NOTES AND NUGGETS

DON'T STOP ME NOW

Last Saturday's 23-7 win over the Clippers has an argument for the best offensive game in the Storm Chasers era of the Triple-A Omaha franchise (since 2011) and one of the best in modern Omaha era (Since 2005)

- 10 home runs set a new modern franchise record ... this outburst passed Omaha's previous modern franchise record of 9, set on July 4, 2022 vs. Toledo ... the Storm Chasers are just the 4th full season Minor League team since 2005 to hit 10+ homers in a game, the first Triple-A team since 2019 (Las Vegas, 7/26/19 @ El Paso) ... the July 4, 2022 game was also the last time multiple Omaha players hit multiple homers in the same game, 3 had 2-homer games yesterday.
- 23 runs in a game in the most in the Storm Chasers era ... it tied a modern era franchise record, matching a 23-5 win over the Round Rock Express on August 30, 2010 ... 23 runs is the most a Triple-A team has scored in a game this season, the 3rd-most scored by a full-season affiliate (Greensboro, 8/9/25 @ Asheville).
 - Switch-hitting outfielder **Drew Waters** hit 2 home runs, one from each side of the plate ... he's the first Triple-A Omaha player to homer from both sides of the plate in the same game since **Tim Raines Jr.** on August 20, 2009 @ Tacoma ... in that game, Raines hit a right-handed solo shot in the 4th inning, followed by a 3-run left-handed homer in the 8th ... Waters' 2 homers combined to travel 887 feet, the furthest combined distance from a Storm Chaser hitter's 2-homer game since Statcast tracking was introduced to the IL in 2023.

2ND HALF SLUGGERS

While Omaha has had a slow start to the 2nd half, a few hitters have had a hot start offensively to the back half of the season.

- Harold Castro is hitting .316 (56-for-177) since June 24 ... he leads the team with 56 hits, 100 total bases, 12 home runs and 36 RBI this half ... Castro was just named the IL's Player of the Week for the 2nd week in a row, going 14-for-25 (.560) with 3 HR & 14 RBI last week in the Chasers' series against Columbus.
- MJ Melendez is hitting .295 (46-for-156) in the 2nd half and leads the team with 16 doubles ... he is 2nd on the team with 46 hits, 90 total bases and 22 walks, while tied 3rd with 23 RBI and 8 homers.
- Carter Jensen joined Omaha for the 2nd half and despite a slow start, he has hit 13 homers with 36 RBI since arriving ... 23 of his 40 hits have gone for extrabases (9 doubles, 1 triple & 13 homers), for 90 total bases ... his 27 walks lead the team, while batting .286 (40-for-140) with the Chasers.

HITTIN' HAROLD

- Storm Chasers infielder **Harold Castro** is having one of the best offensive months by an International Leaguer this year.

 Castro has a case to be the IL's Player of the Month in August, as he's hitting .481 (38-for-79) this month, with a league-best 38 hits, 72 total bases and 9 homers and tied 1st with 25 runs batted in ... among full season Minor Leaguers, he's 1st in total bases, tied 1st in hits, 2nd home runs and tied 2nd in runs batted in ... In 12 games since August 9, he's 28-for-51 at the plate (.549 average) with 22 RBI ... in this stretch, he has 11 multi-hit games with an RBI in every game but one ... he has homered 7 times in the last 12 games with 6 multi-RBI games.
- From August 9 to 20, Castro recorded multiple hits in 7 straight games, with an RBI in all 7 games as well ... in that stretch he went 16-for-30 (.533) with 1 double, 1 triple, 5 homers and 12 runs batted in ... 7 consecutive multi-hit games tied a modern Omaha franchise record (since 2005) ... Nick Loftin did so last year, hitting .517 (15-for-29) between August 3 and 10.

THAT'S WHAT SPEED DO

The Storm Chasers are not near the league lead in stolen bases, but Omaha has

- one of the highest success rates on the basepaths in the Minors.

