LAST TIME OUT: Brooklyn utilized a 4-run 7th inning to snare the season-opening rubber-match from Jersey Shore, 4-2, on Sunday afternoon at Maimonides Park...Cyclones grabbed the lead on a SS **Kevin Kendall** bases-loaded walk...CF **Alex Ramírez** followed with a 2-run single and 3B **Jaylen Palmer** added an infield RBI knock...BlueClaws tallied a pair in the 9th before stranding the bases loaded...LHP **Daniel Juárez** entered with one out and produced a foul pop and a strikeout to earn the save...RHP **Tyler Stuart** hurled 4.0 scoreless innings to start, while RHP **Jordan Geber** posted 4.1 innings of one-run ball to earn the win for Brooklyn in relief.

FULLY LOADED: Prior to Opening Day, *Baseball America* ranked the Brooklyn Cyclones as having the fourth most-talented roster in all of Minor League Baseball...The 'Clones are the highest rated non-Triple-A squad, falling just behind the Norfolk Tides (1), Durham Bulls (2), and Columbus Clippers (3)...Brooklyn is the lone South Atlantic League team and A-level club to be recognized within the Top 10.

RUNNING WITH OUR EYES CLOSED: The Cyclones have turned up their speed through the first three games of the 2023 season...After swiping two bags in Sunday's win vs. Jersey Shore, Brooklyn has now stolen 6 bases on the campaign...That is the most for the franchise through the first three contests since they snagged 8 bases in the initial three games of the 2017 campaign vs. Staten Island and at Vermont...Brooklyn is third in the South Atlantic League in steals and OF **Omar De Los Santos** is tied for third in the circuit with 3 swipes.

LIGHT IT UP: Through the first three games of the 2023 season, the Cyclones offense has been a tornado of production...Brooklyn enters the second series of the year with 19 runs scored in 3 contests...That total is the most among South Atlantic League teams...That total is the most for the franchise through the first three games of the season dating back to the start of the Minor League stat portal during the 2005 campaign...The 'Clones tallied 16 runs in the initial three contests of 2005 season.

PATIENCE IS KEY: Brooklyn enters Tuesday's series opener at Winston-Salem leading the South Atlantic League in walks (24)...The 'Clones have worked 5 more free passes than the squad with the second-most in the circuit (Hudson Valley; 19)...Brooklyn has worked the third-most walks among non-Triple-A teams thus far in 2023...Only Single-A Daytona of the Florida State League (27) and Single-A Salem of the Carolina League (26) have earned more.

SAME FACES, NEW PLACES: LHP **Quinn Brodey** and RHP **Manny Rodriguez** made their Cyclones pitching debuts on Saturday afternoon...Brodey yielded one run on one hit, striking out a pair, in 2.1 innings...Rodri-

vs. WINSTON-SALEM: Brooklyn travels to North Carolina for their first matchup against the White Sox' High-A affiliate. The Dash boast nie of the Pale Hose top 30 prospects per *Baseball America*...RHP **Norge Vera** (8), RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (11), RHP **Kohl Simas** (13), OF **Wilfred Veras** (17), INF **Wes Kath** (18), OF **Terrell Tatum** (24), and INF **Loideli Chapellí** (26) are all on Winston-Salem's active roster...INF **Colson Montgomery** (1) and RHP **Jared Kelley** (14) are currently on the injured list...The Cyclones went 7-5 in their first 12 matchups against the Dash in 2022...Brooklyn won 4-of-6 from Winston-Salem at Truist Park from September 6-11, the final series of the regular season.

guez did not permit a hit or run over 1.2 frames...As an outfielder, Brodey led Brooklyn in RBI (30) in 2017...Rodriguez appeared in 51 games as a shortstop with the franchise in 2018.

2022 IN REVIEW: The Cyclones finished the 2022 campaign with an overall mark of 70-62...Brooklyn snared the South Atlantic League North Division crown in the second half, finishing 2.0 games ahead of Hudson Valley with a mark of 40-26...The 'Clones earned an 8-1 win at home vs. Aberdeen in the opening game of the Division Championship before dropping the final two games of the series on the road.

