LAST TIME OUT...

MOOSIC, Pa. (August 14, 2021) – In a thrilling 10-inning contest, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders walked off with a 6-5 win over the Lehigh Valley IronPigs on Saturday night at PNC Field. The RailRiders are now 5-6 in extra-inning games this season.

With the bases loaded and no outs in the bottom of the 10th, Lehigh Valley's Cam Bedrosian uncorked a wild pitch with Ryan LaMarre at the plate to score Greg Allen with the winning run.

The RailRiders took the lead in the bottom of the first after Lehigh Valley opener Austin Ross walked the first two batters of the game, and an error by second baseman Sal Gozzo allowed Greg Allen to score. In the bottom of the second, Kyle Holder doubled and scored on a Julian Garcia wild pitch to extend the lead to 2-0. In the top of the fourth Lehigh Valley took the lead on a three-run home run by T.J. Rivera off J.P. Sears. The left-hander allowed three runs on six hits in 3.2 innings of work, walking two and striking out four.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre regained the lead in the bottom of the fifth when Chris Gittens lined a three-run home run to right-center off Braden Zarbinsky. The blast was the eighth of the year for Gittens in 25 games with the RailRiders, with six of them coming against the IronPigs. It was the first game Gittens played with SWB since July 15. Lehigh Valley added a run in the top of the seventh against Kevin Gadea to close the gap to 5-4, and tied the game in the eighth on a solo home run from Matt Vierling off Nick Green.

The game remained tied into the bottom of the 10th as Greg Weissert (3-1) turned in 1-2-3 innings out of the bullpen in the ninth and 10th. Bedrosian came in for the IronPigs in the bottom of the 10th and walked Socrates Brito and Gittens to load the bases for LaMarre and set the stage for the dramatic conclusion of the game.

NEWS & NOTES

STARTING SLOW: The RailRiders sport a 3.98 ERA as a team through 84 games this season, but starting pitching has been a weak spot for the team. Starters have pitched to the tune of a 12-20 record and a 5.33 ERA, while the bullpen is 39-13 with a 2.96 ERA. SWB starters have lasted an average of just over 3.2 innings per start this season, and have sported a 5.67 RA/9 (both earned and unearned runs allowed per game on an ERA scale). Meanwhile the RailRiders have the third-best bullpen ERA among full-season minor league clubs, trailing Buffalo (2.90) and Somerset (2.92).

SUPER GREG: RailRiders OF **Greg Allen** has been on a tear in seven games since being returned to the team from the Yankees. The switch-hitter is batting .421 (8-for-19) with 3 R, 2 2B, HR, RBI, 2 BB, 5 K, and 2 HBP. Overall, Allen is riding a seven-game hitting streak which has raised his season batting line from .263/.402/.343 to .302/.429/.437, a 121-point jump in his OPS.

MIND THE CLOCK: This week's series with Lehigh Valley has featured three pitch clock violations -- one against RailRiders pitcher **Josh Maciejewski** for taking too long to deliver a pitch, one against Iron Pigs outfielder Matt Vierling for taking too long to step in the box on Wednesday, and a third against SWB pitcher **Kevin Gadea** for taking too long to come set with a runner on base on Saturday. In 84 games, the RailRiders have seen only 12 pitch clock violations against themselves or their opponents this year, after 31 were called in the 2019 season. These are the first pace of play violations called in a RailRiders game since June 22, when both **Luis Gil** and Lehigh Valley's Mauricio Llovera were cited for taking too long to come set with a runner on base.

BEEN A LONG TIME: With a loss to Lehigh Valley on Wednesday and Buffalo's 5-0 win over Rochester, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders wake up Thursday morning in second place in Triple-A East Northeast for the first time since the beginning of play on May 7. That day, the RailRiders beat the Syracuse Mets 7-3 to move into a tie for first in Triple-A East Northeast, and would at least share the throne until the end of play on August 11. During SWB's 97-day reign atop the division, the average price of a gallon of gas jumped from \$2.89 to \$3.17, "Save Your Tears" by The Weeknd and Ariana Grande was de-throned as the No. 1 song, and **Hoy Park's** entire RailRiders career happened.

ROUGH PATCH: Even with the Saturday win over Lehigh Valley, the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders continue to be mired in their worst stretch of the season, having dropped nine out of their last 13 games. There have been two three-game losing skids for SWB in this span, only the second and third times this year that the RailRiders have dropped three in a row, respectively. Through 84 completed games, the RailRiders have not dropped four straight games. In 2019, SWB had three four-game losing streaks and one six-game losing streak. There was also one stretch where the team lost 11-of-12 games played from 8/6-17.