 Omaha has successfully stolen 148 bases this year, and only been caught 27 times ... 148 steals rank tied 7th in the International League and tied 12th in Triple-A.
- 148-for-175 in steal attempts is a 84.6% success rate, the 2nd-best stolen base rate at the Triple-A level and 6th among the 120 full-season Minor League teams (1st: South Bend Cubs, 85.6%, 219-for-256).

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

Omaha has played many close games this season ... with incredible success recently.

- Last Friday marked the Storm Chasers' 11th 1-run win this year... Omaha is 11-19 in 1-run games this year, including 8-0 in their last 8 games that have been decided by 1 run, after starting the year 3-19 in 1-run games.
- On August 5, the Storm Chasers snapped a stretch of nearly 2 months without winning a 1-run game ... Omaha had lost its last 10 games that were decided by 1 run, then beat Indianapolis in extras and have now won 8 straight..
- Last Friday was Omaha's 29th "comeback" win of the year, a win after trailing at any point in the game ... it was the 14th time winning while trailing for more than 2 innings ... August 17 was the 8th time winning after trailing for half the game.

Kolek is pitching in his 5th start with Omaha, his 11th Triple-A start and 25th overall start this year ... he began the year in the Padres organization and has spent much of the year in San Diego's rotation ... was acquired by Kansas City at the trade deadline as part of the exchange for <u>Freddy Fermin</u>. Playing his 7th <u>professional season this year</u> ... Royals are Kolek's 4th MLB organization, has previously spent time with the Dodgers, Mariners and Padres ... has appeared in 43 Major League games (25 starts) with the Padres between 2024 and 2025.

Made his 4th start in the Royals organization, took his 3rd loss with the Storm Chasers in his second shortest outing of the year, ... allowed 2 runs on 4 hits in the 1st inning ... pitched a 1-2-3 2nd frame ... allowed another pair of runs in the 3rd on 3 singles and a walk, hitting 2 batters ... allowed a leadoff double in the 4th and was pulled before an out was recorded.

2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- Optioned to Triple-A on March 25 and made 5 starts for the El Paso Chihuahuas before being recalled on May 4 ... since the start of May, has made just 1 appearance in the Minors, optioned July 6 for a 3.0-inning start for El Paso on July 12 ... recalled July 22, made 2 more starts, optioned July 29 and traded July 31. Has pitched at least 5.0 innings in 12 of his 14 MLB starts this season ... he's gotten through 5.2 innings in 8 of the 14, owning a 2.16 ERA (12 ER, 50.0 IP) in those outings.

 Despite having made just the 14 starts this season, Kolek's 17 GIDPs are tied 2nd in the National League and tied 5th most in all of MLB (1st: Angels' Jose Soriano, 25) ... among all Major League starters who have made at least 14 starts (137 pitchers), his 1.93 GIDP/9 IP ratio leads the Majors (next closest: 1.52)

- Threw the first complete game of his career on May 10 @ Colorado, holding the Rockies to 5 hits and 2 walks over 9.0 shutout innings, while throwing a career-high 104 pitches ... his first 2 MLB outings of the year on May 4 and 10 were back-to-Back scoreless starts, which he also did June 2 and 7.





Scorigami: A portmanteau of score and origami, a scorigami is a scoring combination that has never happened before in a team, sport or league's history. The term was originated by SB Nation writer Jon Bois for NFL scores.

Above is a matrix of every final score that has happened in a Triple-A Omaha game <u>since 2000</u>. Green squares represent Omaha wins, while red squares represent Omaha losses. The number inside the square refers to the number of times that result has occurred. Empty squares represent a scoring combination or result that has not happened.

Since 2000, there are **58** results in Triple-A Omaha games that have only happened once. **34** of those results (wins or losses) are a true scorigami, a scoring combination that has only happened once. Recent scorigami occurrences are listed to the right, with true scorigamis in bold.
