Leading Off

The Fightin Phils finish a six-game series on Sunday with the Binghamton Rumble Ponies. It's the 12th of 18 matchups between the teams this season, and the sixth of six in Reading. Binghamton leads the season-series 6-5, and the teams split a six-game series in Binghamton from Apr. 16-21. Reading went 4-14 against Binghamton last season, including a 2-10 record at home. Reading has already won the same amount of games against Binghamton as last season.

Bringing the Rain and Runs

The Fightin Phils hit a season-high five home runs in a rain-shortened 12-6 over Binghamton on Saturday night. The game was called after the top of the seventh, giving Reading its second win of the week. Jose Rodriguez and Carson Taylor each had three hits, while Marcus Lee Sang and Bryce Ball had two. Kendall Simmons had three RBI, while Caleb Ricketts and Ball had two. Reading had five runs in the third, four in the fourth, one in the fifth and two in the Eight-of-nine members of the Fightin Phils starting lineup had runs and hits in the win. Reading's last rain-shortened game was on Aug. 20, 2023, at New Hampshire. Ironically, Reading also had a 12-6 rain-shortened win last season, coming on May 3 at Hartford.

Home Run Merchants

Reading crushed a season-high five home runs in last night's win. Bryce Ball, Kendall Simmons, Robert Moore, Baron Radcliff and Carson Taylor all homered. The last time Reading had five home runs in a game was July 14, 2023, against the Portland Sea Dogs at FirstEnergy Stadium. This week, Reading has hit an Eastern Leahue-high 12 home runs. This comes after not hitting a single homer last week at Richmond. Kendall Simmons has three home runs this week and Bryce Ball has homered in back-to-back games. It is the sixth time in Bryce Ball's career he's homered in back-to-back games, with the last instance coming on April 28-29, 2022, with Tennessee. Ball has never homered in three-straight games. Robert Moore homered for the first time since Aug. 23, 2023, with Wisconsin, and Carson Taylor went deep for the first time since Apr. 20 at Binghamton.

Out of the Bullpen

Fightin Phils reliever Tristan Garnett is establishing himself as not just one of the best relief arms on the Fightin Phils, but in the Eastern League. Garnett has a 1.29 ERA this season and opponents are hitting just .173 against him. He's allowed earned runs in two of his 15 outings this season, and has not surrendered an earned run over his last seven appearances. Amongst Eastern League relievers with at least 10 appearances, Garnett ranks eighth with a 1.29 ERA.

Taylor Rolling Again

After a brief quiet spell, Carson Taylor is continuing the torrid pace he is on to begin the season. Across the last four games, Taylor is slashing .500/.529/.750, with a 1.279 OPS, with three five scored, a double, homer a three RBI. This came after a brief one-for-15 spell for Taylor over his previous five games, prior to Wednesday night. Taylor holds the following Eastern League ranks: 2nd AVG (.327), 2nd RBI (33), 4th OBP (.409), 4th SLG (.540) and 4th OPS (.949).

Who's Hot

Other Fightin Phils who have had good weeks are Marcus Lee Sang, Jose Rodriguez and Kendall Simmons. This week, Lee Sang is 7-18 (.389), with one home run and two RBI. After hitting just .197 in April, Lee Sang is batting .308 in May. Kendall Simmons is 5-13 (.385) this week, with three home runs and five RBI. Simmons is hitting .297 in May, after a .182 April. Jose Rodriguez had three hits and two runs last night. He is now hitting .345 May after a .176 April. Also, Rodriguez has struck out just five times in 62 May plate appearances.

This Day in Baseballtown History

May 26, 2010: At Reading, Matt Rizzotti's 3-run homer with one out in the bottom of the 9th gives the R-Phils a 5-3 win over Portland. Rizzotti finishes the night 3-for-5 with a pair of homers and a double while knocking in all five Reading runs.

Ponies Rumbling Into Reading

Binghamton enters today with a 23-19 record, which is tied for first in the Eastern League's Northeast Division. The Rumble Ponies hosted the Bowie Baysox at home and took two-of-six games in the series, winning Tuesday and Sunday, and dropping four-straight in the middle. After this week, Binghamton returns to Mirabito Stadium and hosts Harrisburg for a six-game series. Binghamton's roster features 10 of the Mets' top-30 prospects: Jett Williams (1), Ryan Clifford (4), Kevin Parada (9), Blade Tidwell (10), Brandon Sproat (13), Alex Ramirez (16), Tyler Stuart (18), Nolan McLean (19), Joander Suarez (28) and Rhylan Thomas (30).

Ponies Pitcher

Righty Cameron Foster makes the start tonight for Binghamton. This season Foster is 2-1, with a 3.76 ERA over eight games and four starts (26.1 IP, 25 H, 17 BB, 19 SO). Foster pitched one inning of relief at Reading on Tuesday, allowing two runs with two walks and one hit allowed. He also faced Reading on May 20, not allowing a run over four innings. His last start came on May 9 at Portland. In his first pro season in 2023, Foster went 4-6, with a 4.20 ERA over 18 games (16 starts) for High-A Brooklyn. The Mets drafted Foster in the 14th round of the 2022 draft out of McNese State.

2024 Notes: On Fightin Phils Opening Day Roster. Hit around in Apr. 6 loss at Bowie. Allowed eight-earned runs on seven hits in just 2.1 innings pitched. Eight runs allowed were a career high. Struggled in second-straight outing on Apr. 13 vs Portland. Allowed five-earned runs, including two more homers, while suffering second-straight loss. Also racked up season-high four walks and four strikeouts. Four walks was one shy of career-high. Was on Development List from Apr. 14-21. Struggled with comman Apr. 21 at Binghamton, lasing just 2.2 innings and walking four for second-straight outing. Placed on 7-day IL Apr. 23 and activated prior to start on May 8. Best outing of season May 8 vs Hartford, where he tossed season-high 4.1 innings pitched in no-decision. Lasted just one-plus inning May 16 at RIC, allowing five hits and six runs in loss to Flying Squirrels. Allowed three-earned runs over four innings May 21 vs BNG.

CAREER TRANSACTIONS: Signed a minor league contract with the San Diego Padres as an International Free Agent on July 8, 2017. Elected free agency from the Padres on November 6, 2023. Signed a minor league contract with the Philadelphia Phillies on December 16, 2023.

2023: Spent the entire season with Double-A San Antonio in the Padres organization. Led the team in strikeouts and innings pitched. Earned his first win since 2019 on May 11 against Corpus Christi, pitching six innings, allowing no-earned runs, and picking up eight strikeouts. Had a 3.88 strikeout to walk ratio (31 SO, 8 BB) in five May starts and struck out 31.8% of the batters faced (34-107) in five June starts. Had at least six strikeouts in seven-straight games from May 23 through June 28, which was tied for the longest such streak in the Texas League. Pitched in one postseason game.
