30 of the season. They surpassed their entire total from a year ago when Cole Sturgeon put down a sacrifice bunt just nine days later on May 20.

TWINS UPDATE - The Minnesota Twins were blanked for the second straight game losing 5-0 to the Detroit Tigers on Wednesday night at Comerica Park. Jorge Polanco and Gio Urshela collected the only two hits for the Twins. Trevor Megill tossed 2.0 perfect innings of relief and struck out three.

LAST APPEARANCE: 5/26 vs. IND...tossed 6.0 innings allowing one run on four hits while walking four and striking out five...received the win in an 8-1 Saints victory.

APPEARANCE PRIOR: 5/20 @ OMA...pitched 3.0 innings allowing five runs (four earned) on five hits while walking two and striking out one...did not receive a decision in an 8-7 Storm Chasers victory.

AND ON THE SECOND DAY, SANCHEZ RESTED: Sanchez has 183 professional appearances of which he has started 64 times. He has thrown 118 times out of the bullpen and has never once pitched on back-to-back days.

THAT'S ROCHESTER, NY NOT MINNESOTA: Last season, Sanchez pitched in two games for the Rochester Red Wings, the former Minnesota Twins Triple-A affiliate. Of course, Sanchez was with the Washington Nationals organization in 2021. He becomes the first Saints player to play for Rochester that wasn't already in the Twins system (there were plenty of players in 2021 that made the move over to the new affiliate).

PLAYER TO BE NAMED LATER: On December 12, 2016 Sanchez was sent from the Washington Nationals to the Philadelphia Phillies organization. He was the ever popular "Player to be Named Later" that completed an earlier trade between the two teams that sent RHP Jimmy Cordero to the Phillies. Cordero reached the Majors with the Nationals in 2018 and went 1-2 with a 5.68 ERA in 22 relief appearances.

MOWING 'EM DOWN: Sanchez' strikeout numbers aren't necessarily eye-popping, with a career 7.6 strikeouts per nine innings. But in 2016 while with High-A Potomac, he struck out at least one hitter in 20 consecutive relief appearances from June 2-September 9.

SUNDAY FUNDAY: If you were looking for the hammer during a series in 2021, Mario Sanchez was your man. He pitched in three Sunday games last season and allowed just one run across 14.0 innings while giving up just eight hits while walking three and striking out 15.

ALMOST ALWAYS A WINNER: Since coming over to The States in 2014, Sanchez has had a winning record in each full season with the exception of 2021 (2018 he was coming off Tommy John surgery and went 0-1 during his rehab stint). Across 107 appearances from 2015-17, 2019, he has only been under .500 during a season on 7 occasions (May 4-29, 2015)
