WSH AFFILIATE NOTES

Double-A Harrisburg picked up their second-straight win last night, 4-2 over Richmond (SF) in their series opener...LB **ETHAN PETRY** connected on his ninth homer of the season, a two-run shot in the fourth.



CLIPPED WINGS: Back in the Flower City, the Rochester Red Wings began their six-game homestand Tuesday against the Charlotte Knights and fell in a back-and-forth game one with a final score of 8-6...2B **CAYDEN WALLACE** and DH **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** each launched two-run homers, serving as the catalysts for the Wings' bats throughout the evening...1B **YOHANDY MORALES** was the only Rochester hitter to log a multi-hit performance, going 2-for-4 with a pair of singles...the Red Wings look to get back into the win column tonight playing as the White Hots, sending southpaw **JARED SIMPSON** to the mound against rehabbing Charlotte right-hander Drew Thorpe.



HOME(R) SIMPSON: Southpaw **JARED SIMPSON** will take the ball first for the Red Wings tonight in what will be his fourth start (7th app.) as a Red Wing since joining the club on 7/19...the 26-year-old opened things up with a hitless inning in his previous outing on 8/7 at SWB, while striking out a pair and walking one...Simpson has yet to allow a run across six appearances as the opener in 2026 (first 6 starts of pro career, 3 w/ HBG, 3 w/ ROC), allowing just three hits across 7.0 innings while holding batters to a .125 BAA with a 1.14 WHIP...he is just two appearances, 5.0 innings, and seven strikeouts shy of his career-highs' set last season (41 G, 52.0 IP, 64 SO)...



Across 18 home games (3 GS) with Rochester and Double-A Harrisburg, the Iowa native boasts a 1.96 ERA (5 ER/23.0 IP) with 28 strikeouts and a .198 BAA.



EVERYBODY EATS: After adding two more homers in last night's losing effort, the Red Wings offense has now gone deep at least twice in six consecutive games for the first time since they did so in seven-straight in 2019 (7/7-15)...since the streak started on 8/5, Rochester leads all of Minor and Major League Baseball with 19 long balls...they also lead all MLB teams with 131 total bases, T-3rd with 51 RBI, rank fourth with 54 runs scored, fifth with a .590 SLG, and sixth with a .979 OPS...DH **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** is one of four players in professional baseball with five homers in the last seven days, joining Buffalo INF Charles McAdoo (4 w/ BUF, 1 w/ TOR), High-A Lake County (CLE) INF Welbyn Franciscia, and Double-A Arkansas (SEA) C Boston Smith.



KING OF THE HILL: SS **SEAVER KING** comes into tonight's contest looking for his fourth consecutive multi-hit game after a 2-for-5 night at the plate in the game one loss against Charlotte...since King came off the IL on 7/30, the 23-year-old ranks eighth in batting average (.333) among International League hitters (Min. 35 AB) and second on the team behind MAXWELL ROMERO JR. (.351), while leading the Red Wings in on-base percentage (.442) during that span...since the calendar flipped to August, the former Demon Deacon is slashing .300/.417/.533 with three extra-base hits...



The speedy Top 30 prospect is slashing .478/.586/.783 with four extra-base hits in seven Wednesday games with Rochester this season.



MAXWELL HOUSE: DH **MAXWELL ROMERO JR.** went yard for the fifth time in last night's loss to Charlotte, finishing the night 1-for-4 with two driven in...the homer, a 395-foot opposite field home run, was Romero's fifth of August, tying him for the International League-lead in that category...against Triple-A right-handed pitching, the former Miami Hurricane is slashing .348/.455/.739 with eight extra-base hits and 16 RBI...when the lefty catcher comes to the plate with runners on base, he's hitting .455 (10-for-22), when the runners get into scoring position he carries a .471 (8-for-17) batting average, and when there is two outs and runners in scoring position, Romero is slashing .714/.715/1.157 with a home run and seven RBI...



Since July 18, Romero has had the highest average exit velocity (95.5 MPH), average hit distance (233 FT), third in RBI (16), fourth in OPS (1.194), as well as fifth in BABIP (.458)



OFF THE WALL(ACE): 2B **CAYDEN WALLACE** went 1-for-3 at the plate last night, hitting a home run in the fourth, driving in teammate **RILEY ADAMS** to score two runs...Wallace also logged a walk and stole a base in the contest...this month, the second baseman is slashing .308/.341/.513, hitting two home runs with eight RBI and two walks, ranking second on the Red Wings' in hits (12) and third in batting average (.308)...



In the nine games as a Red Wing following a loss Wallace has played in this season, the Arkansas native has an on-base percentage of .313 and a slugging percentage of .552.



MORALES AUTHORITY: 1B **YOHANDY MORALES** scored a run after going 2-for-4 in yesterday's contest...since coming back from injury on 8/7, the Miami native is batting .375 (6-for-16), with an on-base percentage of .500, and a slugging percentage of .549...among all International League hitters this season, Morales is third in runs (66) and in total bases (174)...the first baseman also leads Nationals Minor Leaguers in SLG (.549), second in OPS (.922), third in hits (99), and total bases (184).