'NEW' MAN IN CHARGE: Chris Newell takes over as the manager of the Brooklyn Cyclones in 2023 after serving as the team's bench coach in 2022...Newell served as skipper of the Birmingham-Bloomfield Beavers of the United Shore Professional Baseball League from 2016-19...The 49-year-old won consecutive championships (2017-18) and was named Manager of the Year three times (2016-18)...Holds a career record of 105-92 (.533).

NEW DRAFT CLASS: The New York Mets' 2022 MLB draft class brings six arms and three bats to Coney Island in 2023...RHP **Blade Tidwell** (2nd round), RHP **Tyler Stuart** (6th), RHP **Dylan Tebrake** (8th), RHP **Paul Gervase** (12th), RHP **Cameron Foster** (14th), and RHP **Jordan Geber** (UDFA) all begin the season on pitching coach **Victor Ramos'** staff...C **Kevin Parada** — the No. 11 overall pick — joins INF **Chase Estep** (9th) and INF **Brad Malm** (UDFA) headlining the offensive firepower.

PROSPECTS: Brooklyn hosts three of the Mets Top 10 prospects, according to *MLB Pipeline* and *Baseball America*...They include C **Kevin Parada** (No. 3 *MLB Pipeline*/No. 4 *Baseball America*), OF **Alex Ramírez** (4/5), and RHP **Blade Tidwell** (7/9)...OF **Stanley Consuegra** ranks as the organization's No. 21 farmhand per *MLB Pipeline*.

CANARSIE TO CONEY: INF/OF **Jaylen Palmer**, returns to the Cyclones once again in 2023. The Canarsie, Brooklyn native attended Holy Cross High School in Queens - three miles east from Citi Field in Flushing and 30 miles northeast of Maimonides Park - before being drafted by the Mets in the 22nd round of the 2018 MLB Draft.

TOP PROSPECT: Tidwell enters the 2023 season ranked as the Mets' top pitching prospect per MLB Pipeline...Comes at No. 7 overall on the Top 30 list...The 21-year-old is considered the organization's No. 9 overall farmhand by *Baseball America*...Only RHP **Kodai Senga** is a higher-ranked pitcher on their list...Selected as having the "Best Fastball" and "Best Secondary Pitch" in the Mets' 2022 draft class.

2022: Selected by the Mets in the second round of the 2022 draft...Signed for \$1.85 million on July 27...Assigned to the Florida Complex League Mets on August 9...Tossed 1.0 scoreless inning vs. FCL Astros Blue before joining Single-A St. Lucie on August 16...Made 4 starts, registering an 0-1 record with a 2.16 ERA (2 ER in 8.1 IP) and 9 strikeouts...Hurled 9.2-scoreless innings for St. Lucie in the Florida State League playoffs, helping the Mets to their first league title since 2006...Earned his first professional win in the decisive Game 2 of the Championship Series on September 20 vs. Dunedin (5.0 IP, 3 H, 2 BB, 7 SO).

VOLUNTEER SERVICE: Tidwell joined the New York system after an incredible career at Tennessee...As a draft-eligible sophomore in 2022, The Volunteer State native accrued a 3-2 record with a 3.00 ERA (13 ER in 39.0 IP) and 51 punch outs in 13 appearances (9 starts)...Missed the first two months of the season with shoulder soreness...Named to the 2022 Knoxville Regional All-Tournament team...As a freshman in 2021, Tidwell was recognized on the SEC All-Freshman Team and named a Freshman All-American by D1Baseball.com and Perfect Game.

LORETTO LIGHTNING: Tidwell is no stranger to being around talent...At Loretto (Tenn.) High School, the former second-round selection was teammates with 2018 first-round pick (No. 7 overall) and current San Diego Padres LHP **Ryan Weathers**...Ryan's father, **David**, who pitched for the Mets (2002-04) is also a Loretto High School alum.