THREE DOZEN SIDES OF BACON: The COVID-19 pandemic has created one of the most unusual season schedules in the history of the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre franchise. With the season beginning a full month later than traditional, all teams in Triple-A East will play 120-game regular season schedules, followed by the 10-game Triple-A Final Stretch. The RailRiders, along with the rest of the Northeast Division teams, will exclusively play teams within the division. This leads to a schedule where SWB plays the rival Lehigh Valley IronPigs an unprecedented 36 times. For perspective, the RailRiders play the Rochester Red Wings and the Buffalo Bisons a combined 36 times. The RailRiders currently lead the 2021 IronRail Series 13-10, but Lehigh Valley has taken three of five games in the current set.

FALLING BEHIND: The RailRiders have made a habit of notching comeback wins this season, but the flip side is that is predicated on the team falling behind in many games this season. Through 84 games this season, Scranton/Wilkes-Barre has allowed the first run in 46 games, notching a 23-23 record in those contests. The RailRiders have been out-scored 92-76 (-16) in the first two innings of games this season, a shocking number considering the team is +95 in run differential this season, the third-best mark in Triple-A East (Durham, +174; Buffalo, +106). Most of the damage has been done in the middle innings, with SWB sporting an impressive +68 run differential in innings four through six.

LAST TIME OUT: García had a rough go on Tuesday night in the series opener with Lehigh Valley, allowing five runs on three hits in 4.1 innings, walking five and striking out four. The right-hander was tagged with the loss, and has walked nine batters in 8.2 innings in his last two starts. He allowed a home run to Charlie Tilson in the second inning, setting the tone early before settling down.

TROUBLE WITH THE HOMER: In 63.1 innings this season, García has already surrendered a career-high 18 home runs with the RailRiders this season. That equates to a shocking 2.56 HR/9.0 IP and an equally-shocking 22.5% HR/FB rate. The right-hander has the highest HR/9 among pitchers in all of Triple-A with at least 60.0 innings pitched, and also highest in all of MiLB. García's HR/FB rate is 3rd-highest in Triple-A with the same qualifier.

RECORD SETTING ROOKIE: Deivi García made his big-league debut in Game 2 of a doubleheader on 8/30/2020 against the New York Mets (6.0 IP, 4 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 0 BB, 6 K). He became just the 10th Yankee since 1935 and the first since 1992 to throw at least 6.0 IP and not allow an earned run in his MLB debut. García went on to become just the second pitcher in Yankees history with at least 6 K and no more than 2 BB in each of his first four big league appearances (Masahiro Tanaka, 2014). He did this while being the youngest pitcher (21 year, 103 days) to start a game for the Yankees since Phil Hughes (21 years, 95 days in 2007), and the second-youngest player to start a game in the majors in 2020 (Luis Patiño, SD; 20 years, 329 days). The right-hander capped off the season by starting Game 2 of the ALDS against Tampa Bay, and became the youngest pitcher (21 years, 140 days) ever to start a postseason game for the Yankees (previous: Whitey Ford, 1950 World Series Game 4; 21 years, 351 days).

2021 HIGHLIGHTS:

- Began the season at the Yankees Alternate Training Site, recalled by Yankees for a spot start on 4/26.
- Optioned to the Yankees Alternate Training Site on 4/27 and assigned to RailRiders Opening Day roster on 4/30.
- Named Triple-A East Pitcher of the Week for 5/10-16 (1-0, 10.0 IP, 5.0 H, 1 R, 0 ER, 2 BB, 16 K), the first weekly award for an SWB pitcher since Jonathan Holder in 2016 (8/22-28).

PERSONAL:

- Launched a new Instagram account in June dedicated to showcasing his artwork "@drawings_deivi83".
- Full name is Deivi Anderson García.
- Watches the same 5-minute clip of his idol Pedro Martinez from the 1999 All-Star Game before each of his starts.
- Credits his Father for a lot of his success, he was the first one to teach him a curveball and made countless sacrifices for him to attend tryouts. His mother was a doctor who gave up her career to focus on raising her children.
- Grew up wanting to play shortstop, began pitching when he went to tryouts as a 15-year-old and scouts had him work out on the mound.
- Younger brother, Andres García, is a prospect in the Toronto Blue Jays organization. He most recently played for the DSL Blue Jays in 2019.
- Pitched in the 2019 SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game at Progressive Field in Cleveland, and was promoted to Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for the first time after the game.