STEADY EDDY: RHP **EDDY YEAN** came on in relief in the eighth inning last night, and recorded two outs with a strikeout on 12 pitches...he has now turned in a scoreless outing in 14 of his last 15 appearances (1 GS) between Rochester and Washington dating back to 7/2 vs. LHV, including eight-straight clean appearances with the Red Wings...he boasts a 0.95 ERA (2 ER/19.0 IP) with a 0.58 WHIP and .109 BAA across both levels since 7/2, while logging 17 strikeouts to just four walks...he ranks second among all Triple-A & MLB pitchers (min. 15.0 IP) in BAA over that stretch, third in WHIP, and 11th in ERA...



Yean leads all International League pitchers and ranks second in Triple-A with 45 total appearances this season, just one spot ahead of RHP **JACK SINCLAIR** (44).

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the eighth round of the 2023 MLB Draft out of the University of Iowa.

- Slated to make his fourth start and seventh appearance overall in game two of this six-game set at ESL Ballpark. The left-hander has logged 7.1 innings to the tune of a 2.45 ERA, and hasn't allowed a run in six games as an opener between Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester this season.
- Transferred to Rochester for his Triple-A debut on 7/19, after spending the entire season with Double-A Harrisburg...logged 33 appearances (3 GS, first of pro career) with a 2.04 ERA (9 ER/39.2 IP), while striking out 48 with a 1.36 WHIP and .182 BAA.
- Slated to make his second start with Rochester tonight...coming off his first start in game one on 7/30 (1.0 IP, 0 ER).
- At the time of his promotion, ranked sixth among all Eastern League pitchers (min. 25.0 IP) in ERA, and T-12th in BAA...led all Harrisburg pitchers in appearances.
- Did not allow an earned run through 10 appearances dating from 6/16 to 7/17, and 16 of his last 17 since 5/19...boasts a 0.82 ERA (2 ER/22.0 IP) with 23 strikeouts, a 1.00 WHIP and .137 BAA since 5/19.
- Has appeared in 86 career games (3 GS) with a 4.16 ERA (49 ER/106.0 IP), 133 strikeouts, 92 walks, and a .195 BAA.

Entering his sixth professional season, first with the Nationals organization after signing as a Minor League free agent on 3/31/2026... originally selected by New York-AL in the ninth round of the 2021 MLB Draft out of the University of Southern California...named Texas League Pitcher of the Week with Northwest Arkansas on 5/19/2024 and 7/30/2023...named Midwest League Pitcher of the Week with Quad City on May 7, 2023.

- Sixth in the IL among qualified pitchers in ERA (4.06) and fourth in wins (7).
- Picked up his sixth win of the season and 30th of his professional career last time out on 7/11 at Worcester, carrying a no-hitter into the sixth before finishing with 6.0 full innings, one hit, and one earned run while striking out three and walking two.
- Across three Saturday games this season (2 GS), the soon-to-be 27-year-old is 2-0 with a 1.80 ERA (3 ER/15.0 IP), a 0.47 WHIP, .104 BAA, and a BB/9 of 1.20.
- Recorded 500th career strikeout on 6/9 vs. Worcester.
- Made his 100th career start in game two of a doubleheader on 4/17 vs. Buffalo.
- Began the 2026 season with Double-A Harrisburg...transferred to Triple-A Rochester on 4/4.
- Made 29 appearances (25 GS) with Triple-A Omaha in 2025...went 4-9 with a 7.84 ERA (204 ER/119.1 IP), while compiling 100 strikeouts against 51 walks...ranked second among all Royals Minor League pitchers in games started, fourth in innings pitched, and T-9th in strikeouts.

Entering his fourth professional season, all with the Nationals organization after he was selected in the seventh round of the 2022 MLB Draft, out of Texas Christian University.

- Optioned to Rochester on 8/4 after pitching 10.5 innings for the Nationals since his recall to the team on 6/29...allowed just one hit in his last four appearances with Washington.
- Boasts the third-lowest ERA (4.22) of any Red Wings pitcher with at least 50 innings of work.
- Recalled by Washington on 4/24 for his MLB debut the same day at Chicago-AL...allowed two earned on two hits across 2.0 innings of relief, striking out one and walking four.
- Named Nationals Minor League Pitcher of the Year in 2025 with a 6-7 record, 3.28 ERA (49 ER/134.1 IP), 135 strikeouts, and 55 walks across 27 games (26 GS) between High-A Wilmington, Double-A Harrisburg and Triple-A Rochester, setting career marks in nearly every category.
- Began the season with High-A Wilmington...transferred to Double-A Harrisburg on 5/23, and Triple-A Rochester on 8/6.
- Matched his career-high three times with 7.0 innings pitched (4/23, 5/17, 6/19)...set a career-high with 10 strikeouts in game one of a doubleheader on 4/12 against Hub City (TEX).
